Contract between Chengdu Municipality in Sichuan Province and Kenya on Chinese aid to build a large national sports center in Nairobi. It will include athletes' living quarters and an indoor swimming pool.

Equatorial Guinea

Under construction is the Bikomo hydroelectric power station. Works on this project started in 1976.

Sierra Leone

The sugar refinery built with Chinese aid in Mamunta was handed over (XNA, Feb 28, 1982). Works had started in 1977. The refinery has a capacity of crushing 400 tons of sugarcane per day for white granulated sugar.

Zambia

The textile mill, under construction in Kabwe since 1979, after completion will have a capacity of 9.1 million meters of cloth annually.

Known Cadres on New Posts**Chen Xian 陈先**

Identified as vice-minister, Physical Culture and Sports Commission (XNA, Feb 12, 1982)
Chen was president of the Table Tennis Association from 1973 until 1978 and holds the post of a vice-president of the Sports Federation since 1979.

Deng Zhaoxiang 邓兆祥

Identified as deputy commander of the PLA Navy (Jinan Radio, Jan 25, 1982)
In February 1949 Deng went over to the Communist with the cruiser "Chongqing" whose commandant he was. Since 1962 he held the post of deputy commander of the North China Sea Fleet under the PLA Navy. He is now eighty years old.

Guo Chunyuan 郭春原

Identified as secretary of Tianjin Municipality CP (Tianjin Radio, Jan 23, 1982)
Guo also is a vice-mayor of Tianjin since May 1980 (on this post already before the Cultural Revolution).

Li Kaixin 李开汶

Identified as vice-minister of the State Planning Commission (XNA, Jan 28, 1982)
Since 1976 Li also holds the post of director of the State Bureau of Supplies. Before the Cultural Revolution he was a vice-minister of the State Economic Commission.

Tian Shixing 田世兴

Identified as deputy commander of Fuzhou Military Region (Fuzhou Radio, Jan 22, 1982)
Tian became known when he was elected deputy for the PLA in Feb 1978.

Wang Luming 王政明

Identified as secretary of Heilongjiang Province CP (Harbin Radio, Feb 5, 1982)
Wang was a deputy secretary before. Since 1979 he also is a vice-governor of Heilongjiang.

Wang Qun

Identified as secretary of Hubei Province CP and as 1st secretary of Wuhan Municipality CP (Wuhan Radio, Feb 20, 1982)
In 1978 Wang could be identified as secretary of the Hubei Branch of the Communist Youth League and some time later deputy secretary of Hubei CP.

Xiang Nan

Zhao Boping 赵伯平

Identified as vice-minister of the State Family Planning Commission (Xian Radio, Feb 25, 1982)
Before the Cultural Revolution Zhao

was an alternate member of the CCP 8th Central Committee and governor of Shaanxi Province. Purged in 1967 he was reactivated only in 1978 without receiving a new position until now.

Zheng Xiaoxian 郑校先

Identified as vice-governor of Jiangxi Province (Nanchang Radio, Feb 12, 1982)

Zheng held these positions before: Vice-chairman, Revolutionary Committee of Qinghai Province (1977-1979) and vice-governor of Qinghai the following time until Apr 1981.

New Cadres

Deng Ken

Identified as vice-governor of Hubei Province (Wuhan Radio, Feb 9, 1982) It is said that Deng is a brother of Deng Xiaoping.

Ding Changda

Appointed vice-governor of Sichuan Province (Chengdu Radio, Dec 26, 1981)

Feng Ji

Identified as vice-minister of commerce (XNA, Feb 17, 1982)

Yuan Jun

Identified as deputy commander of Shenyang Military Region (XNA, Jan 28, 1982)

Deceased Cadres

Wang Guanlan 王观澜

Died Jan 19, 1982 (XNA, Feb 13, 1982)

His last position was member of the Standing Committee of the 5th NPC.

Yang Kaizhi

Died Jan 26, 1982 (Changsha Radio, Feb 4, 1982)

Yang was the brother of Yang Kaihui, Mao Zedong's first wife.
