Agreements with Foreign Countries

April 1979

- April 5 U S A Agreement for academic exchange cooperation between Beijing University and the University of California. Under the agreement Beijing University and the University of California at Berkeley will exchange teaching programmes, outlines of courses, academic journals and other publications. Post-graduate students will be exchanged and each university will send professors and lecturers to the other to teach and do research. The two institutions will cooperate in agree scientific fields (1).
- 6 JAPAN Agreement on cooperation in patent work (2)
- 16 YEMEN, Arab Republic Protocol on sending a new Chinese medical team consisting of 60 members (3)
- 18 YUGOSLAVIA The first agreement on long-term cooperation between a Yugoslav and a Chinese enterprise has been signed in Peking. Sarajevo Energoinvest and the electrical goods factory in Xi'an have agreed to cooperate in joint development and research work and in the transfer of technology, knowledge and skills. They will also cooperate in construction and will develop mutual purchase and sales relations. This general agreement, valid for five years, represents the basis for a number of other specific agreements of which the nearest to being signed is an agreement on cooperation on the research, improvement and production of high-voltage switches, known by the name of ST-6, made by Energoinvest (4).

- EGYPT Trade protocol for 1979 (5)
- 21 PAKISTAN Trade protocol for the next year (6). Goods worth 26,000,000 dollars are to be exchanged. Chinese exports: steel billets, pig iron, coal, tools, workshop implements, sheet and glass plates, construction and road-building machinery, and telecommunications equipment. Pakistan's export: cotton, cotton Yarn, textile goods, leather, and other goods (7).

China's Economic Aid

April 1979

LAOS

All of the 497 Chinese engineers and technicians sent to Laos to construct the highway from M.Nam Bak to Luang Prabang were called back and returned to China on April 5, 1979 (NCNA Apr 9, 1979).

MAURITANIA

A ceremony to mark the laying of the foundation-stone for a deepwater port, "The Port of Friendship", was held in Nouakchott on April 10, 1979. It is to be built by China and includes installations on land and projects at sea (NCNA Apr 10, 1979).

NEPAL

A Chinese technical team arrived in Kathmandu on April 4 to carry out a detailed survey and site selection for a paper industry in Nepal. The paper industry, which will have a capacity to produce 10 tons a day, is expected to be set up in the Lumbini zone (Kathmandu Radio Apr 5, 1979; cit. SWB 6093).

PAKISTAN

The commissioning record of the Pakistan heavy foundry and forge built with Chinese aid was signed in Taxila on April 26. It was completed in 1977 and put into operation last March after two years of trial production (NCNA Apr 26, 1979).

SIERRA LEONE

The "Siaka Stevens Stadium" built with Chinese aid was opened on April 19 (NCNA Apr 19, 1979). The construction work for this stadium started in June 1975 (NCNA Sep 28, 1978).

YEMEN, Arab Republic (NORTH)

Under a protocol between the governments of China and the Yemen Arab Republic signed in Sanaa on April 16, a 60-member Chinese medical team will be sent to the Arab Republic of Yemen, which will provide the necessary equipment, medicine and housing. North Yemen will also pay for the travelling and other expenses of the Chinese team (NCNA Apr 17, 1979).

YEMEN, People's Republic (SOUTH)

China renders assistance to a fishery project in South Yemen. It is situated near the port of Aden and will serve many purposes, including the installation of a fast freezer and refrigerating facilities. (NCNA Apr 18, 1979).

Known Cadres on New Posts

DU CHUNYONG 杜春永

Identified as vice-minister of the Ministry for Building Materials (NCNA Apr 11, 1979).

Du became known in 1973 as director of a bureau of the Capital Construction Commission.

FU YUTIAN 傅雨田

Identified as CP secretary and as vice-chairman of the Revolutionary Committee of Jiangxi Province (Nanchang Radio April 21, 1979).

Fu, who was reactivated in December 1978, had been vice-chairman of the Guangxi Autonomous Region before the Cultural Revolution.

HU JIABIN 胡嘉宾

Identified as vice-minister of the Nationalities Affairs Commission (NCNA Apr 26, 1979).

Hu was reactivated in August 1978. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been a member of the State Nationalities Affairs Commission.

LI JIANPING 李建平

Identified as vice-minister of the Ministry for Light Industry (NCNA Apr 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Li had been a vice-minister of coal industry. Reactivated in 1973 he became a vice-minister of the fuel and chemical industries in April 1974 and retained this post until the ministry was divided in January 1975.

LI RUIZHAN 李瑞山

Identified as vice-minister of the State Agricultural Commission (Tianjin Radio Apr 10, 1979).

Li, a member of the CCP Central Committee since its 9th Congress in 1969, had been first secretary of Shaanxi Province from 1971 until the end of 1978.

LIU CHANGYI 刘昌毅

Identified as deputy commander of the Canton Military Region (Nanning Radio Apr 12, 1979).

Liu, a vice-admiral of the PLA Navy before the Cultural Revolution, who was reactivated as deputy commander of the Nanking Military Region in 1975, disappeared soon after the death of Mao Zedong. He reappeared in 1978.

QIAN XINZHONG 钱纹忠

Appointed minister of the Ministry of Public Health (NCNA Apr 3, 1979).

Qian had been a vice-minister of that ministry before his new appointment. He had already held the post of minister between 1965 and his purge in September 1966. (The former minister, Jiang Yizhen, was active until March 1979).

SONG YANGCHU 宋养初

Appointed minister of the Ministry of Building Materials (NCNA Apr 3, 1979).

(There had already been a Ministry of Building Materials between 1956 and 1958, which was revived now). Song is one of the few cadres to survive the Cultural Revolution unharmed. Until his new appointment he was a vice-minister of the Capital Construction Commission, a post he had held, without any interruption, since 1965.

WANG CHUN 王纯

Identified as secretary of the CP Committee of Beijing (Peking) Municipality (Beijing Daily, Mar 31, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Wang had been a vice mayor of Beijing. Reactivated in 1977, he is also a vice-chairman of the Beijing Revolutionary Committee.

WAN DA 万达

Identified as second secretary of the Hunan Provincial CP Committee (Changsha Radio Apr 24, 1979).

Wan who has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since its 11th Party Congress in 1977, had been secretary of the Hunan Party Committee before.

WANG RENZHONG 王任重

Identified as chairman of the National Committee on Natural Agricultural Resources Surveying and Agricultural Zoning (NCNA Apr 13, 1979).
(continued next page)

Wang had been an alternate member of the 8th Central Committee before the Cultural Revolution. He became widely known when he crossed the Chang Jiang River, swimming with Mao, in September 1966. Purged in the autumn of the same year he was reactivated in September 1978 to be appointed vice-premier and by-elected member of the 11th CCP Central Committee in December 1978. In February 1979 he was appointed minister of the State Agricultural Commission. These appointments have made Wang China's leading cadre in agricultural affairs.

WANG XIAN 王 宪

Identified as secretary of the Beijing Municipality's CP Committee (Beijing Radio Apr 21, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Wang had been head of the Miyun Reservoir Construction Bureau. He was reactivated in 1977 as vice-chairman of the Beijing Revolutionary Committee.

WANG ZHIGUO 王 治国

Identified as vice-chairman of the Hunan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Changsha Radio Apr 18, 1979).

Before his present appointment, Wang had been a member of the Standing Committee of the Hunan Provincial CP Committee.

WU SHIHONG 武 士 鸿

Identified as deputy commander of Nanjing Military Region (Nanjing Radio Apr 11, 1979).

Wu has been a leading military cadre in the Nanjing Military Region since 1971. In 1975 he was identified as political commissar of the Zhejiang Military District - a post he was last seen on in May 1977.

XU DAOQI 许 边 琦

Identified as secretary of Hubei Provincial CP Committee (Wuhan Radio Apr 28, 1979).

Xu had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution. Purged in 1967, he was reactivated as vice-chairman of the Hubei Revolutionary Committee in January 1978.

YANG SHANGKUN 杨 尚 昆

Appointed first secretary of the Guangzhou CP Committee and chairman of that municipality's Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Apr 5, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Yang had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee. Purged in 1967 he was reactivated in December 1978 to become second secretary of the Guangdong Provincial CP Committee one month later.

YANG YUNYU (f). 杨 蕴 玉

Identified as vice-minister of education (NCNA Apr 17, 1979).

Yang had been director of that ministry's Foreign Affairs

Department since April 1978. In February 1979 she was appointed vice-chairman of the PR China's National Commission for UNESCO.

ZHANG JINONG 张 季 农

Identified as vice-minister of water conservancy (NCNA Apr 10, 1979).

Zhang had been a vice-minister of the Ministry of Water Conservancy and Electric Power until February 1979 when that ministry was divided into ministries for water conservancy and for the power industry.

ZHOU LI 周 里

Identified as secretary of the Hunan Provincial CP Committee (Changsha Radio Apr 30, 1979).

Zhou had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution. Purged in 1967, he was reactivated in 1977 to be elected a member of the 5th National People's Congress's Standing Committee in March 1978.

Reactivated Cadres

ZHANG GUOSHENG

Identified as permanent secretary of Qinghai Provincial CP Committee and as chairman of the Qinghai Revolutionary Committee (Xi'an Radio Apr 20, 1979).

In 1958 Zhang had been a secretary of the Qinghai CP Committee.

ZHANG JICHUN 张 际 春

Attended the memorial service for Tian Han (NCNA Apr 25, 1979).

Zhang had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and a vice-director of that body's Propaganda Department until his purge in 1966.

New Cadres

DONG CUNCAI

Identified as vice-minister of education and as president of the Education Society (NCNA Apr 24, 1979).

FANG ZHIDA

Identified as director of the CCP Central Committee's Department for United Front Work (NCNA Apr 11, 1979).

GA·BU·LONG

Identified as member of the Qinghai Provincial CP Committee's Standing Committee and as vice-chairman of the same region's Revolutionary Committee

(Xi'an Radio Apr 20, 1979).

GU YUANLIN

Identified as deputy commander of the Xinjiang Military Region (Ürümqi Radio Apr 20, 1979).

LI TAO

Identified as vice-minister of the textile industry (NCNA Apr 2, 1979).

WANG JINSAN

Identified as vice-minister of the coal industry (NCNA Apr 2, 1979).

WANG PING

Identified as vice-minister of the State Nationalities Affairs Commission (NCNA Apr 26, 1979).

ZHANG CIHAI

Identified as vice-chairman of the Yunnan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Kunming Radio Apr 27, 1979).

Deceased Cadres

MA CHUNGU 马纯古

Died on March 16, 1979 (NCNA Apr 1, 1979).

Ma's positions included that of a vice-chairman of the Trade Unions and of a member of the Standing Committee of the 5th National People's Congress.

TONG DIZHOU 董第周

Died on March 30, 1979 (NCNA Apr 7, 1979).

Tong was one of the few scientists who survived the Cultural Revolution unharmed. When he died he was holding the following positions: member of the 5th NPC's Standing Committee; vice-president of the Academy of Sciences; vice-president of the 5th China's People's Political Consultative Conference; and director of the Institute of Zoology under the Academy of Sciences. With Tong one of the most prominent Chinese scientists has gone.
