Agreement for economic industrial and technical cooperation. It says, "with a view to strengthening the friendly relations between two countries, the contracting parties shall encourage the development of economic, industrial and technical cooperation between institutions, economic organizations and enterprises in the respective countries. The contracting parties shall promote the realization of cooperation projects between institutions, economic organizations and enterprises in the two countries." Under the agreement, the two contracting parties will establish a mixed commission, consisting of representatives of competent authorities and economic organizations of the two countries.

Basic agreement. According to it, the two sides will strengthen technical cooperation in health activities in a spirit of friendly cooperation, and they agreed to the establishment of technical advisory cooperation.
