In the memorandum WWF has reaffirmed its commitment to provide 1 million US\$ against the estimated total costs of about 4.3 million Yuan (one U.S.Dollar equals 1.52 Yuan in last December) needed for the capital construction of six items for the panda center listed in the action plan. "The balance of these costs will be provided by the Chinese side through self fundraising."

The China Building Engineering Corporaation (also known as the China Construction Machinery Corporation), which contracts for construction work in foreign countries, has completed 21 construction projects in North Yemen, Kuwait and other countries since its founding. These projects represent a part of the 109 contracts signed by the corporation with foreign customers. The 109 contracts cover such work as designing, construction and equipment installation. All of the 21 buildings have been completed and turned over to customers for use either at or prior to the time prescribed. The China Building Engineering Corporation is an organization established in early 1979 exlusively for undertaking construction projects in foreign countries. There are also six branch offices of the corporation in North Yemen, Iraq, Kuwait, Thailand, Hongkong and Macao. In the past two years the corporation has signed 15 long-term cooperation agreements with contractors in Kuwait, Sudan, Italy, Japan and the USA. It has also made joint investments with businessmen in North Yemen, Hongkong, Macao and other places in six companies that undertake building engineering and real-estate deals. (XNA, Mar 21, 1981)

Congo

The Chinese and Congolese governments signed a protocol on 21st March on the Chinese government continuing to dispatch medical teams to Congo. The cooperation in medical work and public health between China and congo started in 1967. The Chinese government has since sent a total of six medical teams. (Beijing Radio, Mar 23, 1981)

A study for doctors and medical personnel to go to Congo and Gabon recently began in Tianjin. After six months of trainthey will be formed into two medical teams and will leave for Congo and Gabon in September to provide free medical services there. (Tianjin Radio, Mar 1, 1981)

The first Chinese medical team arrived in Jibouti on February 22 in accordance with an agreement signed in July 1980 (XNA, Mar 30, 1981)

Moroco

A Chinese medical team of ten experts on treating extensive burns and replantation of severed limbs arrived in Meknes. This is the first Chinese medical team of its kind sent abroad. Under a protocol signed last year the team will stay in Moroco for two years and help train Moroccan doctors. (XNA, Mar 21, 1981)

A Chinese economic and technical survey team was received by Prime Minister Iambakey Okuk (XNA, Mar 31, 1981)

Four new pumping wells sunk by Chinese technicians have recently gone into operation. (XNA, Mar 3, 1981)

Somalia

The Balewen (Beletwen?) rice farm, located near Jowhar, capital of the Middle Shabelle Region, was constructed with Chinese assistance. To the farm belong a pumping station, a grain processing plant, a storehouse, farm machinery and the administration office. The farm recently reaped a good harvest on its 48 hectares of experimental paddy fields. Output per hectare was 4,320 kilogrammes. (XNA, Mar 5, 1981)
