**Editor's Note**

Under the present heading, we have thought it a good idea to publish a yearly bibliography at the basis of the monthly bibliographies. This will, however, involve some technical changes, as follows: Firstly, as the topics from every month have to be computerized and this is not yet possible with Chinese characters, we have to omit those. Instead, every Chinese article will be marked as such in brackets behind the article. The second change affects the principle of compilation. For the past one or two years, the social sciences in China have experienced a renaissance - "a hundred flowers blossom" again. We have, therefore, started

on picking up more and more items from the new Chinese publications but, of course, with a small basket we cannot collect all the flowers. So we decided to concentrate chiefly on primary periodicals, leaving out the editorials from "People's Daily" (RMRB). As to the secondary sources, we can only take into consideration as many magazines specializing in Chinese or Asian affairs as our limited staff permits. The third, and last, remark is that, beginning with this number, we shall omit the asterisks marking primary and secondary sources, because the sources can easily be localized by their respective places of publication.
