China's Economic Aid

CONGO (Brazzaville)

The Bouenza hydro-electric power station and a high-tension transmission and transformation project in Southern Congo were handed over on July 4. Preparations for these two projects started in 1973. They are among the first hydroelectric projects in the country, and are the biggest ones in the country's economic construction (XNA Jul 5, 1979).

MAURITIUS

On July 2 minutes of the examination of the preliminary design for the terminal building of a new airport with Chinese assistance were signed (XNA Jul 3, 1979).

PAKISTAN

The engine-rebuilding facilities forming the first phase of the country's first tank rebuilding complex were commissioned at Taxila on July 8. The Chinese-assisted heavy rebuilding factory has been equipped to undertake the rebuilding of complete tanks and major overhauls of engines, and will manufacture thousands of parts and assemblies required for the rebuilding programme. It will also repair hundreds of parts and components of optical, electrical and communications equipment to be reused in the rebuilding process. The factory also has certain sophisticated and rare engineering facilities (Karachi Radio Jul 8, 1979; cit. SWB 6166).

SOMALIA

A clean-water service was completed at Baidos, a town of 30,000, 240 kilometres west of Mogadishu. The project, constructed with Chinese assistance, is now supplying the town with 1,000 tons of water a day. They are served from few pumps (XNA Jul 24, 1978).

SRI LANKA

Sri Lanka fish-breeding experts successfully hatched a species of Chinese carp recently at the Uda Walawe fresh-water breeding experimental station, a Chinese-aided project which was completed last year. Due to the careful preparation and effective operation, the hatching produced over 265,000 fish fry. These have already been placed in ponds (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

YEMEN, PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC (South Yemen)

The Chinese technical group working in Aden Salt Works left here for home upon the completion of the third term of technical cooperation. The salt works was expanded with Chinese aid under the agreement on economic and technical cooperation. The project began in October 1973, and was handed over in June 1976 with a designed capacity of 150,000 tons annually. The Chinese technical group then remained to help in training and operation at the works (XNA Jul 1, 1979).

Personal Data

Known Cadres on New Posts

BANQEN ERDENI 班禅额尔德尼

By-elected vice-chairman of the 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Known in the Western world as Panchen Lama, this living Buddha had been a member of the CPPCC's Standing Committee before - a position he also held before the Cultural Revolution during which he was purged, to be reactivated in February 1978.

DONG CHUNCAI 董纯才

Identified as vice-minister of education (XNA Apr 13, 1979).
Due to a misprint in XNA, Dong was registered under "New Cadres" in C.a. 1979/4 by the name of Dong Cunhai. Dong had been on the same post between 1952 and 1965.

FAN MUHAN 范慕韩

Identified as vice minister of the 6th Ministry of Machine Building (XNA Jul 12, 1979).
Before the Cultural Revolution Fan had been a vice minister of the 1st Ministry of Machine Building. He disappeared in 1967 and was reactivated in 1978.

HAN YING 韩英

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Han is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee and has been 1st secretary of the Communist Youth League since 1978.

HE MINXUE 贺敏学

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Before the Cultural Revolution He had been Party secretary and vice governor of Fujian Province.

HU QILI 胡启立

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Hu, a youth and student cadre before the Cultural Revolution, was reactivated in September 1978 to become a vice president of Qinghua University. In October of the same year he was elected secretary of the Communist Youth

League and chairman of the Youth Federation in May this year.

HU YUZHONG 胡愈之

By-elected vice-chairman of the 5th CPPCC (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Hu is a cadre of long standing in the fields of United Front work and culture. Though he had been a vice-minister of culture from 1959 until the Cultural Revolution, he survived unharmed. His main position after the Cultural Revolution was that of a member of the Standing Committees of the Third to Fifth National People's Congresses.

HUANG XINBAI 黄辛白

Identified as vice-minister of education (XNA Jul 10, 1979).
Huang, who had been a vice-minister of higher education before the Cultural Revolution was purged in 1967. Reactivated in 1972, he has been a vice president of Beijing University since.

LI DONGYE 李东冶

Identified as vice-minister of the Ministry of Metallurgical Industry and as Party secretary of the Anshan Iron and Steel Company (Shenyang Radio Jul 3, 1979).
In 1960 Li was identified as secretary of the Liaoning Provincial CP Committee. He disappeared in 1961 and was not reactivated until now.

LI FENGPING 李丰平

Identified as vice-chairman of the Zhejiang Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Hangzhou Radio Jul 7, 1979).
Since May 1978 Li has also been secretary of the Zhejiang CP Committee, a post he had already held between 1961 and 1964 when he was transferred to Anhui Province to become a Party secretary of the provincial Party Committee.

LI LI 李立

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Before the Cultural Revolution Li had been governor of Guizhou Province. Elected alternate member of the Central Committee by the 9th Party Congress in 1969, he was not confirmed in this position by the 10th Congress. He lost his posts in Guizhou Province - that of a vice-chairman of the

Revolutionary Committee and that of deputy secretary of the Provincial CP Committee in 1976, and disappeared in 1977.

LI WEIHAN 李维汉

By-elected vice-chairman of the 5th CPPCC (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Li, who is now 83 years old, had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and was purged as a counterrevolutionary revisionist in 1967. Reactivated in February 1978 he was elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee one month later, and has been an advisor to the CCP Central Committee's United Front Work Department since March this year.

LI YOUJIU 李友九

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture (KCNA Jul 8, 1979).

Li had been a vice-minister in the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry since May 1978 and remained in that position until February 1979 when the ministry was divided up into one for agriculture and one for forestry.

LI YUNCHANG 李运昌

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Li, reactivated only now, had been a vice-minister of communications until 1959. As a member of the CCP's Central Committee's Control Commission he was elected member of the 4th CPPCC's Standing Committee in January 1965.

LIN HAO 林浩

Identified as commandant of the PLA Political Academy (Xinhua Jul 26, 1979) Lin was known as a military cadre since 1974.

LIU GANG 刘刚

Identified as secretary of Tianjin Municipal CP (Tianjin Radio Jul 16, 1979) Liu, who had been director of the Loyang Tractor Works in the fifteenth and director of the Central Committee's North-west Bureau's Propaganda Department from 1965 until Cultural Revolution was reactivated in May this year, when he could be identified as vice-chairman of the Tianjin Revolutionary Committee.

LIU LANTAO 刘澜涛

By-elected vice-chairman of the 5th CPPCC (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Liu, a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and 1st secretary of its North-West Bureau before the Cultural Revolution, was reactivated in December 1978. Since March this year he has been 1st vice-director of the CCP Central Committee's United Front Work Department.

LIU NINGYI 刘宁一

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Liu had been a member of the 8th CCP's Central Committee. Besides he held a number of other posts, the most important being that of president of the Chinese Trade Unions. Purged in December 1967, 1967, he was reactivated in June this year.

LU DINGYI 陆定一

By-elected vice-chairman of the 5th CPPCC (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Lu had been an alternate member of the Political Bureau of the 8th Central Committee, vice premier and minister of culture. Purged in January 1967, he was reactivated in January 1979.

MA HUIZHI 马辉之

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Ma had held the same post in the 4th CPPCC and was also vice-minister of communications between 1959 and the Cultural Revolution. He was reactivated in June this year.

NIE ZHEN 聂真

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Nie had inter alia been vice president of the People's University and vice-director of the Beijing Institute of Socialism. Reactivated in February 1978, he has been deputy secretary-general of the 5th CPPCC since April of that year.

NIU PEICONG 牛佩琮

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Niu had been vice-director of the State Bureau of Finance and Commerce.

PING JIESAN 平杰三

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Since January this year Ping has held the post of a vice-director of the 11th CCP Central Committee's United Front Work Department, a position he already held from 1958 until the Cultural Revolution during which he was purged.

RONG ZIHE 戎子和

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Rong had been a vice-minister of finance between 1949 and about 1962. In 1965 he was identified as director of the Financial Committee in the North-West Bureau of the CCP Central Committee. He disappeared in 1966 and was reactivated in December 1978.

SHEN BOCHUN 申伯纯

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Shen had been a deputy secretary-general of the CPPCC between 1958 and the Cultural Revolution.

SHU TONG 舒同

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Shu had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee. Between 1955 and 1960 he was 1st secretary of the Shandong Provincial CP Committee. From 1964 until the Cultural Revolution he was secretary of the Shaanxi Provincial CP Committee. Purged in 1967, he was reactivated in January 1978.

SHUAI MENGQI (f) 帅孟奇

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Before the Cultural Revolution Shuai, who is now 82 years old, had been an alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and a women's cadre. She disappeared in 1966 and was reactivated in December 1978.

WANG GUANG 王光

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
In March 1978 Wang was identified as director of the State Publication Administrative Bureau. Since July of the same year Wang has been head of the Hongkong Branch of Xinhua News Agency.

WANG KEJUN 王克俊

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Wang had been a deputy secretary-general of the 4th CPPCC.

WANG KUNLUN 王昆仑

By-elected vice-chairman of the 5th CPPCC (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
From 1958 until the Cultural Revolution Wang had been a vice-mayor of Beijing. Reactivated in 1975, he was elected member of the Standing Committee of the 5th National People's Congress in March 1978.

WEN ZHENGYI 文正一

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Wen, who belongs to the Korean minority, has been a member of the CCP Central Committee's Commission for Inspecting Discipline since December 1978 and was made a member of the State Nationalities Affairs Commission in May this year.

XU BINZHOU 徐斌洲

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Xu, a PLA lieutenant-general, was a vice-minister of agricultural machinery from 1960 until the Cultural Revolution. He survived the Cultural Revolution unharmed and has been a vice-minister of the 1st Ministry of Machine Building since February 1972.

XUE ZIZHENG 薛子正

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Xue had been a vice-director of the CCP Central Committee's United Front Work Department from 1959 until the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in February this year he was made 1st deputy secretary-general of the 5th CPPCC in May.

YANG HANSHENG 杨翰笙

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Before the Cultural Revolution Yang had been a vice-chairman and secretary-general of the Federation of Literary and Art Circles. Purged in 1966 he was reactivated in January this year to become again vice-chairman of the Federation of Literary and Art Circles in May.

YANG JUE 杨珏

Identified as vice-minister of Forestry (Xinhua Jul 23, 1979). In 1964 Yang had been secretary of the Henan Provincial CP and became vice-chairman of the State Economic Commission the following year. Purged in 1967 he was reactivated in 1975 to become vice-director of the State General Forestry Bureau in August 1978.

YANG SHANGKUN 杨尚昆

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
Before the Cultural Revolution Yang had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and director of its General Office. Purged in 1968 he was reactivated in December 1978. In January 1979 he became 2nd secretary of the Guangdong Provincial CP Committee and in May, 1st secretary of the Guangzhou Municipal CP Committee.

YANG XIANDONG 杨显东

Identified as vice-minister of Agriculture (Harbin Radio Jul 19, 1979) Yang had been on the same post before Cultural Revolution. Since January 1978 he is president of the Agronomy Society and since June the same year vice-president of the Academy of Agricultural Science.

YANG XIANZHEN 杨献珍

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

He had been in the same position in the 3rd and 4th CPPCCs, too. Besides, he was a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and president of the Higher Party School between 1955 and 1961. For his theory of "combining two into one" against the political line of "one dividing into two" he was subjected to severe criticism and purged in 1966. He was reactivated in December 1978.

ZHANG PINGHUA 张平花

Identified as vice-minister of the State Agricultural Commission (Xinhua Jul 30, 1979) Zhang, a Hunan cadre and member of the CCP's Central Committee, had been second secretary of Hunan Provincial CP from 1973 until fall of 1977 when he became director of the CCP Central Committee's Propaganda Department. On this post he was succeeded by Hu Yaobang January 1979.

ZHANG YOUYU 张友渔

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Zhang had held the same position in the 4th CPPCC. Besides, he was vice president of the Association for Political Science and Law, vice-director of the Department of Philosophy and Social Science under the Academy of Sciences and director of the Academy's Research Institute of Law. Zhang disappeared in 1966 and was reactivated in February 1979.

ZHANG ZHIYI 张执一

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Zhang had been a vice-director of the CCP Central Committee's United Front Work Department. Purged in 1967 he was reactivated in December 1978.

ZHENG SHAOWEN 郑绍文

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Zheng had been vice-minister of finance between 1954 and 1959, when he disappeared. His first reappearance was in February 1979 when he was appointed vice president of the Supreme People's Court.

Reactivated Cadres

LIU YAXIONG (f) 刘业雄

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

From 1959 until 1964 Liu had been vice-minister of labour. Elected member of the 3rd National People's Congress's Standing Committee in January 1965, she disappeared in 1967 and was not reactivated until now.

WANG RUITING 王瑞庭

Identified as vice-minister of textile industry (XNA Jul 11, 1979).

In 1962 Wang led a group of textile experts to Indonesia.

WANG XIAOCI 王孝慈

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Wang had been vice governor of Gansu Province.

WANG ZAITIAN 王再天

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Wang, a Mongol, was vice-chairman and Party secretary of the Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region. He disappeared in 1967 and was not reactivated until now.

XING FANGQUN 何方群

Identified as alternate secretary of the Trade Unions and as editor-in-chief of 'Workers Daily' (Gungren ribao) (Xinhua Jul 15, 1979) Xing had been editor-in-chief of the Workers Daily from 1965 until Cultural Revolution in which he was purged.

XU MAIJIN 徐迈进

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979);

Between 1959 and the Cultural Revolution Xu had been vice-director of the State Staff Office for Culture and Education.

YANG FANGZHI 杨放之

Identified as director of the State Bureau of Foreign Experts Affairs (Xinhua Jul 22, 1979) Yang had been director of the State Council's secretary in the late fifties and became director of the Office of Foreign Experts Administration in 1959. This post he held until October 1964.

YANG ZHILIN 杨植霖

Appointed member of the National Games Organizing Committee (Xinhua Jul 16, 1979) Yang had been secretary of Inner Mongolia CP from 1958 until 1961. In 1962 became First secretary of Qinghai Provincial CP, a post he held until fall of 1966 when he was purged.

YI LIRONG 易礼容

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Yi Joined Mao Zedong's New People's Society in 1918 and later on worked under Chen Duxiu and Liu Shaoqi (until 1927). In the Yen'an time he became a trade union cadre. He held leading positions in the Chinese Trade Unions until the Cultural Revolution. Between 1954 and 1964 he was also deputy secretary-general of the CPPCC. He disappeared in 1966 and was reactivated now.

ZHANG PANSHI 张磐石

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Zhang had been a cadre in the fields of propaganda and culture, his last position being that of a vice-director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee.

ZHAO YIMIN 赵毅敏

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Zhao had been an alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee. His other posts included that of a vice president of the Association for Cultural Relations with Foreign Countries (1955-1959 and 1966-Cultural Revolution) and of a vice-director of the CCP CENTRAL Committee's Department of International Liaison (since about 1961). Having disappeared in 1967, he was not reactivated until now.

Deceased Cadre

SHEN BOCHUN 申伯纯

Died July 13, 1979 (Xinhua Jul 28, 1979).

A deputy secretary general of the 3rd and 4th CPPCC, Shen was by-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee on July 2, 1979 - only eleven days before his death.

HE ZHUGUO 何柱国

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

LI TIEZHENG 李铁铮

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).

By-elected member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee (XNA Jul 2, 1979).
