Agreements with Foreign Countries

August 1979

- August 2? JORDAN During a Chinese economic and trade exhibition in Amman twenty contracts were signed promoting trade between China and Jordan (1)
- 4 ITT (USA) Agreement between the China Ocean Shipping Company and the International Telephone and Telegram Inc. Far East and Pacific, Inc. According to the agreement, the Chinese company's repair shops in Shanghai, Guangzhou, Tianjin, Qingdao and Dalian will act as representatives of the ITT in repairing communication facilities, navigational aids and broadcasting equipment for Chinese and foreign merchant vessels docking in these ports (2).
- 6 USSR Agreement on goods exchange and payments for 1979 (3)
- SUDAN Trade protocol for 1979-1980 (3), worth 90,000,000 US dollars (4)
- ITALY Agreement between the Chinese National Construction Company and the state-owned Italian Institute for Industrial Reconstruction (IRI) under which Chinese manpower will be made available for civil engineering projects abroad. The five-year agreement, providing in general terms for the use of Chinese labour and advanced Italian technology, followed reports at the end of May that the Chinese had offered to make available to the Italian firm up to 400,000 workers and technicians for public works projects in any country except the countries of the Soviet bloc. The original offer, presented to executives of another IRI subsidiary, cited such projects as the construction of railways, bridges, tunnels and factories. The agreement is within the framework of the Sino-Italian trade agreement concluded last April. The Chinese Metallurgical Industry Ministry, which made the initial proposal to the IRI group, said it had more than 30 civil engineering units divided into 20 companies which could provide 130,000 men for civil engineering projects, 40,000 for mining projects, 50,000 in the electrical and mechanical engineering sectors and a further 71,000 for such tasks as construction of blast furnaces, steel structures, prefabricated concrete structures, earth and stone work and the construction of machinery and repairs (5);
- 9? PAKISTAN China and Pakistan signed a revised border trade agreement in Gilgit; they also ratified the border trade agreement signed in June this year. Pakistan will export to China local products of dried fruits, nylon scarves, leather goods, cotton daris (blankets) and medicinal herbs. China will export agricultural implements, hardware, tools, plants, fur coats, utensils and crockery (6).
- 10 MONGOLIA, PR Protocol on the mutual supply of goods for 1979 (7)
- 13 CONGO (Brazz.) Protocol on economic and technical cooperation under which China is to send technicians to the "Naval Yard of Congo" (8)
- 15 SRI LANKA Agreement on cultural cooperation. It will guarantee further development in exchanges and cooperation in the fields of culture, arts, education, sports, and journalism (9).
- YUGOSLAVIA The Xinhua News Agency and Tanjug, the Yugoslav Telegraph Agency, signed an agreement for the exchange of news items and cooperation (9).
- 16 TANZANIA Protocol of the 13th meeting of the Board of Directors of the Chinese-Tanzanian Joint Shipping Company (10).

- 18 ROMANIA Agreement on cooperation between the Xinhua News Agency and Agerpress, the Romanian News Agency (11)
- YEMEN, Arab Rep. Contract between China's Road and Bridge Construction Company and North Yemen's Urban Affairs Ministry for designing road construction in the urban areas of Sanaa. Projects contained in the contract include: an expansion project for a 5.8 kilometre-long street and the surfacing with bitumen of another two streets covering altogether 205,000 square metres. The Chinese company sent an advance group to this country last March for contracting projects. It has signed with the Yemeni side two contracts for construction and two for designing. They are an expansion project for the terminal area of the Sanaa airport; a contract for the construction of a heliport at the Republican Palace and two contracts for designing road construction in Sanaa and the City of Hajah. The projects will cost a total of 10 million US dollars (11).
- 22 NEW ZEALAND Memorandum on the establishment of a model centre for animal husbandry at Wuxuan, Guangxi Autonomous Region (12).
- 28 KOREA, DPR Protocol on border railway transport for 1979 (13).
- USA (a) Implementing accord for cultural exchange in 1980 and 1981. It stipulates concrete items for exchange between the two countries in culture and art, education, broadcasting, books and other literature, garden designing and architecture, cultural study, sports, social science and translation and publication, as well as financial provisions.
- (b) Protocol on cooperation in hydroelectric power and related water resource management. The protocol stipulates that both parties agree to promote and establish cooperation in the sphere of hydroelectric power and related water resources on the basis of equality, mutual benefit and reciprocity and make appropriate arrangements, encourage and provide facilities for concrete cooperative activities. According to the protocol, such cooperation includes exchanging and providing each other with information, taking joint ventures in experiment and research, exchanging specialists and training technical personnel and providing plans, engineering designs and advice on technical questions and construction management. - July 21 FRANCE Memorandum on the construction of 13 projects ... A further series of agreements concerns the cooperation to be put into effect by three French companies: Alsthom for transformers, Merlin Gerin for circuit-breakers and Cohen et Belier (?) in the engineering sphere. These three agreements represent contracts worth in all about 100,000,000 francs (15).

China's Economic Aid

August 1979

BURMA

A protocol was signed on August 1 on the Chinese provision of more than 7,000,000 pounds sterling worth of machinery and equipment for the Shwedaung textile mill project (Rangoon Radio Aug 1, 1979; cit. SWB/W 1044).

CONGO (Brazz.)

China is to send technicians to the "Naval Yard of Congo" in accordance with a protocol signed on August 13 (XNA Aug 13, 1979).

GUINEA

The second group of Guinea's dentist auxiliaries passed out from the dentist centre in Conakry on August 11. They were trained by the Chinese medical team now working in Guinea (XNA Aug 11, 1979).

NEPAL

The total output value of the Bansbari leather shoe factory, built with Chinese aid in the late sixties, reached 10.2 million rupees in 1978-1979, - a nearly fivefold increase over 1972-1973. In a drive to promote export, the factory sold 250 tons of shoe soles to China last year. Under a contract made with West Germany this year, 40,000 pairs of slippers will be exported to the latter (XNA Aug 27, 1979).

SRI LANKA

China has offered Sri Lanka an interest-free loan of 500,000,000 rupees, repayable over 20 years, to cover three projects: a new marketing complex in Colombo; water supply

facilities and the development of modern villages.

TANZANIA

Chinese experts in coal prospecting completed their work at Ilima, Mbeya region, which started in 1975. They discovered an estimated reserve of more than 50,000,000 tons of coal (XNA Aug 24, 1979).

TUNISIA

The Tunisian premier minister laid a foundation-stone for the Chinese-aided Medjerdah-Cap Bon canal project. The 123 kilometre-long canal constitutes the main part of the water conservancy plan in Northern Tunisia. On completion it will provide water for the citizens in the capital as well as Cap Bon and Sahel, and irrigate nearly 20,000 hectares of farmland (XNA Aug 15, 1979).

YEMEN, Arab Republic

China's Road and Bridge Construction Company has signed four contracts with North Yemen: two for airport and heliport construction and two for road construction design. The total cost will be 10,000,000 US dollars (XNA Aug 1979).

BASANG f. 巴桑

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).
Basang, a secretary of the CCP Central Committee, had been vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee before.

FAN ZUOKAI 樊作楷

Identified as assistant foreign minister (XNA Aug 23, 1979).
Fan had been ambassador to Somalia (1970-1975) and to Mali (1975-1978) before.

GUO XILAN 郭锡兰

Elected first vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).
Guo has been a Tibet cadre since the fifties. Reactivated after the Cultural Revolution in 1971 he was vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee until it was renamed Regional People's Government and still is secretary of the Tibet CP Committee.

JIANG YIZHEN 江一真

Identified as second secretary of the Hebei Provincial CP Committee and as vice-chairman of the Hebei Revolutionary Committee (XNA Aug 31, 1979).
Before the Cultural Revolution Jiang had been governor of Fujian Province until 1979, vice-minister of state farms and land reclamation (1962-1963) and vice-minister of agriculture (1964-1966). Reactivated in 1974, he became minister of public health in 1977, - a post he held until April 1979.

LI BENSHAN 李本善

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).
Li has been a Tibet cadre since the 1960s. Reactivated in 1973,

he was first secretary of the Lhasa Municipal CP Committee until the fall of 1977 when he disappeared, to reappear now.

LOZONG ZUCHENG 洛桑慈诚

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).
Lozong, a Tibetan, had inter alia been president of the Tibet Higher People's Court before the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in 1975, he was made vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee.

NIU RUIZHOU 牛瑞驹

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).
As a then newcomer, Niu was elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee in December 1977.

PAGBALHA GELEG NAMGYAI 帕巴拉卓列朗杰

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).
Pagbalha, a 'Living Buddha', had been vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Region before the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in 1972, he has been a vice-chairman of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference since. In 1978 he was elected deputy of Tibet to the 5th National People's Congress.

QIAO JIAJIN 乔加欣

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).
As a then newcomer, Qiao was elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee in December 1977.

RONG GOATANG 荣高棠

Identified as vice-minister of the Physical Culture and Sports Commission (XNA Aug 30, 1979).
Rong is a sports cadre of long standing. In this field he held a

number of prominent posts before the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in February 1979, he was elected vice-president of the Sports Federation the following month.

TIANBAO 天宝

Elected chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).

Tianbao has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since 1969. Before his present appointment he had been vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee, and still is secretary of the Tibet CP Committee.

TING MAO 廷懋

Identified as second secretary of the Inner Mongolia Autonomous Regional CP (Hohhot Radio Jul 25, 1979).

Ting, a PLA major-general, had been deputy political commissar of the Inner Mongolia Military Region before the Cultural Revolution, during which he was purged. He was reactivated as second political commissar of the Inner Mongolia Military District in June this year.

WU LANTING 乌兰亭

Identified as deputy commander of the Wuhan Military Region (Hefei Radio Aug 11, 1979).

Wu had been deputy commander of the Anhui Military District in 1970 and then disappeared, to be reactivated now.

YANG ZONGXIN 杨宗欣

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).

A Tibet cadre before the Cultural Revolution, Yang was reactivated in 1974 to become a vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee the following year.

YAO YILIN 姚依林

Identified as deputy secretary-general of the CCP Central Committee (XNA Aug 30, 1979).

Yao is a member of the CCP Central Committee and vice premier. Appointed secretary-general of the State Financial and Economic Commission in July this year, he has now attained a position in the CCP hierarchy similar to his prominent positions in the government.

YIN ZHE 尹喆

Identified as secretary of the Hebei Provincial CP Committee (Shijiazhuang Radio Aug 18, 1979).

Yin had been a member of the Standing Committee of the Hebei Provincial CP Committee.

YUAN ZHEN 袁振

Identified as a vice-chairman of the Anhui Provincial Revolutionary Committee and as a member of the Standing Committee of the Anhui Provincial CP Committee (Hefei Radio July 28, 1979).

Yuan had been first secretary of the Taiyuan Municipal CP Committee before the Cultural Revolution and was elected vice-chairman of the Shanxi Revolutionary Committee in 1967, to

disappear thereafter. He was not reactivated until now.

ZENG SAN 曾三

Identified as vice-director of the General Office of the CCP Central Committee (XNA Aug 30, 1979).

Zeng had held the same post from 1956 until the Cultural Revolution. In addition he was director of the State Archives Bureau (1954 until Cultural Revolution) and director of the Central Archives Library (1959 until Cultural Revolution); Zeng was reactivated in December 1978 when he was appointed member of the Commission for Inspecting Discipline under the CCP Central Committee.

ZHA-XI-WANG-XU 扎喜旺徐

Identified as secretary of the Qinghai Provincial CP Committee (Xining Radio Aug 1, 1979).

Zha's Tibetan name is Drashi Wongshi. He was elected member of the State Nationalities Commission in May this year.

ZHANG JINXIAN

Identified as vice-chairman of the Hubei Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Wuhan Radio Aug 27, 1979).

Zhang has been a member of the Standing Committee of the Hubei Provincial CP Committee since 1976.

ZHANG ZHONG 张中

Identified as director of the State Archives Bureau (XNA Aug 30, 1979).

Zhang had been a vice-director of that Bureau between 1955 and the Cultural Revolution during which he was purged. He was reactivated in December 1978.

ZHAO XIU 赵修

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture (XNA Aug 22, 1979).

Zhao had been a vice-governor of Hubei Province before the Cultural Revolution. He was reactivated as Party secretary of that province in 1973, and disappeared in March 1977. In April this year Zhao was identified as director of the Animal Husbandry Bureau under the Ministry of Agriculture.

HOU JIE 侯杰

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Autonomous Regional People's Government (XNA Aug 31, 1979).

In the 1960s Hou had been director of the Department of Industry and Communications and member of the Standing Committee of the Tibet CP Committee.
