## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Five-year agricultural cooperation and exchange programme. The record says China and Australia will cooperate and exchange technical information on crop production, seed cultivation, grassland management and improvement, livestock breeding and management, prevention and treatment of animal and plant disease and pests, agricultural mechanization, soil preservation and land improvement, tree seed improvement, forest management, timber production and utilization, agriculture and forestry education. The programme will be implemented through exchange of technical and other suitable information, exchange of delegations and bilateral seminars and meetings.

Agreement between the China International Trust and Investment Corporation (CITIC) and the London-based Nordic Bank Limited for the purpose of promoting and assisting cooperation between local authorities, departments and legal entities in the People's Republic of China and commercial and industrial corporations in the United Kingdom and the four Nordic countries - Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden. The agreement says that all parties to this agreement will make efforts to encourage both commercial and industrial cooperation between Chinese entities and companies in the Banks' respective countries in the spirit of mutual benefit and friendly cooperation towards assisting the realisation of the economic goals of the People's Republic of China. The agreement defines the area of cooperation such as the exchange of information and the identification of projects, and the Bank, in its role as middleman, will be involved in putting together funds to provide the financial support for certain projects and investments.

Relieved from his post as chairman and elected vice-chairman of the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jun 29, 1981)

**Huang Luobin**

Identified as secretary of Xinjiang Autonomous Region CP (Drumqi Radio, Jun 6, 1981)  
Before the Cultural Revolution Huang had been vice-governor of Gansu Province. He was reactivated only in February 1981, being identified as a cadre of Xinjiang.

**Li Ligong**

Identified as permanent secretary of Shanxi Province CP (Taiyuan Radio, Jun 14, 1981)  
Li had been secretary of Beijing CP before.

**Liu Daosheng**

Identified as secretary of Beijing Municipality CP (XNA, Jun 9, 1981)  
Liu had been member of the Standing Committee of Beijing CP before.

**Liu Ruilong**

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture (XNA, May 16, 1981)  
Liu had been in the same position before the Cultural Revolution. He was reactivated in March 1978 when he was elected member of the Standing Committee of the 5th CPPCC.

Appointed vice-president of the Supreme People's Court (XNA, Jun 10, 1981)

Before the Cultural Revolution Wang worked in the Supreme People's Procuratorate. Reactivated in 1979 he became a member of the Judicial Committee under the Supreme People's Court.

#### Xi Zhongxun

Elected member of the Secretariat under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jun 29, 1981); appointed director of the Legal Commission of the NPC Standing Committee (XNA, Jun 10, 1981)

Xi had been vice-premier from 1959 until 1962 when he disappeared. Reactivated in 1978 he became 2nd secretary of Guangdong Province CP in April and 1st secretary in December that year. In December 1979 he was elected governor of Guangdong. In summer 1980 he was ordered to Beijing to become vice-chairman of the 5th NPC.
