AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Agreement on cultural cooperation

- May 02 **Sierra Leone**
Cultural agreement. It says, the two contracting parties agreed to promote exchanges and cooperation between the two countries in the fields of culture, education, science, public health, sports, publication, the press and broadcasting on the basis of equality and mutual benefit. The agreement also stipulates that the two countries will exchange visits of writers, artists, art troupes, teachers, scholars, athletes and coaches. The two sides agree to grant scholarships to each other's students and encourage students to study in each other's country, to exchange books and other materials, to translate and publish each other's outstanding works of literature and art.

It covers a period of two years. According to the protocol, Turkey will export to the PRC goods worth 65,000,000 dollars within a year. Hazelnuts and tobacco comprise the most significant items to be exported. The hazelnut exports will total 10-20,000,000 dollars and tobacco exports will reach 10,000,000 dollars. Apart from this, pistachio nut exports should total 1,000,000 dollars, worry beads 2,000,000 dollars, borax 1,000,000 dollars, and olive oil 1,000,000 dollars. All exports should earn 65,000,000 dollars. The goods Turkey will import from the PRC will generally consist of chemicals and industrial products.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Jordan

The China Aero-technology Import and Export Corporation has signed an agreement to build part of a residential area near Amman. The agreement, worth 50 million U.S.\$, was signed with the Housing Corporation of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan after international bidding. The Abu-Nuseir residential area, 14 kilometers north of the Jordanian capital, is to provide 0.7 million square meters of floor space and will be built in two stages. The Chinese Corporation will build 1,523 apartments in the first stage with 184,000 square meters of floor space. A French Company has also contracted to help with this stage.

Morocco

The ground-breaking ceremony for a sports complex in Rabat took place on May 6th, 1981. The project was designed by Chinese experts and will be constructed with the help of China in accordance with a China-Morocco agreement signed in 1975. With a total space of 80 hectares, the complex is located in the suburbs of Rabat. It has a stadium with a seating capacity of 60,000 people and a gymnasium for 8,000.

The third Chinese medical team left Rabat for its work site in Taza. The team arrived in Rabat from Shanghai on 29th April.

Nepal

The 36-kilometer long Narayanghat-mugling Highway which

opened to traffic recently, is a part of the Narayanghat-gorkha Road under construction. The completed section with a total of 19 small and medium-sized bridges, 184 culverts and 226 protecting walls of more than 10,000 meters long and 2 to 10 meters high took the Chinese experts and the Nepalese workers more than three years of hard work. It links Nepal's industrial cities in the South and the Kathmandu-Pokhara Highway in Central Nepal. It is of great significance for developing the country's national economy.

Nigeria

The Wuhan Iron and Steel Company, Hubei, has sold a whole set of steel mill equipment to the (Asaba) iron and steel company of Nigeria. The set includes an electric furnace with an annual capacity of 50,000 tons of steel, a set of rolling equipment and an accessory air compressor workshop, a small repair plant and a transformer plant. The Wuhan Company will also provide the Nigerian company with the necessary experts, engineers and technicians.

Known Cadres on New Posts

Dai Suli 戴苏里

Identified as acting governor of Henan Province (Zhengzhou Radio, May 2, 1981).

Dai, an alternate member of the CCP 11th Central Committee, had been vice-governor before.

Feng Depei 冯德培

Elected vice-president of the Academy of Sciences and its Biology Department (XNA, May 19, 20, 1981).

The neurophysiologist Feng is also director of the Shanghai Institute of Physiology of the Academy of Sciences and vice-president of this academy's Shanghai Branch.

Hao Shengwang 郝盛旺

Identified as commander of Guangdong Military District (Guangzhou Radio, Apr 28, 1981).

Hao, a PLA general-major, had been on the same post from 1965 until Cultural Revolution. He was reactivated only now.

Li Xun 李薰

Elected vice-president of the Academy of Sciences and director of its Department of Technical Sciences (XNA, May 19, 20, 1981).

Li, who returned from the U.S.A. to China in 1951, has been president of the Shenyang Branch of the Academy of Sciences since 1980.

Lu Jiaxi 卢嘉锡

Elected president of the Academy of Sciences (XNA, May 19, 1981).

Lu held the following posts before: Director of the Chemistry Department, Beijing University of Science and Technology; director of the Fujian Institute of the Structure of the matter under the Academy of Sciences; vice-president of Fuzhou University; and vice-chairman of the Standing Committee, People's Congress of Fujian Province.

Mou Haixiu 牟海秀

Appointed vice-governor of Zhejiang Province (Hangzhou Radio, May 21, 1981).

Mou was vice-governor of Sichuan Province before.

Song Shaowen 宋邵文

Identified as vice-minister of the Commission for Machine Building Industry (XNA, May 24, 1981).

Before the Cultural Revolution Song had been vice-chairman of the Economic Commission, Capital Construction Commission and Planning Commission. He was reactivated last year.

Tu Guangzhi 涂光炽

Elected director of the Department of Earth Sciences under the Academy of Sciences (XNA, May 20, 1981).
Nothing had been known of Tu before he was elected deputy for Guizhou Province to the 5th NPC in February 1978.

Yan Dongsheng 严东生

Elected director of the Chemistry Department, Academy of Sciences (XNA, May 20, 1981).
Since 1980 Yan has been vice-president of the Shanghai Science and Technology University and director of the Shanghai Silicate Chemistry Technology Institute of the Academy of Sciences.

Ye Duzheng 叶笃正

Elected vice-president of the Academy of Sciences; identified as director of the Institute of Atmospheric Physics under this academy (XNA, May 19, 1981).

Zhang Longxiang 张龙翔

Appointed president of the Beijing University (XNA, May 29, 1981).

Zhang who received his doctorate of philosophy from Toronto University, Canada, in the early 1940's was referred to the Chinese media only after the Cultural Revolution. In 1978 he was identified as vice-president of Beijing University and the following year as vice-president of the Biochemistry Society.

New Cadres**Li Ming**

Identified as vice-minister of finance (XNA, May 8, 1981).
Li perhaps is identical with the Li Ming referred to as deputy director of the General Administration of Civil Administration from 1978 until 1979, when he disappeared.

Li Tianjun
