## China's Economic Aid

December 1977

### BENIN

The construction of the Cotonou stadium began on Dec 7, 1977. The stadium will be situated 10 km from Cotonou, covering 30 hectares of land. It will include a stadium seating 31,000 spectators, an indoor gymnasium, swimming pools, lodgings, open-air training grounds, and parking lots (NCNA Dec 8, 1977).

### CAMEROON

A Chinese medical team left the country and a new one took over (NCNA Dec 6, 1977).

### EQUATORIAL GUINEA

A road between Ncue and Mongomo, which was built with Chinese aid, was handed over on Dec 7, 1977 (NCNA Dec 11, 1977).

### ETHIOPIA

A cotton mill with 25,000 spindles and 624 looms will be constructed at Awassa, with Chinese assistance. Minutes of talks on this project were signed on Dec 19, 1977 (NCNA Dec 20, 1977).

### GHANA

Chinese technicians are giving technical guidance in the installation of cotton-spinning equipment. They came to Ghana in June 1976 (NCNA Dec 19, 1977).

### KUWAIT

An agreement on economic and technical cooperation was signed on Dec 26, 1977 (NCNA Dec 26, 1977).

### LIBERIA

A sugar mill, built with Chinese assistance, was put into operation in Barrake, Maryland county, on Dec 16, 1977 (NCNA Dec 19, 1977).

### TOGO

The construction of the irrigation project in Pota on the Sio river began on Dec 16, 1977 (NCNA Dec 16, 1977).

### TUNISIA

The second Chinese medical team left for home and the third arrived (NCNA Dec 19, 1977).

### VIETNAM

A textbook printing house established with Chinese aid has been completed in the suburbs of Hanoi. It covers an area of 10,000 square metres. Its automatic or semi-automatic machines are capable of printing textbooks and coloured materials (NCNA Dec 16, 1977). The construction of the printing house started in October 1973. Both the typographic and offset processes in this factory are carried out by automatic and semi-automatic equipment. The plant can print 3,000 million book-pages a year in Vietnamese, Chinese, Russian, French, or English (VNA Dec 15, 1977; cit. SWB/W 961).

CHAO LI-CHIH 赵力之

Elected vice-chairman of the Shansi Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 22, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Chao had been a secretary of the Taiyuan CCP Committee.

CHAO P'ENG-FEI 赵鹏飞

Elected vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

From 1960 until 1967 Chao was vice-mayor of Peking.

CHAO TSENG-YI 赵增益

Elected deputy secretary of the Yunnan CCP Committee (Kunming Radio, Dec 14, 1977).

Chao had been first secretary of the Kunming Party Committee since 1957 when he disappeared during the Cultural Revolution.

CH'EN TSO-LIN 陈作霖

Elected vice-chairman of the Chekiang Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 30, 1977).

Ch'en is an alternate member of the 11th CCP Central Committee, and has been secretary of the Chekiang Party Committee since June 1977.

CHENG YUNG-HO 郑永和

Elected vice-chairman of the Honan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 19, 1977).

Cheng had been referred to as a government cadre in December 1976.

CH'I SHOU-LIANG 齐寿良

Elected vice-chairman of the Hunan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 3, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution, Ch'i had been first Party secretary of the West Hunan Autonomous Chou. He disappeared during the Cultural Revolution and was reactivated in February 1977, holding the post of first Party secretary of Changsha since.

CHIA LIN-FANG 贾林放

Elected vice-chairman of the Kueichou Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 9, 1977).

From 1963 until the Cultural Revolution, Chia was vice-minister of the coal industry.

CHIA YÜN-PIAO 贾云标

Elected vice-chairman of the Shansi Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 15, 1977).

From 1964 until the Cultural Revolution Chia had been vice-governor of Shansi province.

CHIANG NAN-HSIANG 蒋南翔

Identified as vice-minister of the Science and Technology Commission under the State Council (NCNA Dec 12, 1977).

Chiang was an alternate member of the 8th Central Committee of the CCP, president of Tsinghua University between 1960 and 1963, and minister for higher education between 1965 and the Cultural Revolution. He was then denounced as a follower of Liu Shao-ch'i. Reactivated in 1974, Chiang was appointed vice-chairman of the Tientsin Municipal Revolutionary Committee in July 1977.

CHIANG PAO-TI (f) 蒋宝婣

Elected vice-chairman of the Chekiang Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 30, 1977).

Chiang has been an alternate member of the CCP Central Committee since 1969 and chairman of the Chekiang Trade Unions since 1973.

CHOU LIN 周林

Identified as vice-minister of education (NCNA Dec 12, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Chou was first Party secretary and governor of Kueichou province. He was then denounced for being a capitalist roader and revisionist.

CHOU TSE 周泽

Elected secretary of the Kiangsu CCP Committee (NCNA Dec 16, 1977).

Before his present appointment, Chou had been a member of the Standing Committee of the Kiangsu Party Committee.

CH'U CHIANG 储江

Elected secretary of the Kiangsu CCP Committee (NCNA Dec 16, 1977).

Ch'u is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee and also Party secretary of Nanking Municipality.

CHU LI-CHIH 朱理治

Elected vice-chairman of the Hopei Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 13, 1977).

This is the first time Chu has appeared after the Cultural Revolution. Before that event he had first been vice-minister

of communications (until 1958) and then vice-minister of the State Planning Commission (1958-1963).

CHU MU-CHIH 朱穆之

Identified as vice-director of the CCP Central Committee's Propaganda Department (NCNA Dec 19, 1977).

Chu, a member of the CCP Central Committee since its 10th Congress in 1973, has held the post of director of NCNA since 1972 (in December 1977 he was succeeded in that post by Tseng T'ao).

CHUNG KUO-CH'U 钟国楚

Elected secretary of the Kiangsu CCP Committee (NCNA Dec 16, 1977).

Chung is a major-general and has held the post of 2nd political commissar of the Kiangsu Military District since May 1977.

FENG K'E 冯克

Elected vice-chairman of the Chekiang Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 30, 1977).

Feng has been a member of the Standing Committee of the Chekiang Provincial Party Committee since mid-1976.

HSI-HOU-PA 希侯巴

Elected vice-chairman of the Chinghai Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 30, 1977).

Hsi is a Tibetan national and a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee.

HSIANG SHOU-CHIH 向守志

Identified as deputy commander of the Nanking Military Region (NCNA Dec 27, 1977).

Hsiang was known as a "leading military cadre" stationed in Peking since 1974 until he was transferred to Nanking in October 1977.

HSÜ CHI-HAI 徐其海

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangsi Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 24, 1977).

Hsü had been a member of that Revolutionary Committee before his recent appointment, and he also was a deputy commander of the Kuangsi Military District (last mentioned in October 1975).

HU SHANG-LI

Elected vice-chairman of the Honan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 19, 1977).

Hu has been a political commissar of the Honan Military District since 1976.

HU YAO-PANG 胡耀邦

Identified as director of the CCP Central Committee's Department for Organization (NCNA Dec 21, 1977).

Hu had been China's leading youth cadre before the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in 1972, he was reelected to the membership of the CCP Central Committee by its 11th Congress. Since October 1977, Hu has been vice-president of the Central Committee's Party School.

HUANG CHEN 黄镇

Identified as minister of culture (NCNA Dec 16, 1977).

Huang, a member of the CCP Central Committee since its 9th

Congress in 1969, was one of China's most prominent diplomats before he became minister of culture. He held the following posts in the diplomatic service: ambassador to Hungary (1950-1954), Indonesia (1954-1961), vice-minister of foreign affairs (1961-1964), ambassador to France (1963-1973), and head of China's Liaison Office in Washington (1973-1977).

HUANG CHIH-KANG 黄志刚

Elected vice-chairman of the Tientsin Municipal Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977). Identified as 2nd secretary of the Tientsin CCP Committee (Tientsin Radio, Dec 9, 1977).

Huang, who was reactivated in May 1977, had been director of the Propaganda Department of the CCP Central Committee's North China Bureau from 1963 until 1965.

HUANG JUNG 黄荣

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangsi Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 24, 1977).

Huang is a former Kuomintang officer who had been deputy to the First to Third National People's Congresses for Kuangsi and also vice-chairman of the Kuangsi Party Committee before the Cultural Revolution.

HUANG K'UN 黄崑

Appointed director of the Institute of Semi-Conductors under the Academy of Science (NCNA Dec 25, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Huang had been a professor in physics at the Peking University.

JAN YEN-NUNG 丹砚农

Elected vice-chairman of the Kueichou Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 9, 1977).

Jan was vice-director of the Agricultural Work Department of Wuhan City's Party Committee before the Cultural Revolution.

KAO CHIH-KUO 高治国

Elected vice-chairman of the Yunnan Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 26, 1977).

Kao was assistant-minister in the Ministry of the Power Industry (1955-1958), first Party secretary and president of Yunnan University (1961-1964), and Party secretary of the Yunnan Provincial Party Committee (1965-1968).

KAO YI 高沂

Identified as vice-minister of education (NCNA Dec 5, 1977).

Kao was vice-president of the Tsinghua University (1962) and vice-minister of higher education (1965-1966).

KU YÜN-T'ING 谷云亭

Identified as secretary of the Tientsin Municipal Party Committee (Tientsin Radio, Dec 9, 1977).

Ku was on the same post before the Cultural Revolution, from 1958 until 1967).

K'UNG AN-MIN 孔安民

Identified as vice-chairman of the Hunan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Changsha Radio, Dec 12, 1977). K'ung was deputy secretary of the Changsha Party Committee between 1960 and 1966.

KUO HSIEN-JUI 郭献瑞

Elected vice-chairman of the Peking Municipal Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Between 1960 and 1961 Kuo was a vice-minister of commerce.

LI CHIA-JEN 李嘉人

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangtung Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 28, 1977).

From 1958 until 1968 Li was a vice-governor of Kuangtung province. He was then purged as a capitalist roader.

LI CH'IAO-YÜN (f) 李巧云

Elected vice-chairman of the Peking Municipal Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Li is an alternate member of the 11th CCP Central Committee.

LI CH'ING-WEI 李庆伟

Elected vice-chairman of the Honan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 19, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Li was a vice-governor of Honan province. He has been a member of the Standing Committee of the Honan Provincial Party Committee since 1975.

LI LI-KUNG 李立功

Elected vice-chairman of the Peking Municipal Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Li was a member of the Communist Youth League between 1954 and the Cultural Revolution and first secretary of the Peking branch of the Communist Youth League between 1966 and his purge during the Cultural Revolution.

LI TAI-KENG 李代耕

Identified as vice-minister of water conservancy and electric power (NCNA Dec 17, 1977).

Li was an assistant minister in the same ministry between 1955 and 1961 when he became its vice-minister. He disappeared during the Cultural Revolution.

LIANG HSIANG 梁湘

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangtung Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 28, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Liang was secretary of the Canton CCP Committee. Reactivated in 1974, he has been 2nd secretary of the Canton Party Committee since 1977.

LIANG WEI-LIN 梁威林

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangtung Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 28, 1977).

Liang was director of the Hsinhua branch-office in Hong Kong from 1960 until December 1977.

LIAO SHENG-TUNG 廖生东

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangsi Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 24, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Liao was director of the Department for Finance and Commerce of the Kuangsi People's Government. He has been a member of the Standing Committee of the Kuangsi Party Committee since 1975.

LO CH'IU-YÜEH (f) 罗秋月

Elected vice-chairman of the Hunan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 3, 1977).

Lo has been chairman of Hunan's Women's Federation since 1973.

MA CH'UN-KU 马纯古

Identified as vice-chairman of the All China Trade Unions (NCNA Dec 21, 1977).

Ma held the same post from 1962 until the Cultural Revolution. Ma has also been a member of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress since 1965. This is the first time that the All China Trade Unions have been referred to after the Cultural Revolution.

MAO LIEN-CHÜEH 毛联珏

Elected vice-chairman of the Peking Municipal Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Mao has been deputy secretary-general of this Committee since 1975 and since August 1977, he has also been a member of the Standing Committee of the Peking Party Committee.

MENG HSIEN-TE 孟宪德

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangtung Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 28, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Meng was first Party secretary of the Chankiang district of Kuangtung province.

NI JUI-CHOU 牛瑞驹

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 15, 1977).

One month before his new appointment Niu had been elected member of the Standing Committee of the Party Committee of the Tibet-Autonomous Region.

PAI HUA

Elected vice-chairman of the Tientsin Municipal Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Pai was a vice-director of the Propaganda Department of the Tientsin Party Committee.

RAGDE 热地

Elected vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee. (NCNA Dec 15, 1977).

Ragde is an alternate member of the 11th CCP Central Committee and also secretary of the Party Committee and chairman of the Peasants' Association of the Tibet Autonomous Region.

SHIH PANG-CHIH 石邦智

Elected vice-chairman of the Hunan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 3, 1977).

Shih, who belongs to the Miao national minority, had been chairman of the West Hunan Autonomous Chou of the Miao and Tuchia before the Cultural Revolution.

SU CHEN-HUA 苏振华

Identified as first political commissar of the PLA Navy (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

SUN KUO-CHIH 孙国治

Elected vice-chairman of the Hunan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 3, 1977).

Sun, a Hunan cadre since the fifties, was made secretary of the Hunan Provincial Party Committee in May 1977.

SUNG JEN-CH'UANG 宋任穷

Identified as vice-chairman of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (NCNA Dec 26, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Sung was among the most prominent cadres of the CCP, with membership to the 8th Central Committee and the post of first secretary of the North-east Bureau of the Central Committee.

TS'AI FENG-LAN (f) 蔡凤兰

Elected vice-chairman of the Chinghai Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 30, 1977).

Ts'ai, a model worker of the Chinghai Heavy Machine Tools Plant, was elected an alternate member of the 11th CCP Central Committee in August 1977.

TSENG T'AO 曾涛

Identified as director of the Hsinhua News Agency (NCNA Dec 7, 1977).

Tseng comes from the diplomatic service, his appointments including the post of an ambassador to Algeria (1962-1967), to Yugoslavia (1970-1973), and France (1973-February 1977). In April 1977 he was made vice-director of the Hsinhua News Agency whose director he has now become.

TS'UI CH'UN 崔君祥

Identified as vice-minister of foreign trade (NCNA Dec 28, 1977).

Between 1960 and 1963 Ts'ui was China's economic representative in North Vietnam and director of the China Technical Import Corporation in autumn 1963. In this capacity he was China's chief agent in negotiations with a group of petroleum experts from the Federal Republic of Germany in July 1974.

TU YI

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangsi Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 24, 1977).

Tu has also been secretary of the Kuangsi Party Committee since 1974.

T'UNG KUO-KUEI 童国贵

Elected vice-chairman of the Hunan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 3, 1977).

Until 1975 T'ung was commander of the Shantung Military District and was then transferred to the Hunan Military District whose commander he still is.

WANG CHAN-YING 王占瀛

Elected vice-chairman of the Tientsin Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Before his recent election Wang was already a member of the Standing Committee of Tientsin's Revolutionary Committee.

WANG CHAO-WEN 王朝文

Elected vice-chairman of the Kueichou Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 9, 1977).

Wang, who belongs to the Miao national minority, has been secretary of the Kueichou Communist Youth League since 1973.

WANG CH'UN 王纯

Elected vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution was vice-mayor of Peking (1960-1967). He was only reactivated now.

WANG CHUNG-NIEN 王中年

Elected vice-chairman of the Tientsin Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Before his recent election Wang had already been deputy secretary-general of the same committee.

WANG HSIAO-YI 王采一

Elected vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Before his recent election Wang had already been deputy secretary-general of the same committee.

WANG NING 王宁

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangtung Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 28, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Wang had been head of the Kuangtung Public Security Office. In December 1977, he was also elected a member of the Kuangtung Party Committee's Standing Committee.

WANG TA-JEN 王大任

Elected vice-chairman of the Shansi Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 27, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Wang was secretary of the Shansi Provincial Party Committee, and in 1975 he was reinstated in that position.

WU SHIH 吴实

Elected vice-chairman of the Kueichou Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 9, 1977).

Between 1960 and the Cultural Revolution Wu had been vice-governor of Kueichou province. He was only reactivated now.

YANG K'ANG-HUA 杨康华

Elected vice-chairman of the Kuangtung Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 28, 1977).

From 1961 until the Cultural Revolution Yang had been vice-governor of Kuangtung province and from 1964 until the Cultural Revolution, president of Chinan University.

YANG YI-CH'EN 杨易辰

Identified as first secretary of the Heilungkiang Provincial Party Committee and chairman of the Heilungkiang Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Harbin Radio, Dec 14, 1977).

Yang was elected a member of the CCP Central Committee by the 11th Congress. He had been Party secretary and vice-chairman of the revolutionary committee in Heilungkiang province before. In his new posts he has succeeded Liu Kuang-t'ao, who had been mentioned on these posts one week before Yang's appointment.

YEH LIN 叶林

Elected vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Yeh was vice-chairman of the State Economic Commission and director of the Supervisory Board of the Federation of Handicraft Industry Corp. He was only reactivated now.

YEN TA-K'AI 闫达闲

Elected vice-chairman of the Tientsin Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 14, 1977); identified as secretary of the Tientsin Party Committee (Tientsin Radio, Dec 9, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Yen had been secretary of the Hepei Provincial Party Committee (1956-1967). In autumn 1967 he was ordered to Tientsin to become 2nd Party secretary of that municipality.

YIN TZU-MING

Elected vice-chairman of the Hunan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 3, 1977).

Since September 1977 Yin has also been a member of the Hunan Provincial Party Committee's Standing Committee.

YÜEH TSUNG-T'AI 岳宗泰

Elected vice-chairman of the Hepei Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Dec 13, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution he had been vice-governor of Shansi province (1960-1961) and worked in the Department of Industry and Communications under the North China Bureau of the CCP Central Committee.
