

Supervisory service agreement and the conditions of contract for the China-Japan friendship hospital construction project. XNA, Dec 1, 1981

Japan (Dec 16)

Notes exchange on the extension of 300,000 million yen of financial assistance to complete the first phase of the Daqing petrochemical complex and the Baoshan steelworks, construction of which had been suspended owing to a shortage of funds. The long term, low interest loan is made up of 130,000 million yen of commodity credits, 100,000 million yen of suppliers' credits and 70,000 million yen of syndicated loans from Japanese commercial banks.

Turkey (Dec 19)

Agreement on economic, industrial and technical cooperation. Under the agreement, China and Turkey shall promote and facilitate by taking appropriate measures the economic, industrial and technical cooperation between the two countries on the basis of equality and mutual benefit. Possible fields of cooperation include industry, agriculture, tourism and services, trade and joint ventures. Both parties agree to establish a mixed commission consisting of ministers or vice-ministers concerned or representatives appointed by them respectively. The commission shall meet annually to review the development of economic, industrial and technical cooperation between the two countries and identify new fields of cooperation. XNA, Dec 19, 1981

Uganda

An ice-making plant built in Kampala with Chinese aid was handed over. (XNA, Dec 18, 1981) The United Nations Development Program recently awarded a 491,915-dollar contract to China National Machinery Corporation of Tianjin for the supply of 250,000 hoe blades to Uganda. Liu Gan 刘 孝 Elected vice-chairman of the Standing Committee, People's Congress of Shandong Province (Jinan Radio, Dec 28, 1981)

Liu is a deputy of Shandong to the 5th NPC and, in Aug 1980, he was identified as director of the Economic Research Institute under the Tianjin Municipality Academy of Social Scien-CPS.

Liu Jie

Liu Jie 刻 杰, Elected chairman of the Standing Committee, People's Congress of Henan Province (Zhengzhou Radio, Jan 1,

Since Jan 1981 Liu holds the post of 1st secretary of Henan CP. From Sep 1979 until Dec 1981 he was governor of Henan Province.

Lu Xuzhang 绪 Identified as vice-minister of foreign trade (XNA, Dec 8, 1981) Lu held this post already from 1956 until the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in 1976 he became director of the International Travel Service in 1978, director of the General Administration for Travel and Tourismus in 1979 (until Oct 1980), vice-minister of the Administrative Commission on Import and Export Affairs in July 1981, and vice-minister of the Foreign Investment Commission two months later.

Wang Baoming 王 保 明 Elected vice-chairman of the Standing Committee, People's Congress of Shandong Province (Jinan Radio, Dec 28, 1981)

Wang possibly is identical with a person of that name who was elected deputy for the PLA to the 5th NPC in Feb 1978.

王金山 Wang Jinshan Appointed vice-governor of Shandong Province (Jinan Radio, Dec 28, 1981) Wang is an alternate member of the CCP 11th Central Committee. From 1977 until spring 1981 he was a secretary of Hebei Province CP.

Wu Boshan

Appointed chairman of the Investment Bank; identified as vice-minister of finance (XNA, Dec 23, 1981)
Wu is a newcomer.

Zeng Qun

Identified as vice-minister of light industry (XNA, Dec 12, 1981)
Zeng is a newcomer.

Zhao Chuqi 夫 妃 琪 Identified as secretary of Hunan Province CP (Changsha Radio, Dec 2, 1981)

Thao held the same post from Oct 1977 until mid-1978 when he was identified as secretary of Gansu Province CP as which he was last mentioned in March 1981.

Zhao Fasheng 赵 发 生 Identified as vice-minister of food (XNA, Nov 7, 1981) Zhao held the same position from 1959 until Cultural Revolution. From 1972 until 1977 he was a vice-minister of commerce.

Zhu Xuefan 朱 学 苑 Elected vice-chairman of the NPC Standing Committee (XNA, Dec 13, 1981)

Zhu was minister of posts and telecommunications from 1960 until the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in Feb 1978 he became vice-president of the Federation of Trade Unions two months later. This post he held until now.

Deceased Cadre

Zhang was a member of the CCP Central Committee since 1928. From 1959 until Cultural Revolution he was chief procurator of the Supreme People's Proucatorate.
