AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Yugoslavia (Nov 01)

Protocol on sports exchange. According to the protocol, China will send in 1983 chess and figure skating teams, a sports delegation and a sports press group to Yugoslavia, while Yugoslavia will send a women's basketball team, a parachuting team to China and send a water polo referee to give lectures in China.

Togo (Nov 02)

Agreement for technical cooperation in running the Hall of the Rally of the Togolese People. Under the agreement China will send technical personnel to help run the hall and train Togolese technicians.

F.A.O.

World Food Programm (Nov 05)

Protocol on developing forestry and fishery. According to the protocols, W.F.P. will offer food to peasants and fishermen in four countries which need land protection and development of fishery resources. The total value of the projects is estimated at 17.87 Mio. US\$. The project on forestry aims at planting fast-growing forest species on land now unused or highly denuded in order to protect neighboring agricultural areas and to provide timber. A total of 10,500 hectares are planned to be reclaimed in Shandong and Sichuan Provinces in four years, according to the protocol. The protocol on fishery states that the purpose of the project is to improve the life of fishermen in Hongze County, Jiangsu Province, near the Hongze Lake, one of the largest in China. In order to achieve these objectives it is proposed to rehabilitate lake fisheries, increase aquaculture production and reduce spoilage of aquatic products through improved techniques.

Protocol on the 35th Meeting of the Korea-China Amnok River Hydraulic Power Company.

Colombia (Nov 10)

Cultural agreement. Under it China will send a Peking opera troupe to visit Colombia and a Colombian folk song and dance ensemble will go to China. The agreement stipulates that the two countries will also send cultural delegation to visit each other, hold exhibitions and increase contacts in the fields of education, publication, broadcasting, television and sports.

Working plan for 1983-84 scientific cooperation between the academies of sciences.

Ecuador (Nov 16)

Agreement on cultural cooperation.

XNA, Nov 17, 1982

World Bank (Nov 16)

Loan agreement under which the World Bank will provide China with a 75.4 Mio.US\$ long-term, interest-free loan for agricultural education and research projects. The loan will be used to improve 11 national colleges in agriculture, forestry, aquatic products, water conservancy and meteorology, build 19 experimental centers and improve 22 existing laboratories. Part of the loan will be used to pay the cost of inviting foreign scholars to lecture in China, and sending teachers and students abroad for advanced study. Seven research institutes will be built including the China Rice Research Institute, a library and an information center for the Chinese Academy of Agricultural Sciences, an animal husbandry research center and research centers for water conservancy, forestry, aquatic products and weather. The colleges and research centers will be equipped with up-to-date equipment and teaching facilities and the enrollment of students will increase about one-third and post-graduates will at least double, the ministry said.

Cultural exchange agreement for 1983-84, involving cooperation in the political, economic, cultural and sports sectors.

Protocol on promoting rice production (for details see "China's Economic aid")

Bangladesh (Nov 23)

Protocol on scientific and technical cooperation. Under it, in 1983, Bangladesh will study China's silk industry, mini-hydropower station, bio-gas and renewable energy technology, cottage industries and pottery. China will study Bangladesh's management and utilization of bamboo groves; medium- and small-scale jute and textile enterprises; production, technology and equipment of jute carpet backing; flood control and harnessing of water resources along the lower reaches of the Ganges river; and fishery and aquatic products.

Congo (Nov 25)

Two protocols on economic and technical cooperation. Under one agreement, China will send agrotechnicians to the Congo to help expand a state farm, emphasizing pig and poultry raising and vegetable growing. Under another

agreement, 22 Chinese technicians working at a shipyard in the Congo will train Congolese workers for the plant.

Great Britain (Nov 26)

Memorandum of understanding between the Chinese Academy of Medical Science and the British Royal Society. Under it both institutions will increase exchanges and cooperation in 1983.

North Korea (Nov 28)

Three agreements between the Bank of China and the Foreign Trade Bank of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea on the trade and non-trade payment and settlement and the exchange of the currencies of the two countries.

Bangladesh (Nov 29)

Loan agreement. The loan is provided by the Chinese government in accordance with the needs of the Bangladesh government for developing its national economy. The loan will be used to pay for projects provided under the agreement between the two governments.

Benin

The Cotonou comprehensive stadium was handed over. The construction started in December 1977 and concluded in June 1982. There are a stadium, a gymnasium, a swimming pool, a dormitory for athletes and some training facilities in the comprehensive stadium of 30 hectares.

Two agreements were signed on 25th November related to

The inauguration ceremony for the dormitories for a sugar refinery and a sugar-cane farm built with Chinese assistance at Mamunta took place in the presence of president Stevens. This joint venture was officially handed over in February 1982. The 13,000 square meters project will be completed in October 1984.

Togo

Under a protocol signed on 2nd November China will render technical help in running the hall of the Rally of the Togolese People, built with Chinese aid. The building, completed in Lama-Kara in October 1982, is 430 kilometers from the capital Lome.

Identified as political commissar of Jinan Military Region (Jinan Radio, Nov 6, 1982)

Chen has been deputy political commissar of that military region before. He is a major-general of the PLA and was elected member of the CCP Central Committee by the 12th Party Congress in September this year.

Hou Jie 侯捷

Identified as secretary of Heilongjiang CP (Harbin Radio, Oct 23, 1982)

Hou has been a member of the Standing Committee of that CP before. Since 1979 he also holds the position of a vice-governor of Heilongjiang.

Hou Runtao 侯润陶

Identified as deputy commander of Wuhan Military Region (Wuhan Radio, Nov 4, 1982)

Hou is a newcomer.

Huang Guangxue

Identified as vice-minister of the State Nationalities Affairs Commission (Urumqi Radio, Nov 10, 1982)

Huang is a newcomer.

Jiang Guanghua

Identified as deputy director of the International Liaison Department under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Nov 21, 1982)

Jiang has been a section chief of this department before.

Liu Chun 刘春

Appointed director of the Institut of Foreign Affairs (XNA, Nov 17, 1982)

Liu served in the diplomatic field since the 1960s. He held ambassador post in

Laos (1962-67); Turkey (1972-76); Tanzania, Seychelles (1976-79); Egypt (1980-82).

Liu Guoguang 刘国光

Identified as vice-president of the Academy of Social Sciences (XNA, Nov 1, 1982)

In 1980 Liu was identified as deputy director of the Economics Institute of that academy. In September this year he was elected alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee.

Wan Haifeng 万海峰

Identified as political commissar of Chengdu Military Region (Chengdu Radio, Nov 15, 1982)

Wan has been deputy political commissar of Beijing Military Region before. In September this year he was elected member of the CCP 12th Central Committee.

Wang Wentong

Identified as vice-minister of public security (XNA, Nov 18, 1982)

Wang is a newcomer.

Wu Xueqian 吴学谦

Appointed minister of foreign affairs (XNA, Nov 21, 1982)

A deputy director of the Department for International Liaison under the CCP Central Committee from May 1978 until May 1982 he became vice-minister of foreign affairs the latter date. The 12th Party Congress elected him member of the Central Committee in September this year.

Xu Fangchun 徐芳春

Identified as deputy commander of Guangzhou Military Region (Nanfeng Ribao, Nov 2, 1982; cit. SWB 7181)

In 1973 Xu could be identified as deputy commander of Hunan Military District. In 1978 he was elected deputy of the PLA for the 5th NPC.

You Taizhong 尤太忠

Identified as commander of Guangzhou Military Region (XNA, Nov 1, 1982)

You has been commander of Chengdu Military Region before.

Yuan Jie

Identified as deputy commander of Beijing Military Region (XNA, Nov 10, 1982)

Yuan is a newcomer.

Yuan Zhen 袁振

Identified as secretary of Anhui Province CP (Hefei Radio, Nov 12, 1982)

Yuan has been a member of the Standing Committee of Anhui CP before.

Zhang Aiping 张爱萍

Appointed minister of national defense (XNA, Nov 19, 1982)

Zhang held the position of a deputy chief of staff of the PLA from 1954 until the Cultural Revolution and again since 1977. In this capacity he was mainly responsible for the development of China nuclear weapons and rockets.

Zhang Wannian 张万年

Identified as deputy commander of Wuhan Military Region (Wuhan Radio, Nov 9, 1982)

Zhang was a newcomer when he was elected alternate member of the CCP 12th Central Committee in Sep this year.

Zhang Xudeng 张序登
