AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

U.S.A. (Oct 01)

Agreement on the U.S. Export-Import Bank credit to the Bank of China (this is the first U.S. official credit to China). Under the agreement, the U.S. Export-Import Bank will lend to the Bank of China 28,417,500 dollars for financing the acquisition in the United States and exportation to the People's Republic of China of U.S. boiler components, air preheaters and related services. Meanwhile, the First National Bank of Chicago and the Bank of China signed a 3,789,000-dollar private financing agreement for the same purpose. The expiry date of the credits is May 31, 1987.

Colombia (Oct 01)

Cultural agreement. Under it, the two parties undertake to strengthen exchange and cooperation in art, education, social sciences, physical culture, press, broadcasting, television, film and other cultural fields. The agreement remains effective for five years.

France (Oct 02)

Cultural exchange programme for 1982-1983. The program stipulated furtherance of exchanges and cooperation between the two countries in culture, education, social sciences, broadcast, TV, books, arts and sports. In 1982, reproductions of Chind's Dunhuang Murals will be on display in France, exhibits of the Versailles Palace and the Louvre Palace will go to China for show, and artists of the two countries will exchange performance tours. China and France will send education delegations to visit each other. France will strengthen cooperation with Chind's Wuhan University. China will hold book exhibitions in France next year.

Romania (Oct 02)

1982-1983 plan for cooperation between the China-Romania Association and the Romania-China Friendship Association. According to the plan, the two associations agree to send delegations of friendship associations, sponsor countries' National Day celebrations, other commemoration activities, and exhibitions, and exchange pictures, films and other references.

Nigeria (Oct 02)

Protocols on economic and technical cooperation. Under them China will continue to help Nigeria construct boreholes for drinking water in the Upper Benue River Basin and a team of Chinese technicians will be sent to Odo-Ekoe, Anambra State, to develop agricultural projects.

XNA, Oct 2, 1981

Australia (Oct 02)

Agreement on a programme of technical cooperation for development. Australia will provide assistance to China worth about 50,000,000 Australian dollars over the next 10 years. Of the six major areas of technical assistance now under final discussion, most will involve the exchange of personnel for training and advice. Only a small proportion of the aid money will be spent on equipment.

Agreement on the design for a 30,000,000-shilling sports complex to be built on the outskirts of Nairobi.

Agreement for the continuation of the German-Chinese cultural exchange programme in 1982 and 1983. Under it, priority was given again to the sciences, higher education and language teaching.

Draft agreement on the mutual protection of investments

Australia (Oct 16)

Cultural exchange programme for 1982-1983. Under the program, the two sides are to have exchanges in culture, art, education, books, publishing, the press, broadcasting, film, television, sports and social sciences and to exchange visits. The two governments will also encourage cultural exchanges between non-governmental organizations in the two countries so as to further friendship between the two peoples.

China will send a full-scale Peking opera troupe to Australia in 1983 and Australia will send a theatrical performing group to China in 1982. The agreement covers a wide range of exchanges embracing the visual arts, music, education and the media. A major budget item on the Australian side is support for Radio Australia's English language teaching broadcasts to China due to begin next year.

Ethiopia

A water project providing 18,000 residents with drinking water has been completed in four towns of Ethiopia's Shoa Province with the help of Chinese technical assistance. More than 250,000 people residing in 23 towns of seven regions have gained access to drinking water since the launching of the water project. Similar schemes are in progress in the towns of Ghinchi and Sendafa in Shoa Province and will be made operational shortly.

Kenya

On Oct 2, 1981 a design contract for the construction of the Kenya National Sports Complex was signed. The sports complex to be built with the design of Chinese experts at Kasarani in Nairobi includes a stadium with 60,000 seats, a gymnasium with 5,000 seats, a swimming facility with 2,000 seats and a 200-bed hostel for athletes. The design of the complex will be undertaken in conformity with the standards required by the International Olympic Association.

Madagascar

15 Chinese technicians received medals on Oct 3, 1981 for their participation in the Toly enterprise. The Toly enterprise is a newly constructed farm machinery repair plant which has seven factories throughout the country. The machines for repairing farm machinery were imported from China and financed with loans from China.

A 300,000-tonne Sino-Maltese friendship dock officially opened on Friday in Malta's Grand Harbour with a 260,000-tonne ship sailing into the dock and three helicopters flying above in the sky. Construction began in January, 1975 and was completed in September, 1980, with the aid from China and the participation of Chinese technicians, after overcoming many difficulties caused by complicated geological conditions.
