AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Pakistan (Jul 01)

Implementation program for cultural exchange for 1982 and 1983. According to the program, China and Pakistan will strengthen friendly relations, and exchanges and cooperation in the fields of culture, art, education, sports, news media, publication and religion. XNA, Jul 01, 1982

Niger (Jul 02) Trade agreement XNA, Jul 04, 1982

Kuwait (Jul 05)

Loan agreement between the Kuwaiti Fund for Arab Economic Development and China on a loan of 14.3 million dinar (50 million US\$) to help fincance the Ningguo cement plant in Anhui Province. The plant, designed to produce 1.5 million tons of cement a year, will be one of the biggest cement plants in China. The total cost of the project is estimated at 36.35 million dinar. This is the first loan provided by the Kuwaiti Fund to China. Under the agreement, Kuwait will give preferential treatment to China's specific needs. XNA, Jul 05, 1982

Benin (Jul 07)

Trade agreement. It stipulates that the two countries will give each other the most-favoured-nation treatment in the customs tariff on the importation, exportation, reexportation and transit of goods, in the issuance of import and export permits and in the customs formalities. The two sides agreed to create a mixed commission to discuss and resolve problems arising from trade between the two countries. XNA, Jul 07, 1982

Pakistan (Jul 10)

Border commodity exchange agreement. Main export items by Pakistan are cotton, textiles, dry fruits, medical herbs, cigarettes and blades while printed cloth, woolen blankets, quilts, agricultural implements, hardware and farm tools constitute the important import items from China. The agreement envisages exchanges of goods worth over 4,000,000 rupees each way, reflecting an increase of about 5% over last year.
