AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

- Nov 5 **Austria**
Long-term agreement on cooperation in economy, industry and technology. The agreement, to be effective for ten years, stipulates closer cooperation between the two countries in machinery and equipment building, mining, metallurgy, petro-chemistry and electronics, architectural and food industry as well as agriculture and forestry.

- Nov 7 **Korea, North**
1980-1981 plan for implementation of the agreement of cooperation in public health. Under it, the two countries will exchange medical personnel, medical achievements and medical literature.

Executive programme on the cultural cooperation agreement. The programme, to be effective till the end of 1981, covers the fields of culture, education, religion, sports and journalism, providing for among others exchange of delegations and materials.

Agreement on cooperation in marine shipping. It stipulates that the two contracting parties will strengthen and promote cooperation in marine shipping on the basis of equality and reciprocity. It also lays down the principles for handling relations between the two countries concerning marine shipping and provides that the two parties will extend to each other most-favoured-nation treatment for merchant ships and their crews.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Wolfgang Bartke

General

China is ready to supply developing countries with farm machinery on favourable terms and expand her economic and technical cooperation with them in this field. This was stated by Xiang Nan, vice-minister of Agricultural Machinery, in a news interview in Beijing on 21st October. Xiang Nan mentioned in particular China's small and medium farm machines and implements which were simple, easy to operate and maintain, inexpensive, and suited the needs of developing countries.

The vice-minister pointed out that China and the other developing countries all take agriculture as the foundation and use industry to equip agriculture. And this opens wide prospects for cooperation among developing countries in the development of farm machinery industry. This bilateral or multilateral cooperation may cover the following fields:

- exchange of experience in the development of the farm machinery industry, and mutual supply of technical literature; exchange of visits by experts; sales of hand-operated farm tools, animal-drawn implements and farm machinery; dispatch of experts specialized in the above-mentioned products and technical training; transfer of blueprints and manufacturing techniques; undertaking to build, for the other side, assembly shops, assembly or production lines for the making of one or several types of farm machinery; designing of farm machinery factories; and joint designing of the farm machinery needed by one or both sides.

The factory will give a new lease of life to F-6 type aircraft after overhauling them. It would also produce drop tanks and a variety of spare parts for aircraft. The completion of this project will help Pakistan become self-supporting in the aeronautics area.

Identified as secretary of Guangdong Province CP and as 1st secretary of Guangzhou Municipality CP (Guangzhou Radio, Nov 15, 1980)
Liang was minister of light industry before.

Liu Xiyao 刘西尧
Identified as secretary of Sichuan CP (Chengdu Radio, Nov 4, 1980)
Liu, an alternate member of the CCP 11th Central Committee, had been minister of education

from 1977 until 1979 when he was ordered to Sichuan Province to become a vice-governor of that province.

Ren Zhongyi 任仲夷
Identified as 1st secretary of Guangdong Province CP (Guangzhou Radio, Nov 15, 1980)
Ren, a member of the CCP 11th Central Committee, was 1st secretary of Liaoning Province CP before.

Wei Yuming 魏玉明
Identified as vice-minister of the Foreign Investment Commission (XNA, Oct 30, 1980)
Since 1977 Wei has also held the post of a vice-minister of economic relations with foreign countries.
