Scientific cooperation plan between the academies of sciences for 1981-1982

Protocol of the 3rd session on scientific and technical cooperation. It provides for an exchange in 1981 of study groups and in-service trainees in various fields of science and technology, including industry, agriculture, fishery and medicine, as well as technical information and data on topics of mutual interest. The exchange of seeds, seedlings, specimen and similar materials for scientific experiments is also provided for.

It provides a basis for seminars, training programs, symposia and workshops to be carried out by either organization. The agreement, which will be in effect for five years and may be automatically renewed for succeeding five-year periods, also provides the framework for carrying out specific research projects between scientists in the two organizations.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Benin

The Chinese aided Malanville paddy-rice project in Borgou Province, northern Benin, was handed over. Malanville, the biggest of eight paddy-rice areas built with Chinese aid, has 516 ha of paddy fields.

Egypt

Chinese experts completed their technical assistance to the Ismailiya Company for Fish Nurseries. The nurseries, situated in the at-Tal al-Kebir region of Ismailiya Province, occupy a total area of 1,300 feddan (1 feddan equals 0.42 ha). Construction work began in the spring of 1979 and more than 70 nurseries have now been dug in an area of over 300 feddan. Last May, 80,000 fry were imported from China. Artificial incubation has also been successfully introduced. There is a great variety of fish breeding in the nurseries, including silver carp, grass carp and common carp. The average yield has reached 1.99 tons of fish per feddan. The Ismailiya company for fish nurseries is a privately owned integrated complex with a total investment of 3,100,000 Egyptian pounds. Besides fish breeding, they raise Beijing ducks, grow fruit trees and process fish products. The whole project is due to be completed in 1982.

Guyana

The Sanata Textile Mill, built with Chinese aid, was handed over. The construction of the mill, the first of its kind in Guyana, began in 1976. Located in an industrial estate in Georgetown, the textile mill spreads over 18 acres of land and has a floor space of 27,000 sq.m. Equipped with 15,000 spindles and over 400 looms and a number of large dyeing and printing machines, the mill is capable of producing over 6,000,000 mof cloth annually from locally grown cotton.

Yemen Arab Republic

The First Housing Cooperative of the Yemen Arab Republic signed on Dec 16 with China's Architectural Engineering Corporation a contract for the construction of 350 flats. This is the first building project the cooperative has undertaken since its creation last year. The cooperative has now 400 members and plans to construct residential areas by using bank loans, in addition to its own capital. The government also supports this non-governmental undertaking by exempting from custom duties all building materials and equipment imported by the cooperative.

Xu could be identified as a leading military cadre of Beijing Military Region in 1974 and as chief of staff of that region in Oct 1977, a position he held at least until the fall of 1978. In Feb 1978 he was elected deputy for the PLA to the 5th NPC.
