

Mozambique (Aug 09) Trade agreement XNA, Aug 9, 1982

Bangladesh (Aug 11)

6th barter protocol for 1982-83. Under it Bangladesh will export to China jute and jute products, urea, fertilizer and hides and skins. And China will export to Bangladesh coal, pig iron, steel billets, chemicals, dyes, machinery and equipment.

A contract was signed on the extension project of the Bimbo broadcasting station. According to it China will provide two sets of China-made 50 kW transmitters and antennas for the station, and will undertake the construction of the machine room and other subsidiary buildings.

The Afife irrigation project was handed over to the Ghanian government. The Afife irrigation project, 160 km east of Accra, consists of a reservoir with a total storage capacity of 31,400,000 cubic metres, a 1,596 metre long dam, 43 irrigation canals with a total length of 39,453 metres and a number of drainage canals and ditches with a total length of 53,140 metres. It can irrigate 808 hectares of paddy fields. The construction of this project was started in July 1979 and completed in June 1982.

Tanzania

China and Tanzania signed an agreement on the design of the Kiwira coal mine. The agreement involves the construction of an access road, a bridge and a power plant. The Kiwira coal mine, which is located 32 kilometres south of Tukuyu, Southern Tanzania, will produce 150,000 tonnes of coal annually in the first stage after it is put into operation. The mine will enable the country to save about 300 million shillings of foreign exchanges which would have been used for importing oil.

In 1963 Liu held the post of an attorney of the Higher Military Procuratorate. In 1980-81 he served as a judge of the special court for the trial of Lin Biao and Jiang Qing counterrevolutionary cliques.

A vice-mayor of Changchun Municipality before the Cultural Revolution, Ren became secretary of Changchun CP in 1978 and its 1st secretary in 1980.
