Venezuela (Nov 01)

1. Cultural agreement. According to it, the contracting parties will work to promote cooperation and exchanges in the fields of culture, the art, education, sports, the press, broadcasting, film and television.

2. Agreement on science and technology. It provides that the two sides will cooperate in science and technology in the spirit of friendship, equality and mutual benefit.

Nepal (Nov 22)

Trade and payments agreement. It will replace the 1974 agreement. Total volume between China and Nepal in 1980 increased to 10.3 million U.S.dollars from 5.8 million U.S.dollars in 1978.

Protocol on the 34th meeting of the Board of Directors of the China-Korea Yalu River hydro-electric Power Company.

Protocol of the 4th session on scientific and technical cooperation.

Comores

Chinese technicians are constructing a diversion works in Nioumakele Region. The project includes seven dams, 18 reservoirs and a 60-kilometer canal. After completion it will supply drinking water for 26 densely populated villages.

China presented 657 cases of medicine and medical instruments. The gift totals 82,000 MF.

Morocco

The 3rd Chinese medical team working in the Settat provincial hospital left for home on 22nd November at the end of its term of work.

Nepal

The Nepalese prime minister on 20th November laid the foundation stone for the Pokhara water conservancy and irrigation project to be constructed by China and Nepal jointly. Construction of the project comes under an agreement signed by China and Nepal in Kathmandu in 1977. The project is composed of two parts - an irrigation system including an 80-metre-long and 4-metre-high dam, a 7.8-kilometre-long canal, 26 branch canals and a number of aqueducts and sluices; and a small power station with a generating capacity of 1500 kw. Upon its completion, the project can provide irrigation for 750 hectares of farmland and electricity for Pokhara - a fast tourism-developing city in the country.

A Chinese gift of medicine and medical instruments worth 20,000,000 CFA francs was presented on 4th November.

Yemen, Arab Republic

The Mokha-Mufrak highway, the first project undertaken by Chinese workers in North Yemen, was completed in 430 days. The 44-kilometer-long highway starts from the southern port of Mokha and, running eastward inland, links up with the Taiz-Hodeida highway. It cuts 140 kilometers by car from Taiz, the main city in the south, to Port Mokha off the Red Sea, and is thus of strategic and economic significance.

Elected vice-governor of Qinghai Province (XNA, Nov 7, 1981)
Ban belongs to the Tibetan minority.

Chen Heqiao

Identified as political commissar of the PLA 2nd Artillery Corps (Beijing Radio, Nov 7, 1981)
Chen is a major-general. Before the Cultural Revolution he served in Kunming Military Region and later as political commissar of the PLA Signal Corps.

Guo Ruozhen

Elected vice-chairman of the Standing Committee, People's Congress of Qinghai Province (Xian Radio, No 9, 1981)
From 1979 until October this year Guo held the post of director of the United Front Work Department under Qinghai Province CP.

Han Fucai

Elected vice-governor of Qinghai Province (XNA, Nov 7, 1981)
Han, who belongs to the Hui minority, was elected deputy for Qinghai Province in Feb 1978.

Li Shuiqing

Identified as commander of the PLA 2nd Artillery Corps (Beijing Radio, Nov 7, 1981)
