**AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES**

**Sudan** (Feb 03)

Protocol between the CCP and the Sudanese Socialist Union to develop their relations on the basis of independence, total equality, mutual respect and non-interference in each other's internal affairs.

**Mongolian People's Republic**

(Feb 04)

Protocol on barter trade and payments for 1983. Under the protocol, the trade volume between the two countries will be higher than last year. China will export to Mongolia silks, satins, daily necessities and fruits while Mongolia will supply China with log and animal products.

**Zambia** (Feb 07)

Executive program for 1983 for the implementation of the Sino-Zambian cultural agreement. Under the program, China will send an art troupe to visit Zambia and hold an exhibition of Chinese shell-carving, feather-patch work and woven products. A Chinese film-week will open in Zambia and China will offer ten scholarships for Zambian students to study in China. On its part, Zambia will send a sports team, an education delegation and a journalist delegation to visit China. A song and dance troupe from Zambia will perform in China for the first time.

November 1982****International Bank  
for Reconstruction  
and Development** (Nov 16, 1982)

The International Bank for Reconstruction and Development has extended a 124 million US\$ loan to China to finance procurement of loading and unloading equipment for container terminals under construction in the Ports of Shanghai, Tianjin and Huangpu.

The loan agreement was concluded in the United States on November 16, 1982, and went into effect early this month. Under the agreement, the borrower shall pay interest at the rate of 11.6 percent per annum on the principal amount of the loan withdrawn. The loan will be paid off in 20 years.

**CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID**

**Kenya**

The Chinese geological survey team left for Zambia after its survey of the East African Rift Valley. Accompanied by Kenyan geologists, they had conducted an extensive survey of the geological structure and general configuration of the Rift Valley, including Nakuru and Kisumu areas, as well as lakes Naivasa, Megadi and Victoria.

**Pakistan**

A 220 kV transmission line was inaugurated in Mardan, Northwest Pakistan. The Construction of the 66.92-kilometer transmission line started in July 1981 with Chinese assistance and was completed in December 1982. A two-week test has shown the line to be functioning well and up to the designed standards. It will supply 400 megawatts of electricity for Pakistan's northwest frontier province.

China and Pakistan signed in Lahore today a contract on China's supply and installation of a 210 mW steam turbine set for Pakistan's Guddu Thermal Power Station Unit No.4. The contract was signed by Pakistan's Water and Power Development Authority (WAPDA), and China's Machine-Building International Corporation (CMIC). CMIC was the lowest bidder in the international tender. WAPDA invited last year for designing, equipment supply, installation, technical training, testing and one year supervision, of the steam turbine set. The other bidders included firms from Japan, the Soviet Union, Italy and a French and Czechoslovak Consortium. The project is valued at 56 million US\$ and is to be completed in three years.

**Sri Lanka**

Sri Lanka is to install coal-fired thermal power plants and mini hydro plants to meet energy demands, according to Deputy Minister of Power and Energy, P. Dayaratne. Dayaratne said that during his recent visit to the PRC he was the advances made by China in coal-fired plants and mini hydro plants. He said a Chinese team would arrive in Colombo "this week" to start work on a project selected earlier to install a plant which can be used in small streams.

**Upper Volta**

A ceremony of handing over 50 wells sunk with Chinese aid was held in Ramongo, the Central-western Department of Upper Volta, on Feb 23. The sinking of these wells started in Sep 1981 and was completed in the fall of 1982. - At the ceremony China and Upper Volta also signed the minutes of talks on China helping Upper Volta dig another 50 wells.

Appointed acting chairman of the People's Government of Ningxia Autonomous Region (XNA, Feb 26, 1983)

Hei belongs to the Hui minority and is an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee. Since June 1982 he also holds the post of a secretary of Ningxia CP.

Appointed acting governor of Fujian Province (XNA, Jan 11, 1983)

Hu, an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee, has been vice-governor of that province before.

Huang is a newcomer.

#### Li Guiying (f) 李桂英

Identified as vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Yunnan Province (Kunming Radio, Feb 13, 1983)  
Li belongs to the Yi minority. Since 1979 she is a member of the State Nationalities Affairs Commission.

#### Li Qingwei 李庆伟

Identified as acting governor and as Party secretary of Shaanxi Province (Xian Radio, Feb 2 and 13, 1983)  
Li has been vice-governor and Party secretary of Henan Province before.

#### Liu Shuqing 刘述卿

Identified as assistant minister of foreign affairs (XNA, Feb 1, 1983)  
Liu held ambassador post in Poland (1972-77), Norway (1977-80), and Bangladesh (1980-82) and later became director of the Asian Affairs Department under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs - a position he possibly still holds.

#### Liu Zheng

Identified as secretary of Hunan Province CP (Changsha Radio, Feb 9, 1983)  
Liu has been a member of the Standing Committee of that CP before.

#### Qi Shan 祁山

Identified as vice-governor of Yunnan Province (Kunming Radio, Feb 13, 1983)  
Qi was a newcomer when he was elected deputy for Yunnan Province to the 5th NPC in 1978.

#### Yan Tongmao 阎同茂

Identified as deputy commander of Beijing Military Region (Tianjin Radio, Feb 14, 1983)  
Yan was elected deputy of the PLA to the 5th NPC in 1978. From 1979 until 1982 he could on several occasions be identified as a leading member of Tianjin Garrison.

#### Yan Yiquan

Identified as vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Yunnan Province (Kunming Radio, Feb 13, 1983)  
Yan is a newcomer.

#### Zhang Xiang 张祥

Identified as deputy director of the PLA General Logistics Department (XNA, Jan 27, 1983)  
Zhang is an alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee. In October 1981 he could be identified as director of the Public Health Division under the PLA General Logistics Department.
