


Five-year agricultural cooperation and exchange programme. The record says China and Australia will cooperate and exchange technical information on crop production, seed cultivation, grassland management and improvement, livestock breeding and management, prevention and treatment of animal and plant disease and pests, agricultural mechanization, soil preservation and land improvement, tree seed improvement, forest management, timber production and utilization, agriculture and forestry education. Jun 04 Denmark, Finland, Great Britain, Norway, Sweden

Agreement between the China International Trust and Investment Corporation (CITIC) and the London-based Nordic Bank Limited for the purpose of promoting and assisting cooperation between local authorities, departments and legal entities in the People's Republic of China and commercial and industrial corporations in the United Kingdom and the four Nordic countries - Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden. The agreement says that all parties to this agreement will make efforts to encourage both commercial and industrial cooperation between Chinese entities and companies in the Banks' respective countries in the spirit of mutual benefit and friendly coopera-tion towards assisting the realisation of the eco-nomic goals of the People's Republic of China. The agreement defines the area of cooperation such as the exchange of information and the identification of projects, and the Bank, in its role as middleman, will be involved in putting together funds to pro-vide the financial support for certain projects and investments. Jun 07 Pakistan

Border trade protocol. Under the protocol, the two countries are to exchange commodities worth 8,800,000 rupees during the next fiscal year. Cotton and woollen products, synthetic cloth, cigarettes, razor blades and leather goods will be exported from Pakistan, while China will supply tea, cotton and woollen cloth, chinaware, hardware and agricultural equipment. Development Fund The IFAD offered a loan of 35 million US\$ to China the modernization of livestock farming in northern grassland. The loan is on favourable terms. The Chinese side is to pay only an annual one-per cent service fund to IFAD. The total loan will be repaid in 50 years. XNA, Jun 12, 1981

Jun 16 U.S.A.

Exchange of notes on establishing additional consulates-general. As provided in the agreement, China will set up additional consulates-general in New York, Chicago and Honolulu, and the United States will set up additional consulates-general in Shenyang, Wuhan and Chengdu. Jun 20 Yugoslavia

Three-year executive plan for educational and cultural cooperation. The executive plan stipulates for the exchange of 20 university scholarships each year for undergraduates and postgraduates, and calls for direct cooperation of universities and other educational, scientific and research organizations, covering exchange of university professors and cooperation in scientific research and information. The plan also specifies exchanges of culture, art, science, journalism and sports. XNA, Jun 20, 1981

Agreement on cooperation (China established relations with UNICEF in 1979. The organization has provided China with aid of 7 million US\$ for medical and cultural purposes.) XNA, Jun 22, 1981

Minutes of the first meeting of the China-Japan Committee for Scientific and Technological Cooperation XNA, Jun 24, 1981

Jun 24

Korea, NorthProtocol on cooperation in teaching and scientific research. The two sides decided to expand and exchange lectures, students, the study of teaching science as well as textbooks, teaching programs and plans. XNA, Jun 24, 1981

Trade protocol. Under the new protocol, China will export to Pakistan steel items including billets, pig iron and tools while Pakistan will export to China cotton yarn, textile goods and leather manufactures. XNA, Jun 24, 1981

Jun 26 France

Cooperation agreement between the Biological Department of the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the French National Institute of Health and Medical Research was signed here today. The agreement provides for exchange of visits between medical researchers of the two countries, particularly in the fields of neurophysiology, neurobiology, immunology, molecularbiology, cellular genetics and pharmacology. Addendum May 1981

May 26 Sweden

Cooperation agreement between the China International Trust and Investment Corporation and the Svenska Handelsbanken. The agreement stipulates that signatories to the agreement make joint efforts to help the PRC achieve its economic purposes in the spirit of mutual benefit, friendship and cooperation. The China International Trust and Investment

Corporation will provide the Svenska Handelsbanken with information on the cooperation and investment sought by China from other countries. On the basis of such information, the Svenska Handelsbanken will decide on technical cooperation by some Swedish corporations with China.

Nepal

The Gorkha-Mugling section of the Gorkha-Narayanghat road was opened to traffic. This section is $36\ \rm km$ long (the total length will be $59\ \rm km$). The completed section has $19\ \rm small$ and medium-sized bridges, $184\ \rm culverts$ and $226\ \rm protecting$ walls more than $10\ \rm ,000$ metres long and $2\ \rm -10$ metres high. Pakistan

A plant for the manufacture of power cables is to be established at Hab Chauki near Karachi, with Chinese assistance. The installation and erection of the machinery will also be carried out by the China National Machinery Import and Export Corporation. The project, which is estimated to cost 170,000,000 rupees, including a foreign exchange component of 85,000,000 rupees, has already been approved by the Central Investment Promotion Committee.

Known Cadres on New Posts

An Zhiwen

Appointed minister of the 6th Ministry of Machine Building (XNA, Jun 10, 1981) An had been 1st vice-minister of the same ministry before.

Deng Xiaoping

Elected chairman of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jun 29, 1981)
Deng had been vice-chairman of the Commission since July 1977. In his new position he succeeds Hua Guofeng. This is the first time in the history of the CCP that the Party's chairman is not at the same time chairman of its Military Commission.

Fang Zhichun

Identified as vice-chairman of the Standing Committee, People's Congress of Jiangxi Province (Nanching Radio, Jun 11, 1981)

Before the Cultural Revolution Fang had been governor of Jiangxi Province. Reactivated in 1977 he has been a member of the 5th NPC's Standing Committee since 1978 and chairman of the Jiangxi Branch of the CPPCC since March 1981.

Hu Yaobang

Elected chairman of the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jun 29, 1981)

A member of the Politburo and secretary-general of the CCP Central Committee since December 1978, Hu was by-elected member of the Standing Committee of the Politburo in February 1980.

Hua Guofeng

Relieved from his post as chairman and elected vice-chairman of the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jun 29, 1981)

Huang Luobin

Identified as secretary of Xinjiang Autonomous Region CP (Orümqi Radio, Jun 6, 1981) Before the Cultural Revolution Huang had been vice-governor

Before the Cultural Revolution Huang had been vice-governor of Gansu Province. He was reactivated only in February 1981, being identified as a cadre of Xinjiang.

Li Ligong

Identified as permanent secretary of Shanxi Province CP (Taiyuan Radio, Jun 14, 1981) Li had been secretary of Beijing CP before.

Liu Daosheng

Identified as secretary of Beijing Municipality CP (XNA, Jun 9, 1981)
Liu had been member of the Standing Committee of Beijing CP before.

Liu Ruilong

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture (XNA, May 16, 1981)

Liu had been in the same position before the Cultural Revolution. He was reactivated in March 1978 when he was elected member of the Standing Committee of the 5th CPPCC.

Song GuangAppointed vice-president of the Supreme People's Court and director of its Economic Division (XNA, Jun 19, 1981)
Song had been mayor and CP secretary of Shenyang Municipality before.

Wang Huide

Identified as deputy director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jun 8, 1981)
Before the Cultural Revolution Wang had been a member of the RMRB Editorial Department. Reactivated in 1974 he became

director of the Bureau for the Translation of the Works of Marx, Engels, Lenin and Stalin in 1978.

Wang Zhanping

Appointed vice-president of the Supreme People's Court (XNA, Jun 10, 1981)

Before the Cultural Revolution Wang worked in the Supreme People's Procuratorate. Reactivated in 1979 he became a member of the Judicial Committee under the Supreme People's Court.

Xi Zhongxun

Elected member of the Secretariat under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jun 29, 1981); appointed director of the Legal Commission of the NPC Standing Committee (XNA, Jun 10, 1981)

Xi had been vice-premier from 1959 until 1962 when he disappeared. Reactivated in 1978 he became 2nd secretary of Guangdong Province CP in April and 1st secretary in December that year. In December 1979 he was elected governor of Guangdong. In summer 1980 he was ordered to Beijing to become vice-chairman of the 5th NPC.

Xing Zitao

By-elected vice-chairman of the Standing Committee, People's Congress of Zhejiang Province (Hangzhou Radio, May 22, 1981) Before the Cultural Revolution Xing had been secretary of Shenyang Municipality CP. He was reactivated only now.

Yan Jun

Identified as vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technological Commission (XNA, Jun 6, 1981)
In 1962 Yan was identified as director of the Department for Electrical Engineering under the Xian Jiaotong University.

Yu Jiyi

By-elected vice-chairman of the Standing Committee, People's Congress of Zhejiang Province (Hangzhou Radio, May 21, 1981) Before the Cultural Revolution Yu had been director of the United Front Work Department under the Zhejiang CP.

Zhao Ziyang

Elected vice-chairman of the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jun 29, 1981)

Zhao has been a member of the Standing Committee of the Politburo since February, and premier since September, 1980.

Died on June 19, 1981 (XNA, Jun 26, 1981) Chen was a member of the CCP 11th Central Committee and a PLA colonel-general.

Xiang Zhonghua
