



A ceremony for the delivering of the Chinese aid project of field improvement in the plain of M'pourie was held on April 11, 1980. The construction of the project, situated in Traza-Region, Southern Mauritania started in February 1972 and was completed last year. It included the reclamation of 1,000 hectars of fields, the establishment of an irrigation and drainage pumping station, and the digging of a 194 kilometer long trunk canal and branch (XNA, Apr 11, 1980) (800400230)

Tanzania

Elected vice-governor of Jilin Province (XNA, Apr 6, 1980).

Before the Cultural Revolution Dong had been for Hebei Province to the 1st NPC and since 1957 secretary of the Trade Unions. He disappeared in 1963 and was reactivated only now.

杜义德 Du Yide

Identified as commander of Lanzhou Military

Region (Lanzhou Radio, Apr 17, 1980).

Du is a member of the CCP 11th Central Committee and a PLA vice-admiral. Before the Cultural Revolution he held the post of deputy political commissar of the PLA Navy, on which he was reactivated in 1972 to become political commissar in 1978.

甘消 3/2 Gan Weihan

Identified as deputy director of the PLA Logistics Department (XNA, Apr 25, General

Gan is a PLA lieutenant-general. In 1960 he was identified as director of the Cadres Department, General Political Department to become a military cadre in Chengdu Military Region in 1966. Reactivated in 1978 he became political commissar of Shenyang Military Region in April that year.

Hua Nan

Identified as deputy director of the PLA General Political Department (XNA, Apr 18, 1980).

Hua became known in 1973 as deputy secretary. general of the Propaganda Section under the PLA Political Department. In Oct 1975 he was identified as director of the "Liberation Army Daily", a post he still helds.

Luo Yuejia (f) 罗越嘉

Elected vice-governor of Jilin Province (XNA. Apr 6, 1980).

Luo had been deputy for Liaoning to the 3rd NPC and was reactivated only now.

Mu Lin

Elected vice-governor of Jilin Province (XNA, Apr 6, 1980).

Mu had been vice-chairman of Jilin Revolutionary Committee before.

Identified as secretary of Hebei Province O (Shijiazhuang Radio, Apr 14, 1980).

Before the Cultural Revolution Pei had been alternate secretary of Hebei CP. He was reactivated only now.
