


AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Uganda (Sep 10) Protocol on China sending a medical team to Uganda. XNA, Sep 10, 1982

U.S.A. (Sep 20)

Document for further cooperation in hydroelectric power and related water resource management for the period 1982-84. The document is the annex two to the U.S.-China hydropower protocol which was signed in August 1979 after the normalization of relations between the two countries. Annex one to the protocol was signed in march 1980, which had been carried out over the last two years. Besides continuation of implementation of uncompleted activities under annex one, annex two focuses on cooperative activities of science and technology on one of the major hydropower projects in China-Hongshui river basin development plan. Some other annex two activities include continued cooperative studies of other potential Chinese hydropower projects, such as Longtan, Ertan and the three gorges of the Yangzi river. U.S. private firms will be involved in these activities under annex two. XNA, Sep 20, 1982

Sri Lanka (Sep 21)

Five-year trade agreement which will into operation on 1st January come 1983. The agreement provides for cash trading in a wide range of goods in place of the traditional rubber for rice barter deal. Under this agreement both countries expect the overall trade to rise sharply from the present 1,000 million rupees to 1,600 million rupees during 1983. Sri Lanka and China will give each other most favoured nation treatment. Both countries now envisage a joint committee to review implementation of the agreement and to promote bilateral trade.

Japan (Sep 23)

Summary of the talks on the fourth meeting on the China-Japan long-term trade agreement. According to the text of the summary, both sides agreed that China will export eight to 8.6 million tons of crude oil to Japan annually between 1983 and 1985, and it will export 4.5 million tons of coal to Japan in 1983, six million tons in 1984, and seven to eight million tons in 1985 according to the needs and possibilities of the two sides. They also agreed that as new progress is made in China's economic readjustment and foreign trade, China will make every possible effort to import technology and equipment from Japan. Japan (Sep 27)

Japan (Sep 21) Exchange of notes on a Japanese gov-ernment loan to the Chinese govern-ment in 1982. According to them, Japan will provide a loan of 65,000 yen.

XNA, Sep 27, 1982 This loan will be used to assist four projects involving harbours and rail-ways. The projects, which include construction of Shijiusuo harbour, expansion of Qinhuangdao harbour and expansion of railways between Yanzhou and Shijiusuo and between Peking and Qinhuangdao, have been underway since 1979 with Japanese economic cooperation. The 65,000 million yen, agreed upon between the two countries in working-level negotiations at the end of August, will be the amount Japan will provide during the current fiscal year ending next March. This amount will raise the sum of money Japan offered to China in connection the four projects to about with 230,000 million yen. The money will be made available from the governmental Overseas Economic Co-operation Fund at an annual interest rate of 3% with a 30-year repayment period, including a 10-year grace period. Gabon

On Sep 10 a foundation stone laying ceremony for a medical center to be built in Libreville with Chinese aid was held. It will be able to receive 300 outpatients per day. (XNA, Sep 11, 1982)

Mali

A Chinese medical team has completed its mission and will return home soon. (XNA, Sep 5, 1982)

Senegal

Senegalese Prime Minister Habib Thiam today laid the foundation stone for the friendship stadium, a 60,000-seat sports complex to be constructed with Chinese aid. The construction of the stadium, located in the suburbs of Dakar, will be aided by China according to a summary of talks signed by the two countries in 1975 and be completed in three years. (XNA, Sep 1, 1982)

Sri Lanka

On Sep 20 the Gin Ganga river regulation project at Indigasketiy in Baddagama in the Southern Province was opened. The entire project consists of over 170 items and covers an area of 200 kilometres on both banks of the river. Among the main items built are 74 bunds, 10 pumping stations, a switch centre, 21 drainage channels totalling of 33.7 kilometres, eight highway bridges and 36.6 kilometres of 33 kv. transmission line. In the past, constant floods of the river brought enormous losses of life and property to the country. With the completion of the project, it will be basically put under control and greatly benefit Sri Lanka's national economic development and the livelihood of the people. (XNA, Sep 20, 1982)

The Chinese-aided cotton cloth finishing plant of the Pugoda textile mill was handed over on Sep 29. With the completion of this finishing plant, the Pugoda textile mill has become a completely and fully equipped textile mill. While the plant is estimated to have cost over rs. 133 million, it is provided with a capacity to produce over 16 million meters of cloth annually. (XNA, Sep 30, 1982)

Uganda

A protocol under which China is to send a medical team to work in Uganda for the first time was signed on 10th September. (XNA, Sep 10, 1982)

Yemen, Arab Republic

The China-aided Amran-Hajja road was opened to traffic. With the completion of the 76-kilometer-long highway, the distance between Western Saudi Arabia and Sanaa will reduced by over 200 kilometers. (XNA, Sep 20, 1982)

Zambia

In connection with the Chinese-aided Serenje-Mansa road Zambia's longest highway bridge is under construction. The bridge spanning the Luapula river, which divides the country from Zaire, is 2,804 meters long. It is the biggest project ever undertaken by Chinese technicians. (XNA, Sep 12, 1982)

Hu was a newcomer when he was elected vice-governor of Fujian Province in Nov 1981. On Sep 11th this year he was elected alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee.

Jiang Nanxiang

Identified as 1st vice-president of the Party School under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Sep 4, 1982) Jiang held the post of president of the Qinghua University from 1952 until the Cultural Revolution. He is a member of the CCP Cenral Committee since Sep 1979.

Li Wenyuan

Identified as vice-chairman, People's Congress of Hubei Province (Wuhan Radio, Aug 21, 1982) Li is a newcomer.

Li Shusheng

Identified as deputy secretary of Yunnan Province CP (XNA, Sep 2, 1981) Li was a newcomer when he was elected deputy for Yunnan to the 5th NPC in Feb 1978.

Ma Ruihua (f)

Identified as vice-chairman, People's Congress of Henan Province (Zhengzhou Radio, Aug 24, 1982)

From 1969 until 1977 when she disappeared Ma had been a vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee.

Pei Wenzhong

Deceased Sep 18, 1982 (XNA, Sep 28, 1982) Pei discovered the "Peking Man" in

1929.

Tai Shuzeng

Vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Hubei Province (Wuhan Radio, Aug 21, 1982) Tai is a newcomer.

Yu Qiuli

Identified as director of the PLA General Political Department (XNA, Sep 28, 1982)

Yu is a member of the CCP 12th Politburo as is Wei Guoqing whom he succeeds.

Changes in China's Diplomatic Service

New Ambassador

Jin Minsheng
