China's Economic Aid

January 1979

MAURITANIA

The Kiffa health centre built with Chinese aid was inaugurated on January 4, 1979. The 50-bed centre consists of departments of internal medicine, surgery, obstetrics, gynecology, ophthalmology, otology, odontology, and stomatology. It can treat more than 500 patients every day (NCNA Jan 5, 1979).

MAURITIUS

A Chinese technical team is staying in Mauritius to finalize designs for a new airport terminal building (NCNA Jan 25, 1979).

MOZAMBIQUE

A Chinese agrotechnical team is in Mozambique to construct a grain and vegetable-growing state farm in Muamba, 80 kilometres from Maputo.

NEPAL

On January 19 King Mahendra inaugurated the Hetauda textile mill. It cost about 190,000,000 rupees (Kathmandu Radio, Jan 19, 1979; cit. SWB 6026). The products of the mill set up with Chinese assistance at a cost of 180,000,000 rupees will reach the market in three months. Nearly 550 workers are currently employed by the factory, which will engage 1,400 workers when it starts normal three-shift production in about one year's time (Kathmandu Radio, Dec 30, 1978; cit. SWB/W 1014).

SIERRA LEONE

The hospital in Rotifunk, a small town in Moyamba District, has become a polyclinic since Chinese doctors started their work there five years ago (NCNA Jan 13, 1979).

SUDAN

A protocol on sending a new Chinese medical team to Sudan was signed on January 6. It is to be valid from June 1978 until June 1979 (NCNA Jan 6, 1979).

TANZANIA

A Chinese coalfield exploration team works in Mbeya Region of Southwest Tanzania, helping the country with its survey of coal resources (NCNA Jan 13, 1979).

ZAIRE

Since late 1975 Chinese engineers and workers have been reconstructing the Kinshasa People's Palace. It has a 3,500-seat auditorium, a banquet hall, an international conference centre for 460 delegates and other facilities (NCNA Jan 18, 1979).

ZAMBIA

The Chinese vice premier Li Xiannian and the Zambian premier D. Lisulo laid the foundation stone for a textile mill on January 14, 1979. The mill will be built with Chinese assistance outside of Kabwe, the capital of the Central Province, 120 kilometres north of Lusaka. When completed, it will have 25,000 spindles and 720 looms (NCNA Jan 14, 1979).

DUAN ZIJUN (Tuan Tzu-chün) **段子俊**
Identified as vice-minister of the third Ministry of Machine Building (NCNA Jan 20, 1979). Duan held the same post before the CR. Reactivated in 1974 he was identified as president of the Society of Astronautics and Aeronautics in September 1978.

LI GUOCAI (Li Kuo-ts' ai)
Identified as vice-minister of chemical industry (NCNA Jan 26, 1979). Li, who is a model worker, had been vice-minister of petroleum and chemical industries from March 1976 until February 1978.

LIANG GUTING (Liang Ku-t' ing)
Identified as second secretary of Qinghai CP Committee (Sining Radio Jan 26, 1979). Liang had been secretary of that CP Committee before.

MA JIKONG (Ma Chi-k' ung) **马继孔**
Identified as CP secretary and vice-chairman of the Jiangxi Revolutionary Committee. (Nanzhang Radio Jan 26, 1979). Ma had been on the same post in Gansu Province before.

MA WENRUI (Ma Wen- jui) **马文瑞**
Identified as first secretary of the Shaanxi CP Committee (Xian Radio Jan 11, 1979). Ma is member of the 11th CCP Central Committee. In 1977 he became vice-minister of the State Planning Commission and vice-president of the Party School under the CCP Central Committee in August 1978.

PENG CHONG (P' eng Ch' ung) **彭冲**
Identified as first secretary of Shanghai CP Committee (NCNA Jan 9, 1978). Peng had been third secretary of that

Party Committee before. He succeeds Su Zhenhua, who had been on this post since the smashing of the 'Gang of Four'.

PING JIESAN (P' ing Chieh-san) **平杰三**
Identified as vice-director of the United Front Work Department under the CCP Central Committee (NCNA Jan 25, 1979). Ping had been on the same post from 1958 until the CR. He was reactivated in December 1978 as member of the Commission for Inspecting Discipline under the CCP Central Committee.

SONG RENQIONG (Sung Jen-ch' iung) **宋任穷**
Identified as director of the Organization Department of the CCP Central Committee (NCNA Jan 17, 1979). Song, who is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee, had been minister of the 7th Ministry of Machine Building before.

WANG BICHENG (Wang Pi-ch' eng) **王必成**
Identified as commander of the Wuhan Military Region (Wuhan Radio Jan 21, 1979). Wang, who is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee, had been commander of the Kunming Military Region before. He succeeds Yang Dezhi, who was seen in Kunming after Wang took over his position.

XIONG XIANGHUI (Hsiung Hsiang-hui) **熊向辉**
Identified as vice-director of the United Front Work Department, CCP Central Committee (NCNA Jan 1, 1979). Xiong is a diplomat of long standing. In 1961 he was an advisor to the Chinese delegation to the Laos Conference in Geneva. From 1962-1966 he was chargé d' affaires in London and from 1972-1973 ambassador to Mexico. Since October 1973 he has been known as a cadre of a department under the CCP Central Committee. Elected member of the 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference in March 1978, he was identified as vice-president of the Institute of Foreign Affairs in November the same year.

YANG SHANGKUN (Yang Shang-k'un) 杨尚昆
Identified as second CP secretary and vice-chairman of the Guangdong Revolutionary Committee (Guangzhou Radio Jan 21, 1979). Yang, a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee before and purged during the CR, was re-activated in December 1978 when he was seen at the memorial service for Peng Dehuai and Tao Zhu.

ZENG DINGSHI (Tseng Ting-shih) 曾定石
Identified as vice-chairman of the Guangdong Revolutionary Committee (Guangzhou Radio Jan 17, 1979). Zeng had been a minor cadre of Guangdong Province before the CR. He was reactivated in February 1978 when he was elected deputy for Guangdong Province to the 5th National People's Congress.

ZHOU GUANGCHUN (Chou Kuang-ch'un) 周光春
Identified as secretary of the Guangxi Autonomous Region's CP (Nanning Radio Jan 19, 1979). Zhou was reactivated in May 1978 as vice-chairman of the Guangxi Revolutionary Committee. Before the CR he held posts in the government and later as chairman of the Economic Committee of the Central South Bureau of the CCP Central Committee.

ZHAO ZENGYI (Chao Tseng-yi) 赵增益
Identified as vice-chairman of the Yunnan Revolutionary Committee (Kunming Radio Jan 26, 1979). Zhao was reactivated in December 1977 as deputy secretary of the Yunnan CP Committee. Before the CR he had been first secretary of Kunming Municipality's CP Committee.

Reactivated Cadres

LIN YINRU (Lin Yin-ju) 林茵如
Identified as vice-chairman of Shaanxi Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Xian Radio Jan 2, 1979). Before the CR Lin had been vice-governor of Shaanxi Province.

LU DINGYI (Lu Ting-yi) 陵定一
First appearance after the CR at the Spring Festival Celebrations in Beijing (NCNA Jan 27, 1979). Before the CR Lu had been an alternate member of the Political Bureau of the 8th CCP Central Committee, director of the CCP Central Committee's Propaganda Department, vice-premier and minister of culture. He was purged in 1966.

PENG ZHEN (P'eng Chen) 彭真
First appearance after the CR at the Spring Festival Celebrations in Beijing (NCNA Jan 27, 1979). Before the CR

Peng had been a member of the Political Bureau of the 8th CCP Central Committee, first secretary of the Beijing CP Committee and mayor of Beijing Municipality. He was purged in 1966.

QIAN JUNRUI (Ch'ien Chün-jui) 钱俊瑞
Identified as director of the Institute of World Economics, Academy of Social Sciences (NCNA Jan 3, 1979). Before the CR Qian had been an alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and vice-minister of education.

RAO SHOUKUN (Jao Shou-k'un) 饶守坤
Identified as commander of the PLA Navy's North China Fleet (NCNA Jan 12, 1979). Rao, who is a vice-admiral, had been deputy commander of the East China Fleet before the CR and was purged in 1967.

WANG GUANGMEI (Wang Kuang-mei) f. 王光美
First appearance after the CR at the Spring Festival Celebrations in Beijing (NCNA Jan 27, 1979). Wang was named as 'widow' of Liu Shaoqi - so the speculations as to whether Liu is still alive or dead finally comes to an end.

WANG WEI (Wang Wei) 王伟
Identified as president of the Youth Federation (NCNA Jan 25, 1979). Wang is a youth cadre of long standing. Before the CR he held posts in the Young Communist League and the Youth Federation as well. He was elected president of the Youth Federation in January 1965 to disappear soon after.

WU SHAOZU (Wu Shao-tsu) 伍绍祖
Identified as chairman of the Students' Federation (NCNA Jan 25, 1979). Wu was elected to the same post in January 1965 and was purged in 1966.

YANG HANSHENG (Yang Han-sheng) 杨翰笙
First appearance after the CR at New Year Party for Beijing's Writers and Artists (NCNA Jan 2, 1979). Before the CR Yang had been a vice-president of the Federation for Literary and Art Circles and a vice-president of the Association for Cultural Relations with Foreign Countries.

Rehabilitated Cadres, deceased as victims of the "Gang of Four"

LIAO LUYAN (Liao Lu-yen) 廖鲁言
Memorial service for Liao on January 25, 1979 (NCNA Jan 25, 1979). Before the CR Liao had been an alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and minister of agriculture.

LIU CHANGSHENG (Liu Ch' ang-sheng) 刘长胜

Memorial service for Liu on January 24, 1979 (NCNA Jan 24, 1979). Before CR Liu had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee, vice-chairman of the Third NPC and vice-chairman of the Trade Unions.

LIU REN (Liu Jen) 刘仁

Mentioned for the first time after the CR on January 12, 1979 (NCNA Jan 12, 1979). Before the CR Liu had been second secretary of the Beijing Municipality's CP, alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and secretary of North Bureau, CCPCC. He was purged in 1966 and died October 26, 1973.

LIU YUMIN (Liu Yü-min) 刘裕民

Memorial service for Liu on Jan 24, 1979 (NCNA Jan 24, 1979). Before the CR Liu had been minister of building construction.

NAN HANCHEN (Nan Han Ch' en) 南汉宸

Memorial service for Nan on January 24, 1979 (NCNA Jan 24, 1979). Before the CR Nan had been a member of the Third NPC's Standing Committee, chairman of the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade and director general of the Bank of China.

WU ZHIPU (Wu Chih-p'u) 吴芝圃

Memorial service for Wu on January 24, 1979 (NCNA Jan 24, 1979). Before the CR Wu had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee, secretary of the Central South Bureau of the CCPCC and deputy commander of the PLA Navy.

XU HAIDONG (Hsü Hai-tung) 徐海东

Memorial service for Xu on January 24, 1979 (NCNA Jan 24, 1979). Xu survived the CR and was elected member of the 9th CCP Central Committee in April 1969. He disappeared one month later.

XU ZIRONG (Hsü Tzu-jung) 徐子荣

Memorial service for Xu on January 25, 1979 (NCNA Jan 25, 1979). Before the CR Xu had been an alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee, member of the third NPC and vice-minister of Public Security.

ZHANG JICHUN (Chang Chi-ch' un) 张际春

Memorial service for Zhang on January 24, 1979 (NCNA Jan 24, 1979). Before the CR Zhang had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and vice-director of the CCPCC Propaganda Department.

ZHANG LINZHI (Chang Lin-chih) 张霖之

Memorial service for Zhang on January 24, 1979 (NCNA

Jan 24, 1979). Before the CR Zhang had been an alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and minister of coal industry.

CHENG MAOLAN (Ch' eng Mao-lan) 程茂兰

Deceased December 31, 1978 (NCNA Jan 20, 1979). Cheng held posts as director of the Beijing Observatory and vice-president of the Society of Astronomy.

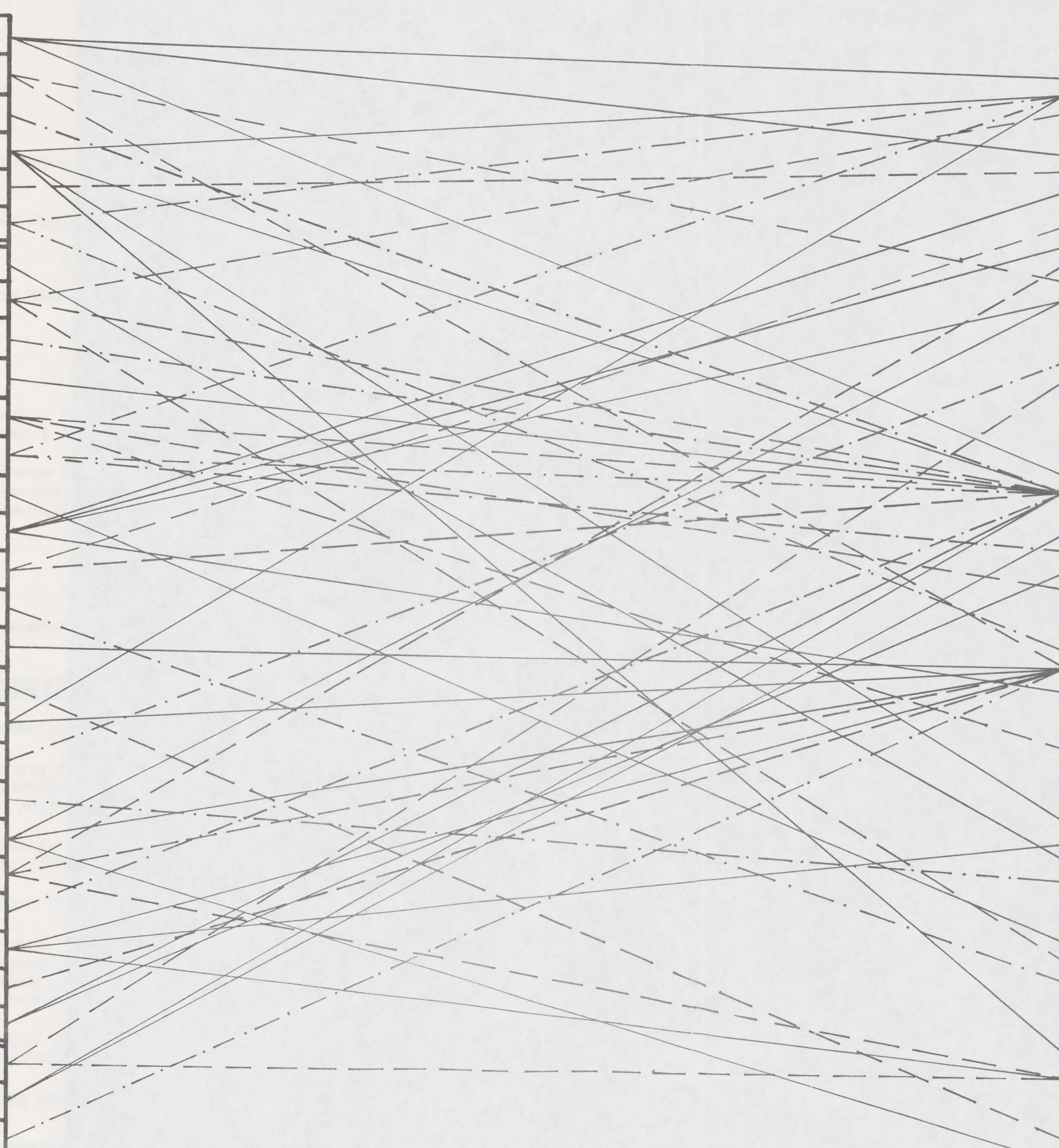
