Italy (Feb 05)
Sports exchange protocol for 1986. Under it, the two countries will exchange visits of teams in fields like soccer, volleyball, ice hockey, handball, fencing, archery and track and field. (XNA, Feb 6, 1986)

Poland (Feb 12)
Sports exchange protocol for 1986. Under it, the two countries will exchange visits of women cagers, sporting acrobats, fencers, footballers, cyclists and gymnasts. (XNA, Feb 13, 1986)

Singapore (Feb 17)
A Cooperation agreement on tourism.
B Cooperation agreement on civil aviation.
C Cooperation agreement on exhibition. (XNA, Feb 17, 1986)

Yemen, Arab Republic (Feb 22)
Protocol of educational cooperation from 1986-90. Under it, China will provide teaching instruments and educational equipment worth 1,000,000 Chinese yuan (about 330,000 US\$) to the secondary technical schools and vocational educational centers in Arab Yemen. China will also send advisors at China's expense to help Arab Yemen in developing its secondary technical education. The protocol also provided that China and Yemen will exchange students and scholarships. (XNA, Feb 22, 1986)

Pakistan (Feb 22)
Protocol on scientific and technical cooperation. Under the protocol, Pakistan will co-operatively undertake 8 new developments proposed by the Chinese for 1986-87. In turn, the Chinese will undertake 7 new programs proposed by Pakistan. The Pakistani items include a study of farm production, cotton and poplar cultivation, agricultural research, railway technology, and the manufacturing of surgical appliances while the Chinese programs include mineral research, oil exploration, a river delta survey, a study of the textile and chemical industries, cultivation of tree sapsins and the manufacture of radio

transmitters, (XNA, Feb 22, 1986)

Mauritania (Feb 23)
A Document on China to present maize.
B Document on China to provide loans. (XNA, Feb 23, 1986)

Pakistan (Feb 24)
Notes of the 1st session of the China-Pakistan Joint Boundary Inspection Committee. (XNA, Feb 24, 1986)

Fed. Rep. of Germany (Feb 25)
Cooperation agreement between the Chinese Nuclear Society and the Nuclear Society of the FR Germany. Under it, the two sides will promote the peaceful use of nuclear energy and technology, expand academic exchanges between specialists and technicians of the two countries, exchange technical data and help in personnel training. (XNA, Feb 25, 1986)

Norway (Feb 25)
Agreement for the avoidance of double taxation and the prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to taxes on income and on capital. (XNA, Feb 25, 1986)

Italy (Feb 27)
Program on cultural exchange for 1986-87. Under it, the two countries will expand cultural exchanges in the areas of education, publishing, journalism, culture, art, broadcasting, television and sports. (XNA, Feb 27, 1986)

Czechoslovakia (Feb 27)
1986-87 plan for cooperation in public health and medical science. Under the plan, the two sides will exchange medical materials and specialists, and swap proceedings of medical conferences held in each country as well as achievements in the medical field. The two countries have chosen 13 subjects for exchange including traditional medicine, diabetes, cardiovascular disease, tumour and management. (XNA, Feb 27, 1986)

Sierra Leone (Feb 27)
A Agreement on the provision of an interest free loan by China.
B Protocol on economic and technical cooperation. (XNA, Feb 27, 1986)

Sierra Leone
The Magbas sugar mill constructed with Chinese assistance and put in-

to operation in 1977, produced more than 8,000 tons sugar, accounting for one-third of the sugar consumed. (XNA, Feb 24, 1986)

Sri Lanka
A Chinese group of expert arrived in Sri Lanka for a feasibility study of establishing a Chinese traditional medical treatment center. The center, besides giving treatment, is to provide training for Sri Lankan doctors in traditional Chinese therapies and medicines, and to explore the possibility of combination of the indigenous medicines of the two countries. (XNA, Feb 3, 1986)

Sudan
The Chinese government has donated 22,000 tons of grain to Sudan for helping drought victims in the country. The grain has been delivered in five shipments beginning last June. The last shipment was delivered in mid-February 1986. (XNA, Feb 14, 1986)

Uganda
The Chinese Red Cross presented relief funds worth 50,000 US\$ for the resettlement of refugees. (XNA, Feb 17, 1986)

Identified as commander of Shanxi Military District (Shanxi Ribao, Jan 30, 1986, cit. SWB, Feb 14, 1986). Yu was a newcomer when elected alternate member of CCP 12th Central Committee in September 1982.

Zhang Wenjin 章文晋
Appointed president of the Associa-

tion for Friendship with Foreign Countries (XNA, Feb 3, 1986). Zhang is a cadre of the Foreign Ministry of long standing. His last position had been ambassador to USA (until March 1985).
