## Agreements with Foreign Countries

November 1979

- Nov 1 GREAT BRITAIN a) Agreement on civil air transport (1)  
b) Agreement on cooperation in the fields of education and culture. It includes direct contacts and exchanges between universities and other institutions of higher education and will facilitate visits and exchanges of university professors, lecturers, specialists and teachers for the purpose of exchanging ideas and experience and giving lectures and teaching. The two countries will also grant scholarships to each other's students, post-graduates and scholars and encourage and facilitate their visits on a self-paying basis for purposes of study and research. The agreements also provides for exchanges of visits of writers, composers, artists, film-makers, and other individuals engaged in creative and performing arts.(1).

b) Declaration of intent for cultural and scientific-technological cooperation (2)
- 7 ROMANIA Agreement on social sciences cooperation (3)
- 8 SYRIA Three-year (1979-1981) plan to implement a Sino-Syrian cultural cooperation treaty. It stipulates that the two countries will cooperate in the fields of education, culture and art, and journalism, including providing scholarships for each other's students, exchanges of journalists and delegations, as well as of materials and experiences.(4).
- 9 CANADA a) Exchange of notes on the renewal of the trade agreement (5)  
b) Protocol on economic cooperation (5)
- GERMANY, Fed. Rep. Agreement on cooperation in broadcasting and television (5)
- MALI Protocol on sending a new Chinese medical team to Mali (6)
- 11 JORDAN Agreement on cultural cooperation. Under it the two countries will carry out cooperation in the fields of culture, arts, education and health, exchange visits by writers, artists and other people engaged in academic activities. The agreement also provides that the two sides will work for the development of tourism between the two countries, promote cooperation between publishing houses, broadcasting and TV systems, and exchange visits of people engaged in these fields.(7)
- 12 ? BULGARIA Protocol on scientific and technical cooperation (8)
- 14 IRAN Memorandum relating to trade in 1980 (9)
- 15 GREECE Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation. It provides that the contracting parties will, on a reciprocal basis, exchange scientific and technological information and data; exchange scientific and technological delegations, scientists, technicians and visiting scholars for visits, study tours and advanced studies; and undertake joint research on projects of common interest; organize bilateral scientific and technological symposia and lectures (10).
- 17 BANGLADESH Agreement on cultural cooperation. It provides for exchanges and cooperation between the two countries in the fields of literature and art, education, science and technology, journalism, radio, television and film, as well as tourism and sports (11).

- Nov 20 GERMANY, Fed. Rep. Protocols on scientific cooperation:  
(a) cooperation in research on raw and semi-finished materials  
(b) joint investigation of energy resources  
(c) joint study of mining, ore dressing and smelting  
(d) joint prospecting of hydrocarbon in the western part of the East China Sea by using isotopic geochemical techniques  
(e) joint surveying of oil or gas reserves in China's Linyi Basin (12)
- NEPAL Protocol on the first joint inspection of the China-Nepal boundary. The two governments through mutual consultations, had formed a joint boundary inspection committee in May 1977, with a view to inspecting jointly the condition of the boundary markers and repairing and reconstructing damaged ones. The committee has also been entrusted with the task of preparing a correct map of the boundary. The committee had completed the above task in a very cordial and friendly atmosphere.(12).
- VENEZUELA Agreement to promote sports exchanges (12)
- 21 EGYPT Trade protocol for 1980 (13)
- TUNISIA Cultural exchange plan. The two countries will exchange students, professors, cultural and art troupes, exhibitions and film weeks (14).
- 23 BELGIUM-LUXEM-BOURG Econ.Union (a) Agreement on the development of economic, industrial, scientific and technical co-operation  
(b) Protocol on economic, industrial and technical cooperation  
(c) Protocol on scientific and technical cooperation (15). Cooperative projects covered by the newly-signed agreements and protocols include: two sets of 300,000 Kilowatt power plants to be imported by China from Belgium; instruments exchanged between the two sides for a 30-year agreement for the Belgian government to provide the Chinese government with interest-free loans. The agreement stipulates that a yearly loan from 1980 to 1982 will be 300 million Belgian Francs (10.3 million US dollars) which will be used to cover part of the cost of the power plants; Belgian banks will make a loan of 5,000 million Belgian francs (2,420 US dollars) to the Bank of China to be used to buy goods from Belgium.(16).
- 26 SRI LANKA Protocol on the exchange of commodities in 1980 (17)
- SYRIA Sports agreement. According to it, China will send table tennis, gymnastics and volleyball coaches to Syria to help train sportsmen and sportswomen. There will be an exchange of sports publications and visits between sports study delegations and sports teams of the two countries. They will also cooperate in international sports activities. (18).
- 29 GREAT BRITAIN Arrangement on railway scientific and technical cooperation (19)

## ADDENDUM OCTOBER 1979

- Oct 26 FINLAND Trade agreement. Under it Finland will continue to export to China chiefly forest and metal industry products. The most important import goods from China are soya-beans and various chemicals and medicines. The value of Chinese exports to Finland last year was 54,000,000 Finnish marks; Finnish exports to China exceeded this figure by some 100,000,000 Finnish marks. In 1980 trade between the two countries will grow by nearly 20 % amounting to a total of 320,000,000 Finnish marks (20).

November 1979

### CONGO, PR

The sixth Chinese medical team left the country and the seventh arrived (XNA Nov 26, 1979).

### MALI

China and Mali signed a protocol, on November 10, on sending a new Chinese medical team to Mali (XNA Nov 10, 1979).

### NIGER

In Tera a reservoir project is being built with Chinese aid. After completion it will bring water to the residents and animals in the district all the year round (XNA Nov 6, 1979).

### SIERRA LEONE

The construction of a China-aided sugar-cane farm has progressed according to schedule since it officially started in October 1977. This farm is the first of its kind in Sierra Leone. Its key project, a 30-metre pump with a diameter of 15 metres, has been completed and will be put into

operation shortly. Progress has also been made in opening up wasteland, experimental planting of canes and in the irrigation and road-building projects of the farm (XNA Nov 4, 1979).

### SYRIA

The Damascus sports complex, built with Chinese aid, was completed (XNA Nov 16, 1979).

### ZAIRE

The Lotokila sugar refinery, which is being built with Chinese aid, has an annual capacity of 15,000 tons and is situated 70 kilometres west of Kisangani. The project includes a 20-hectare sugar-cane plantation (XNA Nov 10, 1979).

Identified as vice-chairman of the Sichuan Provincial Revolutionary Committee (XNA Nov 15, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Meng had been vice-governor of Sichuan. He was reactivated in February 1978 when he was elected deputy for Sichuan Province to the 5th National People's Congress.

WANG FANGZI 王仿子

Identified as director of the Cultural Relics Publishing

House (XNA Nov 11, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Wang had been deputy director of the Office for Publishing Control under the Ministry of Culture. Wang was not reactivated until now.

XUE MUQIAO 薛暮桥

Identified as director of the State Statistical Bureau; elected president of the Statistical Society (XNA Nov 19, 1979).

Before the Cultural Revolution Xue had also been director of the State Statistical Bureau. In addition, he was vice-chairman of the State Economic Commission (1959-1961), vice-chairman of the State Planning Commission (1960-1965), and director of the State Price Committee (1963). Reactivated in 1975 he was identified as director of the Economics Institute under the State Planning Commission in March 1979.

Before the Cultural Revolution Yang had been in the position he has now been reactivated in.

Zhao was identified as director of the Organization Department of the Shanghai Municipal CP Committee in June 1978.
