According to Reuter, the International Monetary Fund announced that it will again extend loans to China totalling 381,000,000 dollars at a rate of interest of 0.5% repayable over ten years.

Both will cooperate in the training of tourist personnel, the agreement says. The agreement is valid for five years.

Botswana

The state-owned farm in Maun, Ngamiland District constructed with Chinese assistance reaped a bumper harvest this year. (XNA, Apr 25, 1981)

Congo

A new rice species which is drought-resistant and less vulnerable to pests has proved to be cultivable in Congolese climate conditions. The new species was the work of Chinese and Congolese agronomists who made joint experiments at Kombé state farm which was constructed with Chinese assistance in 1971. (XNA, Apr 8, 1981)

Nigeria

China is to send a team of experts to Nigeria to assist in planning, designing and constructing boreholes for drinking water in the upper Benue river basin development authority's area of Bauchi State. (XNA, Apr 9, 1981)

Pakistan

In Baluchistan coal-fired power stations are proposed to be

set up to save other sources of energy. A team from China has already carried out a feasibility study for the setting up of such power stations, and initially has recommended the setting up of a 30 MW thermal power station in the Duki area of Loralai District. The Water and Power Development Authority has prepared a proposal for the survey and feasibility study for such power stations in the province. (Karachi Radio, Apr 5, 1981; cit. SWB/W 1129)

Togo

The fourth Chinese medical team was replaced by the fifth (XNA, Apr 17, 1981)

Yemen, Arab Republic

The Chinese Shanxi Province water conservancy survey team left for home after completing its eight-month mission after surveying 240 spots in seven provinces of the country and selecting 28 spots as possible sites for water conservancy projects. The Yemeni government is undertaking small projects on two of these spots. (XNA, Apr 26, 1981)

Known Cadres on New Posts**Chen Huangmei 陈荒煤**

Identified as vice-minister of culture (XNA, Apr 11, 1981) Before the Cultural Revolution Chen had served in the same position. Reactivated in 1979 he has since also been a vice-chairman of the Writers' Union and a council member of the Chinese Pen Centre.

Han Kehua 韩克华

Identified as director of the General Administrative Bureau for Travel and Tourism (XNA, Apr 4, 1981) Han served mainly in the diplomatic service. He held ambassadorial posts in Hungary (1964-1967), Guinea (1969-1974), Italy (1974-1977) and France (1977-1980), before he became vice-minister of foreign affairs in March 1980.

Hu Lijiao 胡立教

Elected chairman of the Standing Committee, People's Congress of Shanghai Municipality (XNA, Apr 16, 1981) Hu, a member of the CCP 11th Central Committee, until 1980 served in Henan Province. He came to Shanghai in Feb 1981 to get the post of the 2nd secretary of Shanghai CP. He took over his new position from Yan Youmin who will be transferred to a new post.

Jiao Ruoyu 焦若愚

Elected mayor of Beijing (XNA, Apr 28, 1981) Jiao had been appointed acting mayor in Jan 1981 (see C.a. 1981/1)

Ngapoi Ngawang Jigmi 阿沛阿旺晋美

Appointed chairman of the People's Government of Tibet Autonomous Region (XNA, Apr 30, 1981) Ngapoi had been chairman of the People's Congress of Tibet

before, a position he held only per nomina as he was bound to Beijing in his function of vice-chairman of the NPC. His new position in Tibet, which is equivalent to the post of a governor in the provinces, will bring him back home. In his new position he succeeds Tian Bao who got a new position as vice-governor of Sichuan Province.

Sai Feng 塞风

Identified as vice-minister of geology (XNA, Apr 9, 1981) From 1960 until 1962 Sai had been deputy director of the Beijing College for Building Construction.

Shi Yichen 石一宸

Identified as deputy commander of Fuzhou Military Region (Fuzhou Radio, Apr 11, 1981) In 1971 Shi was identified as a cadre of Fujian Military District. Since 1977 he has been a member of the Standing Committee, CP Committee of Fuzhou Military Region.

Tian Bao 天宝

Elected vice-governor of Sichuan Province (Chengdu Radio, Apr 24, 1981)

Tian is one of the two Tibetan members of the CCP 11th Central Committee (the other is Basang). He had been chairman of the Tibet Government before, a position equivalent to that of a governor in the provinces. Tian now goes back to Sichuan, where he had been vice-governor before the Cultural Revolution, too.

Wang Daohan 汪道涵

Elected mayor of Shanghai (XNA, Apr 16, 1981) Wang was acting mayor of Shanghai before (see C.a. 1980/10)

Wang Jingkun 王景昆

Identified as commander of Jiangsu Military District (Nanchang Radio, Mar 26, 1981)

As a newcomer Wang was elected deputy for the PLA to the 5th NPC in Feb 1978.

Wu Xue 吴雪

Identified as vice-minister of culture (XNA, Apr 5, 1981)
In July 1980 Wu was identified as director of the No.2 Arts Bureau under the Ministry of Culture. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been director of the Youth theater and secretary of the Stage Artists' Association.

Xue Hongfu 薛宏福

Identified as secretary of Ningxia Autonomous Region CP (Yinchuan Radio, Mar 20, 1981)
Xue was deputy secretary before (see C.a. 1978/5)

Yang Bo 杨波

Identified as vice-minister of the State Energy Commission (XNA, Apr 20, 1981)
Since 1979 Yang has also held the position of a vice-minister of the State Planning Commission.

Yang Dongsheng 杨东生

Elected chairman of the People's Congress of the Tibet Autonomous Region (XNA, Apr 30, 1981)
Yang, of Tibetan minority, has held the post of a vice-minister of the Nationalities Affairs Commission since 1979. From 1971 until 1977 he had been secretary of the Tibet CP.

Zhao Qiyang

Identified as vice-minister of culture (XNA, Apr 4, 1981)
In Feb 1966 Zhao led a Beijing Opera troupe to Burma.
