Agreements with Foreign Countries

October 1979

- Oct 4 FRANCE Protocol of the agreement on cooperation in the field of telecommunications (1)
 USA Agreement between the China International Trust and Investment Corporation and the Eaton-Shen Pacific Corporation on an annual investment of 50 million US dollars for three consecutive years on joint ventures in China (2)
- 8 NETHERLANDS "Declaration of Intent" on the development of agricultural cooperation. The declaration points out that opportunities for mutual agricultural cooperation might exist in the sectors of animal husbandry, horticulture, manufacturing and processing of animal feed, processing of agricultural products, land development, land reclamation, and water management. The two sides have agreed to establish a Joint China-Netherlands Agricultural Working Group and to organize further visits of delegations (3).
- 10 IRAQ Agreement on information cooperation between the Xinhua News Agency and the Iraqi News Agency (4).
- 17 FRANCE Three documents on
(a) development of economic relations
(b) opening of consular posts; (this document covers the probable opening of diplomatic missions in Shanghai and Marseilles)
(c) cultural exchange. This document covers 1980 and 1981, and is devoted in particular to the opening of a French-language department at Wuhan University, work on which will start next year. French teaching staff specialising in mathematics, space physics, computer technology and management methods would be sent to Wuhan. China agreed to introduce the teaching of French by television and increase the number of French teachers in China by next year to 30. France would increase the number of Chinese trainees and students in the country to 200 a year in 1980 and 1981. On the artistic side, a French company will go to China to film Andre Malraux' novel "La Condition Humaine" which is set in Shanghai in the 1920s. The Peking opera will visit Paris as will a Chinese theatre company. Finally, France and China will stage film weeks in their respective countries, there will be a week-long French special on Chinese television, an exhibition of 10,000 French books in many major Chinese cities and exchange of television programmes. - CANADA (a) Notes on the renewal of the trade agreement (originally signed in October 1973)
(b) Protocol on economic cooperation. This protocol provides for the encouragement of arrangements such as joint ventures, compensatory trade and co-production and co-marketing, for the encouragement and facilitation of financial arrangements and the facilitation of the establishment of trade offices by each party in the territory of the other (6)

- Oct 22 NORTH KOREA Protocol of the 19th session of the Committee for Scientific and Technical Cooperation (7)
- 24 GERMANY, Fed.R. (a) Agreement on economic cooperation. The agreement stipulates that, on the basis of equality and mutual benefit the two sides should do their best to provide favourable conditions in the financial facilities
(b) Agreement on cultural cooperation. This agreement includes activities in the fields of the sciences, education, the arts, sports, news, broadcasting, films, television, language training and publication of books, as well as among youth and other social organizations
(c) Agreement on the establishment of consulate-generals in Hamburg and Shanghai (8)
- 26 FINLAND Trade agreement (9)
- 29 GERMANY, Fed.R. Agreement on weights and measures between the Chinese State Bureau of Weights and Measures and the FR Germany's Ministry of Economy (10)
- GAMBIA Protocol on the dispatch of a Chinese medical team (10)
- USA Protocol between the China International Trust and Investment Corporation and (a) the First National Bank of Chicago. The joint efforts of CITIC and FNBC will be applied to foster and encourage commercial and industrial cooperation between the Chinese corporations and companies around the world. Under the agreement, FNBC will identify companies in the US and around the world and select a number of companies for solicitation of their interest in pursuing discussions leading to negotiations for their investment in joint projects with Chinese corporations in China. FNBC will, on a select basis, act in its capacity as a leading commercial and financial institution to undertake to arrange and provide the financial requirements of certain projects. It shall assist CITIC in identifying investment opportunities outside China and on request will provide financial management services to CITIC in the US and around the world.(10).

BAO HOUCANG 包厚昌

Identified as secretary of the Jiangsu Provincial CP Committee (Nanjing Radio Oct 10, 1979).

Bao had been on the same post before the Cultural Revolution. Besides He also held the post of vice-governor of Jiangsu Province.

CHEN XILIAN 陈锡联

Identified as 1st secretary of the Party Committee, Beijing Military Region (XNA Oct 5, 1979).

Chen, a member of the CCP Politburo, has held the post of commander of the Beijing Military Region since January 1974.

FANG Q. ANG 方强

Identified as deputy commander of the PLA Navy (XNA Oct 8, 1979).

Fang, a vice-admiral, had been minister of the 6th Ministry of Machine Building before the Cultural Revolution. Re-activated in 1972 he had been referred to as a cadre of the State Council since 1973.

GUO CHAO 郭超

Identified as CP secretary and vice-chairman of the Revolutionary Committee of Fujian Province (Fuzhou Radio Oct 23, 1979).

A leading military in Beijing between 1970 and 1971, Guo had been deputy secretary of the Fujian Provincial CP Committee since 1973.

HAN FUDONG 韩复东

Identified as deputy director of the Military Training Department under the PLA General Staff and as vice-chairman of the Sports Federation (XNA Sep 29, 1979).

Han is a PLA major-general. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been one of the leading cadres in sports affairs. Re-activated in 1974 he was reinstated in his former position.

HE CHENGHUA 何承华

Identified vice-chairman of the Shaanxi Provincial Revolutionary Committee and as a member of the Standing Committee of the Shaanxi CP Committee (Xi'an Radio Oct 11, 1979).

In 1960 He had been secretary of the Gansu Provincial CP Committee. He was not reactivated until now.

HE ZHIHUA 贺志华

Identified as a vice-minister of light industry (XNA Sep 30, 1979).

He led an experts group to Algeria to stay there from October 1963 until January 1964. He was reactivated only now.

HOU DEYUAN

Identified as vice-minister of posts and telecommunications (XNA Sep 30, 1979).

Hou had been a deputy for Henan Province to the 2nd and 3rd National People's Congresses, and was not reactivated until now.

LI JING 黎靖

Identified as vice-minister of petroleum industry and as director of the Xinjiang Petroleum Administrative Bureau (XNA Oct 15, 1979).

In the sixties Li had been vice-director of the Zhangchun Institute of Geology. Purged in 1966 he was only reactivated now.

LI LINCHUAN

Identified as vice-minister of posts and telecommunications (XNA Sep 27, 1979).

In 1973 Li was identified as director of the Department for Telecommunications under that ministry.

LI SHUIQING 李水清

Identified as vice-minister of communications (XNA Oct 27, 1979).

Li has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since

1969. Between 1971 and 1975 he was minister of the 1st Ministry of Machine Building, then to become deputy commander of the Nanjing Military Region (until about 1977).

LIU ZHUOFU 刘卓甫

Identified as director of the State Bureau of Commodity Prices (XNA Oct 31, 1979).

Until 1961 Liu had been secretary of the Yunnan Provincial CP Committee and vice-governor of Yunnan Province before he became deputy director of the State Price Commission in 1963. He disappeared in October 1963 and was reactivated in February 1978 when he was elected deputy for Hebei Province to the 5th National People's Congress.

LÜ JIANREN 吕剑人

Identified as CP secretary and vice-chairman of the Revolutionary Committee of Shaanxi Province.

Between 1959 and the Cultural Revolution Lü had been a secretary of the Xinjiang Autonomous Regional CP Committee. Reactivated in December 1978 he was identified as a cadre of Shaanxi Province in August this year.

LÜ QING 吕清

Identified as vice-minister of state farms and land reclamation (XNA Oct 1, 1979).

In the fifties Lü had been political commissar of the Heilongjiang Military District.

QIN JIWEI 秦基伟

Identified as 2nd secretary of the Party Committee, Beijing Military Region (XNA Oct 5, 1979).

Qin, who is a member of the CCP 11th Central Committee, has been 1st political commissar of Beijing Military Region since November 1978.

WANG YILUN 王一伦

Identified as secretary of the Inner Mongolia Autonomous Regional CP Committee (Huhehot Radio Sep 27, 1979).

Wang had been a Heilongjiang cadre before. Prior to the Cultural Revolution he had been secretary of the CP Committee of that province. Reactivated in 1973, he held the same post until he was transferred to Inner Mongolia.

WU SHAOWEN 吴绍文

Identified as vice-minister of agricultural machinery (XNA Oct 8, 1979).

Wu was elected deputy for Sichuan Province to the 5th National People's Congress in February 1978. No other information about him is available.

YONG WENTAO 雍文涛

Identified as vice-minister of forestry (XNA Oct 2, 1979).

Yong had held the same post in the late fifties. Reactivated in 1972 he was a cadre in Guangdong Province until 1976, and was appointed vice-minister of education in 1977.

XIONG ZUOFANG 熊作芳

Identified as deputy commander of the Nanjing Military Region (Nanjing Radio Oct 16, 1979).

Xiong had been deputy commander of the Jinan Military Region before.

XUE ZISHENG 薛子正

Identified as vice-director of the United Front Work Department under the CCP Central Committee (XNA Oct 6, 1979).

Xue had held the same position before the Cultural Revolution, from 1959 until his purge in 1966.

ZHANG DANAN

Identified as deputy commander of the Nanjing Military Region (Nanjing Radio Oct 24, 1979).

Zhang had been known as a cadre of the Nanjing Military Region since 1973.

ZHAO YUTING 赵雨亭

Identified as secretary of the Shanxi Provincial CP Committee (Taiyuan Radio Oct 26, 1979).

Zhao had been a member of the Standing Committee of the Shanxi CP Committee before. Since October 1977 he has also held the post of a vice-chairman of the Shanxi Provincial Revolutionary Committee.

ZHAO ZENGYI 赵增益

Elected secretary of the Yunnan Provincial CP Committee (XNA Sep 28, 1979).

Zhao had been a deputy secretary before.

ZHOU CHUNLIN 周纯麟

Identified as deputy commander of the Nanjing Military Region (XNA Oct 10, 1979).

Zhou has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since 1973. Between 1970 and January 1977 he was commander of the Shanghai Garrison. He is the only member of the CCP Central Committee stationed in Shanghai who survived the purge of the "Gang of Four" faction in that city.

ZHOU JIANNAN 周迪南

Identified as vice-minister of the Commission for Regulating Foreign Investments (XNA Oct 8, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Zhou had been vice-minister of the 1st Ministry of Machine Building. He was reactivated on the same post in April 1978.

New Cadres

LIN YI 林毅

Identified as vice-minister of the 6th Ministry of Machine Building (XNA Oct 14, 1979).

ZHANG KERANG

Identified as vice-chairman of the Hebei Provincial Revolutionary Committee and as a member of the Standing Committee of the Hebei Provincial CP Committee (Shijiazhuang Radio Sep 21, 1979).

Deceased Cadres

MA LI 马力

Died September 25, 1979 (XNA Oct 8, 1979).

Ma had been a member of the 11th Central Committee of the CCP and 1st secretary of the Guizhou Provincial CP Committee.

YANG DONGCHUN 杨东纯

Died September 25, 1979 (XNA Oct 16, 1979).

Yang had been a member of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress since 1975.
