| 5 | USA | Two agreements on geophysical survey between the China National Oil and Gas Exploration and Development Corporation and the US Esso Exploration, Inc. (2) |

| 12 | TANZANIA | Agreement on medical aid. Under this agreement, 60 Chinese doctors will work in Tanzania for two years. They will work at regional or district hospitals and Muhimbili medical centre in Das es Salaam (9) |
| | USA | Annex to the implementation agreement between the Chinese State Scientific and Technological Commission and the US Department of Energy on cooperation in high-energy physics. China will build a 50 BeV alternate gradient proton synchrotron by relying primarily on her own efforts, absorbing advanced technique and experience from other countries, including the USA (10) |
| 12? | YUGOSLAVIA | Agreement on cooperation in agriculture and food processing industry (9) |
| 13 | MADAGASCAR | Minutes of talks on the construction of the Antafofo hydroelectric station with Chinese aid. Under the agreement, the hydroelectric station, with an installed capacity of 1,200 kW, will be built on the Lily River, near Tananarive City (11) |

- 16 PERU Minutes of Sino-Peruvian trade talks. Peru is willing to continue supplying China with copper, zinc, lead, fishmeal and other products. The Chinese side hopes that Peru may provide convenience and necessary cooperation for the Chinese goods going into the Peruvian market. The two sides agreed in principle on the set-up of a permanent mixed committee (13)
- 17? PAKISTAN Letters of agreement on 1979 border trade (14)
- 19 CHILE Agreement between the Chilean Nuclear Commission and the National Chemical Corporation from Shanghai under which 1,400 cubic metres of gauze bandage will be sterilized by gamma radiation (15).
Minutes of a meeting of the China-Chile mixed cooperation commission under which it was agreed to stimulate bilateral trade with the aim of reaching 100,000,000 dollars' worth a year. In 1978 Chile's exports were worth 25-30,000,000 dollars while China's exports were worth 8,000,000 dollars (12). Chile and the PR China have agreed to increase and stabilize copper and saltpetre exports. The PR China will provide as soon as possible a list of goods it is interested in purchasing from Chile, such as cellulose, wood, fruit, vegetables, canned goods, algae, fishmeal and chemical, industrial and mineral products. At the same time, 30,000 cubic metres of wood will be shipped to the PR China on an experimental basis aimed at possible permanent trade in this commodity.(15).
- YUGOSLAVIA Radio and TV cooperation agreement and a 1979-1980 radio and TV implementation plan. Under the agreement, China and Yugoslavia will exchange radio and TV broadcasts and related information, visiting delegations, correspondents, programmers and technicians. They will also cooperate in the preparation of radio and TV broadcasts (16).
- GERMANY
Federal Republic Agreement on cooperation in geological science and technology between the Chinese State Geological Bureau and the Ministry of Economy of the FR Germany (16)
- 22 USA Protocol on scientific and technical cooperation in medicine and public health. The protocol is part of the agreement on cooperation in science and technology between China and the United States. According to the protocol, fifteen areas have been agreed upon for initial cooperation, including infectious and parasitic diseases, cancer, cardiovascular diseases, public health and health services research.(17).
- IRELAND Communiqué on the establishment of diplomatic relations (18).
- TUNISIA Agreement on cultural cooperation. According to the agreement, the two parties will take all possible measures to promote and develop cooperation and exchanges in the spheres of culture, the arts, sports, youth, information, broadcasting and television among others.(17).

LUXEMBOURG Initialling of an agreement on the development of economic, industrial and scientific and technical cooperation. Initialling of two protocols on cooperation in economy, industry and technology and on cooperation in science and technology (19).

China's Economic Aid

June 1979

MADAGASCAR

On 13th June China and Madagascar signed the minutes of talks on the construction of the Antafofo hydroelectric station with Chinese aid. Under the agreement, the hydroelectric station, with an installed capacity of 1,200 kW, will be built on the Lily River, near Tananarive City (XNA June 14, 1979).

MALI

China and Mali have signed a protocol on the construction of two dams at Bamako, one at Kenieba in the Kayes region and a Foreign Ministry radio transmitter, and on continued technical assistance on a sugar factory (SWB 6140).

SRI LANKA

China has agreed to help Sri Lanka to tap small hydroelectric power sources. Initially four pilot projects involving 1,000 kW generating units are to be set up (Colombo Radio May 26, 1979; cit. SWB/W 1035).

SUDAN

The Lake Nubia fishery project in Wadi Halfa of Sudan built with Chinese aid was officially handed over to the Sudanese administration. The fishery project with a daily output of five tons of refrigerated fish is the biggest one in Sudan. The construction of the project began three years ago (XNA June 13, 1979).

On 13th June a document was signed whereby China will provide Sudan with experts for training Sudanese workers for the Lake Nubia fishery scheme (SWB/W 1038).

TANZANIA

On 12th June Tanzania and China signed an agreement, whereby 60 Chinese doctors will work in Tanzania for two years at regional or district hospitals, as well as at the Muhimbili medical centre in Dar es Salaam (XNA June 13, 1979).

ZAIRE

Zaire's first farm implement plant which can product 1,350,000 farm tools annually, including hoes, sickles and spades, has been completed. Built with Chinese assistance the plant has produced 25,000 farm tools and trained nearly 100 Zairian workers since it went into trial operation in September 1978 (XNA June 24, 1979).

Known Cadres on New Posts

薄一波

BO YIBO

Elected vice premier; appointed member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Bo, a vice premier before the Cultural Revolution and also an alternate member of the CCP Political Bureau, was purged in 1967. Reactivated in December 1978 he has been reinstated in one of his former positions.

CHEN GUODONG

陈国栋

Appointed minister of food (XNA Jun 6, 1979) and member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Chen is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee. Before his new appointment he had been director of the Federation of Supply and Marketing Cooperatives.

CHEN YUN

陈云

Appointed vice premier and chairman of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Chen had been vice premier between 1949 and 1972 (?) and was the PR China's leading economic cadre until Mao Zedong's Great Leap Forward campaign. He has now been reinstated in his former position as China's leading economic cadre.

FANG YI

方毅

Appointed president of the Academy of Sciences and member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Fang, a member of the CCP Political Bureau since 1977, has been a government cadre since the 1950s. He was responsible for China's economic aid from the very beginning until January 1977 when Chen Muhua succeeded him in this field, while Fang was appointed vice president of the Academy of Sciences under Guo Moruo who was still alive at that time.

As Fang's position in the Party was superior to that of the then president of the Academy, it was evident that he should be chosen to succeed Guo after the latter's death. Appointed minister of the State Scientific and Technical Commission in February 1978, Fang is now the leading cadre of the PR China in the field of science.

GAO YANG

高扬

Appointed minister of state farms and land reclamation (XNA Jun 12, 1979).

Gao had been minister of the chemical industry between 1962 and the Cultural Revolution during which he disappeared. Reactivated in 1978, he has been secretary of the Jilin Provincial CP Committee since.

GU MU

谷牧

Appointed member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Gu, a member of the CCP Central Committee since 1973, has been head of the State Capital Construction Commission since that year. He was also made vice premier in January 1975 - a post he still holds.

GUO ZIHENG

Identified as vice-minister of public health (XNA Jun 21, 1979).

Guo was identified as vice-president of the Chinese Medical Association in July 1978.

HE KANG

何康

Identified as vice-minister of the State Agricultural Commission (XNA Jun 15, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution He held several government posts, the most prominent being that of a vice-director of the Office for Experts Administration (until 1959). Afterwards he became chairman of the Association for Tropical Plants. In March 1978 he was reactivated as vice-minister of agriculture and forestry. In April 1979 He was appointed vice president of the Recommendation and Examination Committee in charge of classifying inventions under the State Scientific and Technical Commission.

HE YIXIANG

何以祥

Identified as deputy commander of the Nanjing Military Region (Shanghai Radio Jun 21, 1979).

He is a PLA major-general and has held the position of commander of the Shanghai Garrison since June 1978.

JIN MING (see next page)

JIN MING 金明

Appointed member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Jin, a vice-minister of finance before the Cultural Revolution, was made secretary-general of the State Council in April 1979.

KANG SHIEN 康世恩

Appointed member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Kang was elected member of the CCP's Central Committee in 1977. Having been a vice-minister of the petroleum industry before the Cultural Revolution, he has been head of the State Economic Commission since March 1978, and was made vice premier at the same time.

LI DAIGENG 李代耕

Identified as vice-minister of power industry (XNA Jun 6, 1979).

Li had been a vice-minister of the Water Conservancy and Electric Power Ministry until it was divided up to form two ministries, one for water conservancy and one for the power industry.

LI SHAOYU 李绍禹

Identified as vice-resident of the Chinese People's Bank (XNA Jun 20, 1979).

Li had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution and was also deputy general manager of the Bank of China. His present appointment marks his recent reactivation after the Cultural Revolution purge.

LI XIANNIAN 李先念

Appointed vice-chairman of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Li is China's oldest vice premier (since 1954) and was minister of finance between 1957 and (probably) 1974. So he can be regarded as an expert of long standing in the new super commission.

LI XIMING 李锡铭

Identified as vice-minister of power industry (Shenyang Radio Jun 25, 1979).

Li had been a vice-minister in the Ministry of Water Conservancy and Electric Power until the recent division of that ministry into two new ministries, one for water conservancy and the other for the power industry.

LIU FANG 刘放

Identified as vice-minister of the 6th Ministry of Machine Building (XNA Jun 12, 1979).

LIU KUN 刘琨

Identified as vice-minister of forestry (Beijing Radio May 24, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Liu held minor posts in the

Ministry of Forestry. Reactivated in August 1978, he was then made vice-director of the Forestry Administrative Bureau under the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry.

LIU XINQUAN 刘新冠

Identified as vice-director of the International Liaison Department under the CCP Central Committee (XNA Jun 22, 1979).

A vice-minister of foreign affairs since 1960, Liu became ambassador to the Soviet Union in 1965, a post he held - with an interruption - until 1976. Between 1976 and the spring of 1979 he was ambassador to Albania.

LIU ZIMO 刘子谟

Identified as vice-chairman of the Xinjiang Autonomous Region's Revolutionary Committee (XNA Jun 18, 1979).

In 1963 Liu had been identified as the director of Xinjiang's Financial Department.

NIU YINGUAN 牛荫冠

Appointed director of the Federation of Supply and Marketing Cooperatives (XNA Jun 12, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Niu had been vice-minister of commerce and director of the Beijing College of Commerce. Reactivated in 1975, he was referred to as a government cadre before his new appointment became known.

PENG ZHEN 彭真

By-elected vice-chairman of the 5th National People's Congress's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Peng had been a member of the CCP Political Bureau, 1st Party secretary and mayor of Beijing before the Cultural Revolution. He was the first prominent Party cadre to fall victim to the Cultural Revolution in June 1966. Reactivated in January 1979 Peng was appointed chairman of the Legal Commission under the NPC's Standing Committee in February 1979. During the Second Session of the 5th NPC he headed the Draft Laws Committee.

SHI LIANG (f) 史良

By-elected vice-chairman of the Standing Committee of the 5th National People's Congress (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Shi is one of the first female lawyers of modern China. In the 1930s she often defended communists in court. As one of the founding members of the China Democratic League - she still is its vice-chairman - she held prominent posts after the foundation of the PR China. Inter alia Shi has been a member of the NPC's Standing Committee since 1959.

WANG GANCHANG 王淦昌

Identified as vice-minister of the 2nd Ministry of Machine Building (XNA Jun 4, 1979).

Wang is one of the leading physicists of the PR China and has been head of the Institute of Atomic Energy under the Academy of Sciences since 1978. This may lead us to

conclude that the 2nd Ministry of Machine Building may possibly be the one responsible for nuclear energy.

WANG RENZHONG 王任重

Appointed member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Wang was an alternate member of the CCP Central Committee and 2nd secretary of its Central-South Bureau before the Cultural Revolution. In September 1966 he joined Mao Zedong in swimming across the Changjiang. Purged in the fall of 1966, Wang was reactivated in September 1978 to become 2nd secretary of the Shaanxi CP Committee. Soon afterwards he was ordered to the Centre to become vice premier in December 1978 and minister in charge of the State Agricultural Commission in February 1979.

WANG ZHEN 王震

Appointed member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Wang has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since 1956 and a member of its Political Bureau since December 1978.

His main merit after the foundation of the PR China was an ardent engagement in land reclamation work in Xinjiang.

WU KEHUA 吴克华

Identified as commander of the Xinjiang Military Region (Ürümqi Radio Jun 11, 1979).

Wu, an alternate member of the CCP Central Committee and lieutenant-general of the PLA, was commander of the Chengdu Military Region before his present appointment to Xinjiang where he has succeeded Liu Zhen, a member of the CCP Central Committee and PLA colonel-general, whose last appearance was noted in February 1979.

XIANG NAN 项南

Identified as vice-minister of agricultural machinery (XNA Jun 14, 1979).

Xiang was a vice-minister of the 1st Ministry of Machine Building before his recent appointment. He is also vice president of the Society of Agricultural Machinery (since April 1978).

XIAO JINGGUANG 肖劲光

Appointed vice-chairman of the Standing Committee of the 5th National People's Congress (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Xiao, who has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since 1969 (having been an alternate member between 1956 and 1969), is the cadre longest in an official position in the PR China: He has been commander of the PLA Navy since 1950. He is also the cadre of longest standing in his additional position as a vice-minister of defence which he has held since 1954.

YANG JIARUI 杨嘉瑞

Identified as deputy commander of the Lanzhou Military

Region (XNA Jun 9, 1979).

Yang, a PLA major-general, had been commander of the Shaanxi Military District since 1960, and was promoted to the position of deputy commander of the Lanzhou Military Region in 1966. He disappeared in 1967 and was reactivated in 1976 when he was referred to as a leading cadre of the Lanzhou Military Region.

YAO YILIN 姚依林

Appointed vice premier and secretary-general of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Yao was elected a member of the CCP Central Committee at the 11th Party Congress. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been vice-minister of commerce (1949-1962) and minister of commerce (1962-Cultural Revolution). Purged in 1966, Yao was reactivated in 1973 to become 1st vice-minister of foreign trade in the same year. He was appointed minister of commerce in August 1978 and relieved from that post in February 1979.

YU QIULI 余秋里

Appointed member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Yu won his merits as minister of the petroleum industry, a position he held from 1958 until 1971 (?). In 1972 he became minister of the State Planning Commission and in 1975, vice premier. In 1977 the 11th Party Congress elected him a member of the CCP Political Bureau. He had been a member of the Central Committee since 1969.

YUE ZHIJIAN 岳志坚

Identified as vice-minister of the State Economic Commission (XNA Jun 24, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Yue was director of the Bureau for Scientific and Technical Personnel and vice-chairman of the State Scientific and Technical Commission. In 1978 he became chairman of the Association for Standardization and director of the State Bureau of Standardization. In April 1979 he was appointed vice president of the Recommendation and Examination Committee in charge of classifying inventions under the State Scientific and Technical Commission.

ZHANG JINGFU 张劲夫

Appointed member of the State Financial and Economic Commission (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Zhang, a Party secretary of the Academy of Sciences and vice-chairman of the State Scientific and Technical Commission before the Cultural Revolution, was reactivated in 1974 to become minister of finance in 1975.

ZHANG ZHONGLIANG 张仲良

Identified as secretary of the Jiangsu CP Committee (Nanjing Radio Jun 9, 1979).

Zhang had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution.

Reactivated in January 1979 he has been vice-chairman of the Jiangsu Revolutionary Committee since.

ZHAO FAN 赵凡

Identified as vice-minister of state farms and land reclamation (XNA Jun 13, 1979).

Zhao was a vice-minister of agriculture and forestry before his recent appointment. He has also held the post of director of the State Agricultural Reclamation Administrative Bureau since 1978.

ZHOU RENSHAN 周仁山

Identified as 2nd secretary of the Xinjiang CP Committee (Ürümqi Radio Jun 11, 1979).

Zhou had been secretary of that Committee before his recent promotion.

ZHU RONG 朱荣

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture (XNA Jun 5, 1979).

Zhu was a vice-minister of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry before.

ZHU YUNSHAN 朱蕴山

Appointed vice-chairman of the Standing Committee of the 5th National People's Congress (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Zhu was a member of the NPC Standing Committee before. Born in 1887, he joined the Tung Meng Hui led by Sun Yat-sen, and is a veteran of the 1911 Revolution.

Reactivated Cadres

CHEN CONGLIE 陈宗烈

Identified as vice-chairman of the Shanghai Revolutionary Committee (XNA May 29, 1979).

In 1960 Chen had been first secretary of the Yencheng District's CP Committee.

HONG PEILIN

Identified as vice-chairman of the Jiangsu Provincial Revolutionary Committee (XNA Jun 17, 1979).

In 1962 Hong had been director of the Provincial Department for Public Health.

LIU NINGYI 刘宁一

First reappearance after the Cultural Revolution at the memorial service for Xiao Guichang (XNA Jun 14, 1979).

Liu had been a member of the 8th Central Committee of the CCP. Besides, he held several other posts, the most important being that of chairman of the Chinese Trade Unions (since 1958).

SHI LIDE 史立德

Identified as deputy director of the Federation of Supply

and Marketing Cooperatives (XNA Jun 21, 1979).

Shi had been on the same post from 1963 until the Cultural Revolution.

ZHAO YIMIN 赵毅敏

By-elected member of the 5th Chinese People's Consultative Conference (XNA Jun 5, 1979).

Zhao had been an alternate member of the CCP's 8th Central Committee. His other posts included that of a vice-director of the Central Committee's Department for International Liaison (since 1963) and that of a member of the Standing Committee of the Third National People's Congress (since 1965).

ZHAO ZISHANG 赵子尚

Identified as vice-minister of the coal industry (XNA Jun 5, 1979).

Zhao held the same position before the Cultural Revolution.

Deceased Cadre

ZHOU SHIDI 周士第

Died June 30, 1979 (XNA Jul 8, 1979).
