## Personal Data

AN ZIWEN 安子文

Appointed vice-chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC's Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). An had been a member of the 8th CCP's Central Committee and director of its Organization Dpt. before CR. Purged in 1967 he reappeared at the memorial meeting for Peng Dehuai and Tao Zhu in December last year.

CHEN YANGSHAN 陈养山

Appointed deputy chief procurator of the Supreme People's Procuratorate (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Before CR Chen had been vice-minister of Justice. He reappeared when he was elected deputy of Ningxia Autonomous Region to the 5th NPC in Feb 1978.

DU XINGYUAN 杜星垣

Elected secretary of Sichuan Provincial CP (NCNA Feb 13,1979). Du had been vice-minister of Water Conservancy and Electric Power from 1962 until 1977 and vice-minister of the First and Second Ministry of Machine Building before that time.

GAO KELIN 高克林

Appointed vice-chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC's Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Since March 1978 Gao holds a post as member of the 5th NPC's Standing Committee. Before CR he had been an alternate member of the 8th CCP's Central Committee and secretary of that's Northwest Bureau.

HOU TONG 侯桐

Identified as vice-chairman of the Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries (NCNA Feb 21,1979). Before CR Hou had been a vice-chairman of the Committee for Promotion of International Trade. Purged in 1967 he was reactivated only now.

HU ZHAOHENG 胡昭衡

Identified as vice-minister of Public Health (NCNA Feb 26,1979). Before CR Hu had been mayor of Tianjin Municipality. Purged in 1967 he was reactivated in 1978 to become vice-chairman of Tianjin Revolutionary Committee and member of Tianjin CP's Standing Committee.

HUO SHILIAN 霍士廉

Appointed minister of Agriculture (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Huo is a member of the 11th CCP's Central Committee and held posts of First secretary of Shaansi Provincial CP and as chairman of the Shaansi Revolutionary Committee until his new promotion.

JI ZONGQUAN 季宗权

Identified as vice-minister of Public Health (NCNA Feb 13,1979). Before CR Ji had been an official of the Supreme People's Procuratorate. He was reactivated only now.

JIANG NANXIANG 蒋南翔

Identified as minister of Education (NCNA Feb 7,1979). Before CR Jiang had been minister of Higher Education and president of Qinghua University as well. Purged in 1967 he was reactivated in 1974 to become vice-chairman of Tianjin Municipality Revolutionary Committee in 1977 (until end that year), vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technological Commission in Dec. 1977 (a position he still holds!), and a member of the 5th NPC's Standing Committee in March 1978.

KONG YUAN 孔原

Appointed deputy secretary-general of the 5th NPC's Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Kong is a member of the 11th CCP's Central Committee and since March 1978 a member of the Standing Committee of the 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference.

LIU LANBO 刘澜波

Appointed minister of Power Industry (NCNA Feb 23,1979) Before CR Liu had been an alternate member of the 8th CCP's Central Committee, vice-minister for Water Conservancy and Electric Power, and a member of the 3rd NPC's Standing Committee. Liu was reactivated only now.

LIU ZHIJIAN 刘志坚

Identified as First political commissar of Kunming Military Region and as 2nd secretary of that's Party Committee (Kunming Radio Feb 13,1979). Liu, an alternate member of the 11th CCP's Central Committee and a PLA lieutenant general, had been political commissar of Kunming Military Region before. He succeeds An Pingsheng as first political commissar who seems to be reduced to his provincial party, administrative and military positions.

LU JIANGUANG

Identified as vice-minister of Public Security (NCNA Feb 17,1979). Liu became known as member of the Committee for Patriotic Health Campaign and as member of the Birth Planning Leading Group under the State Council last year.

LUO YUCHUAN 罗玉川

Appointed minister of Forestry (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Luo had been vice-minister of the ministry of Agriculture and Forestry before. Besides of his new appointment he holds a position as director of the State General Forestry Bureau.

PENG ZHEN 彭真

Appointed chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC's Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Peng was reactivated in Jan this year. Before CR he had been mayor and first party secretary of Beijing Municipality. He became first member of the CCP Political Bureau to be purged during CR.

QIAN ZHENGYING (f) 钱正英

Appointed minister of Water Conservancy (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Qian, who is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee, had been minister of Water

Conservancy and Electric Power before. After division of this ministry to the ministries of Power and of Water Conservancy she took over the latter.

SHA QIANLI 沙千里

Appointed vice-chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC's Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Before CR Sha had been minister of Food. He survived the CR unharmed and holds positions as deputy secretary-general and member of the Standing committee of the NPC since 1975.

SHI LIANG (f) 史良

Appointed vice-chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC's Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Shi, who is a vice-chairman of the China Democratic League since foundation, is also vice-president of the 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference and vice-chirman of the Women's Federation.

TAN ZHENG 谭政

Appointed vice-chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Tan had been an army general and member of the 8th CCP Central Committee before CR. Reactivated in 1975, he is a member of the 5th NPC's Standing Committee since March 1978.

TAO XIJIN 陶希晋

Appointed vice-chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Until 1956 Tao had been vice-president of the Central Academy for Political and Law Cadres. He was reactivated in Oct. last year.

WANG LEI 王磊

Appointed minister of Commerce (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Wang had been vice-chairman of Peking Revolutionary Committee from 1973 until 1977, became minister of Commerce in March 1978 until July that year to be sent back to his former post of vice-chairman of Peking Revolutionary Committee. Wang succeeds Yao Yi-lin whose whereabouts are still unknown.

WANG RENZHONG 王任重

Appointed minister of the State Agricultural Commission (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Wang is one of the newly elected C CCP's Central Committee members, by-elected in Dec. last year by the CC's 3rd Plenum. Also in Dec. last year he was appointed vice-premier.

WANG SHOUDAO 王首道

Appointed vice-chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Wang is am member of the 11th CCP Central Committee, secretary of Guangdong CP and vice-chairman of the Guangdong Revolutionary Committee.

WU XINYU 武新宇

Appointed vice-chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Wu holds posts as member of the Standing

Committee and as deputy secretary-general uninterrupted since 1959.

XIE HONGSHENG

Identified as vice-minister of Textile Industry (NCNA Feb 4,1979). Xie became known as a government cadre in 1977.

YANG DEZHI 杨得志

Identified as commander of Kunming Military Region and as 1st secretary of that's Party Committee (Kunming Radio Feb 13,1979). Yang is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee and until mid-January this year was commander of Wuhan Military Region.

YANG LIGONG 杨立功

Appointed minister of Agricultural Machinery (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Yang was minister of Agriculture and Forestry before. The ministry of Agricultural Machinery was established for the first time in 1959 (Yang became a vice-minister of it in 1962) and re-named 8th Ministry of Machine Building in 1965. The latter was abolished in 1970.

YANG WANXUAN 杨万选

Elected secretary of Sichuan CP (NCNA Feb 13,1979). Yang had been member of that CP's Standing Committee before.

YANG XIUFENG 杨秀峰

Appointed vice-chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC Standing Committee (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Before CR Yang had been member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and since 1965 president of the Supreme People's Court. Purged in 1966 he was reactivated in 1974 to be elected member of the 5th NPC's Standing Committee in March 1978.

ZENG SHENG 曾生

Appointed minister of Communications (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Zeng had been vice-minister of Communications before (since 1975). He succeeds Ye Fei who became first political commissar of the PLA Navy.

ZHANG JINGTANG 张敬堂

Identified as first secretary of Hangzhou Municipality CP (Hangzhou Radio Feb 18,1979). Zhang succeeds Zhang Zishi, son of Kang Sheng, who disappeared in April last year!

ZHENG SHAOWEN 郑绍文

Appointed vice-president of the Supreme People's Court (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Zheng had been vice-minister of Justice from 1954 until 1959. He was reactivated only now.

ZHENG TIANXIANG 郑天翔

Appointed minister of the 7th Ministry of Machine Building (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Zheng had been secretary of Beijing CP before CR and was reactivated to this post in Feb. 1978. The minister position was vacant, since Sung Renqiong took over the CCP CC's Organization Department in Jan. this year.

### Reactivated Cadres

CHEN PENG 陈鹏

First appearance after CR at memorial service for Liu Ren (NCNA Feb 23,1979). Chen had been secretary of Peking CP.

LI da 李达

Identified as vice-minister of the 3rd Ministry of Machine Building (NCNA Feb 17,1979).

### Deceased Cadres

SU ZHENHUA 苏振华

Deceased Feb 7,1979 (NCNA Feb 11,1979). Su is the first Political Bureau member, elected in 1977, who died.

YANG ZHONGJIAN 杨钟健

### Laos

On 16th February the Laos-China Friendship Textile Mill in Muong Sai township of Oudomsay province was handed over. The mill was given by China as non-refundable aid. Construction began on March 9, 1978. The mill is equipped with 20 looms and will produce 300,000 m of cloth a year. (KPL Feb 17, 1979; cit. SWB/W2021)

### Nepal

The Bactapur brick factory built with Chinese assistance was handed over on 20th February. Construction began in March 1977. The factory is situated in Bhadguon in the Kathmandu valley and can produce 20 million bricks a year. It is the second brick factory built with Chinese assistance in Nepal (NCNA, Feb 20, 1979)

### Tanzania

31 medical assistants were given qualification certificates by the Zanzibar Ministry of Health and Social Welfare on 7th February. They were trained by Chinese teachers in a three year course (NCNA Feb 7, 1979)
