*******United Arab Emirates** (Jan 05)
Trade protocol. (XNA, Jan 6, 1986)**Angola** (Jan ?)
Xinhua News Agency and the Angola Press Agency are to cooperate in news exchanges. A two-year agreement, which became effective recently, covers news exchanges by radio and telex, and photo exchanges by post, all free of charge. Each side will also provide assistance to the other's correspondents. The agreement states that the news cooperation reflects the existing cooperative relations between the two countries.**Bolivia** (Jan 07)

Cooperation agreement between the Chinese Association for Science and Technology and the Polish Association for Technology. Under the document, the two groups will hold regular meetings, exchange groups of scientists and participate in international symposiums sponsored by the other scientific associations.
(XNA, Jan 20, 1986)**Hungary** (Jan 22)
Accord for cooperation in plantquarantine and protection. The accord envisages necessary quarantine measures to prevent insects from spreading from one nation to another through Chinese-Hungarian trade. The document also provides for increased scientific and technical cooperation in plant quarantine between the two countries.

Trade agreement by which China will export to Japan 8.8 million to 9.3 million tons of oil and 3.7 million and 4.1 million tons of coal every year from 1986 to 1990. Japan will export to China equipment, construction materials and technological expertise.
(XNA, Jan 22, 1986)**Soviet Union** (Jan 23)
Goods exchange and payments protocol for 1986. Under it, China will sell the Soviet Union items such as nonferrous metals, soybeans, maize, peanuts, frozen meat, fruit, textiles and light industrial products. The Soviet Union will provide China with nonferrous metals, steel, pig iron, urea, automobiles, lumber and aeroplanes.

Protocol on sports exchange in 1986.
(XNA, Jan 24, 1986)**Hungary** (Jan 25)
Accord on increasing cooperation in the scientific and technological fields in the next 5 years. Under it, the two sides will exchange scientific information and academic publications, brief each other on international conferences and exhibitions, and invite each other to participate in international scientific activities.

Protocol on sports exchange. Under it, China will send figure skaters and coaches to Canada for training, a full team of divers and coaches to participate in the can-am-mex diving competition, and a team of wrestlers to compete in the Canada cup of wrestling this year. Canada will send a team of eight junior tennis players to China, as well as the Canadian table tennis national team. Other teams planned to visit China are basketball, speedskating and hockey.

Appointed minister of the State Nationalities Affairs Commission (XNA, Jan 20, 1986).
Ismail, a member of the CCP Central Committee since 1973, has been a Xinjiang cadre before. His last position there has been chairman of the People's Government (until Dec 1985).**Jia Shi 贾石**
Appointed chairman of the China Council for Promotion of Interna-

tional Trade (XNA, Jan 28, 1986). Jia is a foreign trade cadre of long standing. He has been vice-minister of foreign trade from 1964 until 1969 and from 1977 until 1982 and from 1982 until Jan 1986 vice-minister of foreign economic relations and trade. He led a lot of trade delegations, mainly to the Western world.

Jin Yunhui 金运辉

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Government of Xinjiang Autonomous Region (XNA, Dec 23, 1985).

Jin is a newcomer.

Li Jiayu 李嘉玉

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Xinjiang Autonomous Region (Ürümqi Radio, Dec 14, 1985; cit. SWB, Dec 21, 1985).

Li has been secretary of Xinjiang CP from 1980 until Oct 1985.

Lin Zhongming 林中鸣

Appointed assistant minister of foreign economic relations and trade (XNA, Jan 14, 1986).

Qian Liren 钱寿仁

Identified as director of Ren-min ri-bao (XNA, Dec 29, 1985).

Qian derives from the Youth Federation. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been its vice-chairman and secretary-general. Reactivated in 1978 he became deputy director of the International Liaison Department under the CCP Central Committee in 1982 and its director the following year. In Sep 1985 he was by-elected member of the CCP Central Committee.

Qiang Xiaochu 强晓初

Appointed deputy head of the Leading Group for the Rectification of Party Style Within Central Departments (XNA, Jan 10, 1986).

Qiang, a member of the CCP 12th Central Committee and 1st Party Secretary of Jilin Province from 1981-85, since Sep 1985 also holds the position of a secretary of the Central Discipline Inspection Commission under the CCP Central Committee.

Qiao Shi 乔石

Appointed head of the Leading Group for the Rectification of Party Style Within Central Departments (XNA, Jan 10, 1986).

Qiao is a Politburo member since Sep 1985.

Shen Jueren 沈觉仁

Appointed assistant minister of foreign economic relations and trade (XNA, Jan 14, 1986).

Shen has been director of the ministry's Foreign Trade Administration before.
