## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Cultural and sports agreement providing for exchanges of writers, artists, art exhibitions, intellectuals, university publications, sports equipment and technical directors.

- Jul 09 Japan**  
The governmental Export-Import Bank of Japan (Eximbank) signed an agreement with China's foreign exchange bank, the Bank of China, to extend seven united loans totalling 42,000 million yen, according to an Eximbank announcement. The agreement was signed under the memoranda exchanged in May 1979 by the two banks in relation to the basic matters of oil and coal resource development loans. Under the notes, the Eximbank is to extend loans to the Bank of China up to about 420,000 million yen to help finance the development of oil and coal resources, and to promote the export of oil and coal thus obtained to Japan.

- Jul 17 Colombia**  
The two countries will accord to each other the most-favored-nation treatment, tariffs which cover imports and exports, internal taxes, customs regulations, formalities and procedures. The agreement is based on equality and mutual benefit with an aim to strengthen trade relations between the two countries. The two sides agreed to set up a trade committee to oversee the implementation of the agreement and to promote the development of trade relations between the two countries.

The contracting parties agree to exchange writers, artists, art groups, sportsmen, teachers and scholars, translate and publish each other's outstanding works of art and literature, provide each other with scholarships and undertake exchange and cooperation in medicine and health, news, broadcasting, television and film making.

Long-term trade summary. According to the summary, the two sides reached agreement on the revised quotas of crude oil China will supply Japan in 1981 and 1982 as provided in the Japan-China long-term trade agreement. The quotas of Chinese crude oil and coal to Japan between 1983 and 1985 will be discussed later.

A cooperation agreement between the Biological Department of the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the French National Institute of Health and Medical Research was signed in Paris. The agreement provides for exchange of visits between medical researchers of the two countries, particularly in the fields of neurophysiology, neurobiology, immunology, molecular biology, cellular genetics and pharmacology.

Pakistan will generally export cotton textiles, yarn, cotton, leather and leather goods; China will provide instruments, workshop equipment, steel, ore, as well as road-building and construction machines. The two sides also reviewed in detail alternative means to expand bilateral trade outside the scope of the agreement.

## CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

**Egypt**

Five Chinese fishery experts were awarded in appreciation of their service in building the Ismailia fishing ground. The Ismailia fishing ground was built in response to the call of President Sadat for the guarantee of food supply. The Chinese group of five specialists arrived in Egypt in spring, 1979 and set to work to build the fishing ground on weedy, saline-alkali soil, working together with Egyptian workers and technicians. The first stage of the project with a fishing pond of 3 million feddans (1 feddan is equal to 0.42 hectares) has been completed. The planned output was 1.5 tons of fish per feddan this year. The second stage of the project is under way. When completed, the fishing ground will cover a total area of 13 million feddans. (XNA, Jul 26, 1981)

It will occupy some 500 hectares, consisting of a 60,008-seat stadium, a 5,000-seat gymnasium a modernized indoor swimming pool, a sportsman dormitory and many other sports facilities and services. The project will be partly financed by a Chinese government loan and built by Chinese engineers and technicians under an agreement signed during the successful state visit to China by Kenyan President Daniel Rap Mao last September. This is the first Chinese aid project for Kenya. President Moi personally examined and approved the sketch design on last May 21. With the close cooperation of the Kenyan side, the Chinese experts have completed the tasks of site-choosing, data-collecting and designing of the main items of the project. (XNA, Jul 23, 1981)

**Kenya**

Chinese experts fulfilled the survey and design work on a sports complex. The Kenyan national sports complex under designing is a large-scale project to be situated in Kasarani, 10 kilometres from the Kenyan capital of Nairobi.

**Upper Volta**

On July 18 the foundation stone was laid for the building of a comprehensive stadium in Ouagadougou. It will accommodate 35,000 spectators. (XNA, Jul 19, 1981)

## PERSONAL DATA

**Known Cadres on New Posts****Chai Shufan** 柴树藩

Identified as vice-minister of the State Planning Commission (XNA, Jul 6, 1981)

Chai held the same position from 1959 until 1965. Reactivated in 1973 he then had been vice-minister of foreign trade (until 1977) and minister of the 6th Ministry of Machine Building (1978 until June 1980). Since April 1981 he also holds the position of the chairman of the China Corporation of Shipbuilding Industry.

**Chen Guang** 陈光

Identified as vice-minister of civil affairs (XNA, Jul 30, 1981)

(Chen probably holds this position since January 1981.) Before the Cultural Revolution he had been secretary of Jiangsu Province CP. He was reactivated in January 1978 to be elected vice-chairman of the Jiangsu Revolutionary Committee, a post he held until February 1979.

**Ding Yuan** 丁原

Appointed vice-minister of building materials (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

In 1958 he was identified as director of the Bureau for Glass and Ceramics Industry under the Ministry of Building Construction.

**Fu Jize** 傅继泽

Identified as deputy commander of the PLA Navy (XNA, Jul 14, 1981)

Fu, who is a rear-admiral, had been deputy chief of staff of the PLA Navy before the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in 1980 he is commander of the South China Sea Fleet since.

**Gao Tie** 高铁

Appointed vice-minister of building materials (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

In 1965 Gao became president of the Harbin Technical University to be purged soon later. He was reactivated as vice-president of the Beijing University in 1978.

**Hu Qili** 胡启立

Identified as secretary of Tianjin Municipality CP (Tianjin Radio, Jul 2, 1981)

A youth cadre before the Cultural Revolution he became vice-president of the Qinghua University in 1978 and chairman of the Youth Federation the following year to be elected mayor of Tianjin Municipality in June 1980.

**Huang Demao** 黄德懋

Identified as deputy commander of the Kunming Military Region (Kunming Radio, Jun 30, 1981)

(Huang possibly holds this post since February 1980.) He became known when he was elected deputy for the PLA to the 5th NPC in February 1978.

**Li Shuzheng (f)** 李淑铮

Identified as deputy director of the International Liaison Department under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jul 10, 1981)

Li held the same position in the Communist Youth League before the Cultural Revolution. She was reactivated as secretary of the Women's Federation in 1978 and would be identified as a bureau director in the International Liaison Department in April 1980.

**Liu Guoguang** 刘国光

Appointed deputy director of the State Statistical Bureau (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

In 1980 Liu was identified as professor of the Beijing University and as deputy of the Institute of Economics under the Academy of Social Sciences.

**Lu Xuzhang** 卢绪章

Identified as vice-minister of the Administrative Commission of Import and Export Affairs (XNA, Jul 6, 1981)

From 1956 until Cultural Revolution Lu was vice-minister of foreign trade. He was reactivated in 1976 and became director of the General Administration for Travel and Tourism in 1979.

**Ren Puzhai 任朴斋**

Appointed vice-minister of building materials (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

A cadre in the Ministry of Building Construction before the Cultural Revolution he became vice-minister of that ministry until 1975 when it was dissolved. In 1978 he became vice-minister of the State Capital Construction Commission, a position he possibly still holds.

**Wang Huaiyi 王怀义**

Appointed vice-minister of building materials (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

A person of the same name had been secretary of Fushun Municipality CP before the Cultural Revolution.

**Yang Shangkun 杨尚昆**

Identified as secretary-general of the Military Commission under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Jul 29, 1981)

In this position Yang succeeds Geng Biao who became minister of national defense in March this year. Most remarkable is the fact, that Yang is a non-military cadre, which hints to the leadership's intention to bring the PLA under a perfect Party control.

Before the Cultural Revolution Yang had been a member the CCP 8th Central Committee, an alternate member of its secretariat and a member of the Standing Committee of the 3rd NPC. Reactivated in 1978 he became 1st secretary of the Guangzhou Municipality CP and 2nd secretary of the Guangdong Province CP the following year in which he was also by-elected member of the CCP 11th Central Committee. In September 1980 he was by-elected vice-chairman and secretary-general of the 5th NPC.

**Yu Yichuan 于一川**

Identified as secretary of Henan Province CP (Zhengzhou Radio, Jul 6, 1981)

Yu has been deputy secretary before.

**Zhao Yinhua 赵荫华**

Appointed vice-minister of the State Economic Commission (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

Zhao has been director of a department of that commission before.

**Zhou Zijian 周子健**

Identified as secretary of Anhui Province CP (Hefei Radio, Jul 23, 1981)

Zhou, an alternate member of the CCP 11th Central Committee, was appointed governor of Anhui Province in March this year (see C.a., 81/3)

**New Cadres****Cui Naifu 崔乃夫**

Appointed vice-minister of civil affairs (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

**Du Enxun 杜恩训**

Appointed vice-minister of building materials (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

**Hu Baihua**

Identified as deputy commander of the Kunming Military Region (Kunming Radio, Jun 30, 1981)

**Li Fakui**

Identified as vice-president of the Bank of China

**Liu Kun 刘昆**

Appointed vice-minister of the State Economic Commission (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

**Pan Youge 潘友哥**

Appointed vice-minister of civil affairs (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

**Yue Song 岳嵩**

Appointed vice-minister of civil affairs (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

**Changes in China's Diplomatic Service****Hou Dezhang 侯德章**

Appointed consul-general to Alexandria, Arab Republic of Egypt (XNA, Jul 15, 1981)

From 1972 until 1975 Hou had been chargé d'affaires ad interim in Algeria.

**Liu Fu 刘溥**

Identified as ambassador to Liberia (XNA, Jul 9, 1981)

Former positions:
