23 ?	MEXICO	Protocol on the 4th Conference on Scientific and Technical Cooperation. Under the protocol the two sides will increase scientific and technical exchanges this year, especially in agriculture, on the basis of their exchanges last year. Mexico will send scientists to China to do research in agriculture, forestry, fisheries, rejoining of severed limbs, surgery, and Chinese medicinal herbs this year. At the same time China will send its experts to Mexico for the study of cotton cultivation, forestry, fishing for prawn, and the use of geothermal energy. Mexico will also provide China with seeds of cereals, vegetables, henequen and other industrial crops (3).

China's Economic Aid

March 1979

AFGHANISTAN

A regional hospital built by China on gratuitous assistance was delivered to the Afghan government in Kandahar province on March 6, 1979 (NCNA Mar 6, 1979).

BURUNDI

An agreement on economic and technical cooperation was signed on March 19, 1979 (NCNA Mar 19, 1979).

LAOS

The Chinese economic assistance has come to an end. On March 7, the acting foreign minister of Laos, Khamphai Boupha, sent an 'official letter' to the Chinese foreign minister, as follows: "... I would like to inform you that with reference to the 3rd October 1973 agreement between the provisional coalition government of Laos and the PRC government, the construction of roads by Chinese workers in the northern region of the LPDR has been largely completed. The people and government of the LPDR would like to express their profound thanks for such assistance. ..." (Vientiane Radio Mar 12, 1979; cit. SWB 6065). The above letter refers to the construction of the highway from M.Nam Bak to Luang Prabang city which began in 1977 (NCNA Mar 15, 1979).

MAURITANIA

Under an agreement China is to give Mauritania 50 agricultural machines, including 12 tractors and 4 harvesters (Nouakchott Radio Mar 19, 1979; cit. SWB/W 1025).

NIGER

The Kolo agricultural project developed with Chinese aid was handed over on Mar 9, 1979 (NCNA Mar 10, 1979).

SENEGAL

The Chinese-aided well-sinking project in Dakar was handed over on Mar 2, 1979. It comprises 20 piped wells, 10 boreholes and 30 irrigation wells. The project started in June 1977 (NCNA Mar 4, 1979).

SIERRA LEONE

A ground-breaking ceremony of the first sugar mill to be constructed with Chinese aid took place at Magbass in the Northern Province on Mar 2, 1979. It has a total area of some 60,000 sq.metres, including 15,000 sq.m.of building area. It has a capacity of crushing 400 tons of sugarcane per day for white granulated sugar (NCNA Mar 2, 1979).

SOMALIA

The Chinese-aided Child and Maternity Hospital, with a staff of only 40, handles an average of 400 out-patients per day. Since its inauguration two years ago over 200,000 women have been treated here and 20,600 babies delivered (NCNA Mar 6, 1979).

SRI LANKA

A modern farm on 1,500 acres will be set up in the Kala bawa (?) development area with Chinese aid. It will enable the staff of the farm to acquire training on new agricultural structures (Colombo Radio Feb 26, 1979; cit. SWB/W 1023).

TANZANIA

A new Chinese medical team arrived in Zanzibar and the former team went home (NCNA Mar 22, 1979).

UPPER VOLTA

On March 1, 1979, Chinese experts arrived in Ougadougou to help build the Upper Volta stadium (NCNA Mar 6, 1979).

ZAIRE

Chinese agro-technicians are constructing the Mbandaka agricultural experimental centre in the Equateur Region. The items under construction are paddy, vegetable and soybean crops as well as hydraulic installations (NCNA Mar 6, 1979).

Ji, who is a member of the 11th Central Committee, had been minister of foreign affairs from 1972 until 1974 and has been secretary-general of the National People's Congress since January 1975.

LI RENZHI 李任之

Identified as first secretary of Wuhan Municipal CP Committee and as secretary of the Hubei Provincial CP Committee (Wuhan Radio Mar 3 and 5, 1979).

Li, who is a member of the 11th Central Committee, had been CP secretary of Anhui Province before 1973 (until January 1979).

LIANG WENYING 梁文英

Identified as vice-chairman of the Yunnan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Kunming Radio Mar 24, 1979).

Liang is a member of the Standing Committee of the Yunnan CP Committee (since 1975) and director of that body's Propaganda Department (since April 1978).

LUO GUIBO 罗贵波

Identified as second secretary of the Shanxi Provincial CP Committee (NCNA Mar 6, 1979).

Luo had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and vice-minister of foreign affairs between 1958 and 1970. He disappeared in 1970 and was reactivated in December 1978.

Identified as secretary of Henan Provincial CP Committee (Zhengzhou Radio Mar 8, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Qiao had been vice-director

of the Organization Department of the CCP Central Committee. Purged in 1966, he was reactivated in December 1978.

WANG XIPING 王西萍

Identified as vice-minister of communications (NCNA Mar 18, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Wang had been vice-minister of the Second Ministry of Machine-Building. He was reactivated in December 1978.

WEN MINSHENG 文敏生

Identified as secretary of Heilongjiang Provincial CP Committee and as first secretary of the Haerbin Municipal CP Committee (Haerbin Mar 8, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Wen had been governor and second secretary of Henan Province. Purged in 1966, he was reactivated now.

XIE HUAIDE 谢怀德

Identified as vice-chairman of Shaanxi Provincial Revolutionary Committee and as a member of the Standing Committee of the Shaanxi Provincial CP Committee (Xi'an Radio Mar 23, 1979).

Xie was appointed vice-chairman of the Commission for Economic Relations with Foreign Countries in 1964 and held this position until January 1971 when he disappeared. He was reactivated now.

XU CHANGYU

Identified as vice-minister of the Third Ministry of Machine-Building (NCNA Mar 6, 1979).

In 1958 Xu was identified as a PLA major-general.

YE FEI 叶飞

Identified as first political commissar of the PLA Navy (NCNA Mar 1, 1979).

Ye, who is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee, was minister of communications before his new appointment where he has succeeded Su Zhenhua who died on Feb 7, 1979.

ZHANG HAITANG 张海堂

Identified as deputy commander of the Kunming Military

Region (NCNA Mar 25, 1979).

Zhang, who is a PLA major-general, has held the post of commander of Yunnan Military District since 1975.
