BANGLADESH

An agreement on economic and technical cooperation was signed on March 21, 1978. Under this agreement, China will provide Bangladesh with about 800,000,000 taka as an interest-free loan. 680,000,000 will be used in setting up an urea fertilizer plant and a water conservancy project near Dacca. On completion the fertilizer plant will provide 180 tons of urea per day, while the water conservancy project will provide irrigation facilities for 4,500 acres of land (Dacca Radio Mar 21, 1978; cit. SWB 5770).

BURMA

Burma and China signed an accord on March 8, 1978, on the completion of the second stage of the Meiktila textile mill expansion project. The project started in June 1977 and was completed in February 1978. Equipped with 80,000 spindles and 600 looms, the mill went into operation on March 1, 1978 (NCNA Mar 9, 1978).

CONGO (Brazzaville)

The first power-generating unit of the Bouenza hydro-electric station in Moukouloulou, Bouenza Region, built with Chinese aid, went into operation on March 27, 1978 (NCNA Mar 28, 1978).

GAMBIA

Minutes of talks on the construction of four health centres were signed on March 25, 1978 (NCNA Mar 26, 1978).

GHANA

A Chinese technical team arrived on March 10 to assist in the construction of the Afife irrigation project (NCNA Mar 16, 1978).

LAOS

The construction of the Laos-China Friendship weaving factory in Oudomsay Province, to be built with Chinese aid, started on March 9, 1978 (NCNA Mar 14, 1978).

LIBERIA

A protocol on the Barreke sugar project to be built with Chinese assistance was signed on March 9, 1978 (NCNA Mar 11, 1978).

PAKISTAN

In Baluchistan, 10,000,000 tons of iron ore deposits with iron content ranging from 45 to 53% have been discovered in Chagai District. A feasibility report is being prepared and the possibilities of setting up a "mini" steel mill based on iron ore deposits in this district are being examined. The discovery follows three years of exploration carried out by Chinese and Pakistan experts (Karachi Radio, Mar 7, 1978; cit. SWB/W 972).

The shipment of machinery from China for the installation of a glass sheet factory near Naushehra has begun. The installation of the machinery will be completed by Chinese experts who will also train Pakistanis while in Pakistan (Karachi Radio, Mar 3, 1978; cit. SWB/W 971)

ROMANIA

With the aid of Chinese chemical workers a polycarbonate production unit has been built and put into operation at the Rimnicu-Vilcea combine (Agerpress Mar 20, 1978; cit. SWB/EE/W 974)

SYRIA

In Damascus a stadium is under construction with Chinese assistance (NCNA Feb 19, 1978).

TOGO

A ceremony was held in Lome on March 13, 1978, to hand over two rice-growing centres and to sign a protocol on the establishment of stations from which information concerning rice production and agricultural technology can be disseminated (NCNA Mar 14, 1978).

Personal Data

Known Cadres on New Posts

CHANG KEN-SHENG 张根生

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture and forestry (NCNA Mar 29, 1978).

Chang had been an alternate secretary of the Kuangtung Provincial Party Committee before the Cultural Revolution and was ousted, together with T'ao Chu, early in 1968. After his reappearance in 1972, Chang held posts in the Kuangtung CP and Revolutionary Committee. In addition he has been vice-director of the Canton Fair since 1974.

CHANG WEN-PIN 张文彬

Identified as vice-minister for the petroleum industry (NCNA Mar 4, 1978).

Chang had been vice-minister in the Ministry of Petroleum and Chemical Industries until that ministry was divided at the Fifth National People's Congress.

CHANG YÜN (f) 章蕴

Identified as vice-chairman of the Women's Federation (NCNA Mar 4, 1978).

Chang had been on the same post before the Cultural Revolution; she had also been an alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee. Purged in 1967, she was reactivated in 1975.

CH'EN MU-HUA (f) 陈慕华

Elected vice-premier (NCNA Mar 5, 1978).

Ch'en who is the only female member of the Political Bureau of the CCP Central Committee, also holds the post of minister for economic relations with foreign countries.

CH'EN YÜ 陈宇

Identified as vice-chairman of the All-China Trade Unions (NCNA Mar 6, 1978).

Ch'en had been a trade union cadre before the Cultural Revolution and also held posts in the World Federation of Trade Unions until the Chinese left that Moscow-controlled

organization.

CH'IAO SHIH 乔石

Identified as vice-director of the CCP Central Committee's Department for Foreign Relations (NCNA Mar 9, 1978).

Ch'iao who was not reactivated until now had been a secretary of the Afro-Asian Solidarity Committee before the Cultural Revolution.

CH' IEN SAN-CH' IANG 钱三强

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (NCNA Mar 7, 1978).

With an interruption during the Cultural Revolution, Ch'ien has been director of the Institute of Atomic Energy under the Academy of Sciences since 1958, and he is one of China's leading atomic energy specialists.

CHOU P'EI-YÜAN 周培源

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (NCNA Mar 7, 1978).

Chou is one of the leading Chinese physicists. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been vice-president of Peking University and has been vice-chairman of that university's revolutionary committee since. In addition he also holds the post of a vice-chairman of the Scientific and Technical Association.

CHOU SHIH-CHUNG 周世忠

Identified as deputy commander of the Wuhan Military Region (Wuhan Radio Mar 31, 1978).

Chou comes from the Fukien Military District and has been known to be a leading military cadre in the Wuhan Military Region since the autumn of 1976.

FANG YI 方毅

Elected vice-premier (NCNA Mar 4, 1978).

Fang has been a member of the Political Bureau of the CCP

Central Committee since 1977, vice-president of the Academy of Sciences since January 1977, and minister in charge of the State Scientific and Technical Commission since February 1978.

FU CH'UNG-PI 傅崇碧

Identified as commander of the Peking Garrison (NCNA Mar 1, 1978).

Fu held the same post between 1967 and 1968 when he was purged on the charge of being a bourgeois ambitionist and counterrevolutionary double-dealer. Reactivated in 1975, he was (and maybe still is) deputy commander of the Peking Military Region.

HAO CHIEN-HSIU (f) 郝建秀

Identified as vice-minister of textile industry (NCNA Mar 2, 1978).

Hao is a model-worker of the Tsingtao Cotton Works No.8. She has led Shantung province's Women's Federation since 1975, and has been a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee since August 1977.

HO K'ANG 何康

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture and forestry (NCNA Mar 7, 1978).

Ho who was reactivated very recently, used to be known as an expert on tropical plants before the Cultural Revolution.

HSÜ HSIANG-CH'EN 徐向前

Elected vice-premier and minister of national defence (NCNA Mar 5, 1978).

Hsü is one of the four PLA marshals still alive. Elected member of the Political Bureau of the CCP Central Committee in 1977 (a post he had already held in 1968/9), he is also a vice-chairman of the Military Council of the CCP Central Committee.

HU CH'IAO-MU 胡乔木

Appointed president of the Academy of Social Sciences (NCNA Mar 5, 1978).

Hu, who was elected member of the Standing Committee of the Fifth National People's Congress on March 5, too, had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and a vice-director of the Propaganda Department under that Central Committee. After his reactivation in 1974, he did not hold a 'visible' post until his present appointment.

HU K'E-SHIH 胡克实

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (NCNA Mar 7, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Hu had been a secretary of the Chinese Young Communists League. Having been purged during the Cultural Revolution, he was reactivated in 1973 and has been a member of the Standing Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference since that time.

HUA LO-KENG 华罗庚

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (NCNA Mar 7, 1978).

Hua is director of the Institute of Mathematics under the Academy of Sciences and vice-chancellor of the Peking Scientific and Technical University.

K'ANG SHIH-EN 康世恩

Elected vice-premier and minister in charge of the Economic Commission (NCNA Mar 5, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution K'ang had been a vice-minister of petroleum industry. In January 1975 he was appointed minister for petroleum and chemical industries. He was elected member of the 11th CCP Central Committee.

KENG PIAO 耿飏

Elected vice-premier (NCNA Mar 5, 1978);

Keng is director of the Department for Relations with Foreign Countries under the CCP Central Committee (since 1971), and became a member of the Political Bureau during the 11th Party Congress in August 1977.

LI CH'ANG 李昌

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (NCNA Mar 7, 1978).

Li had been an alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee and vice-chairman of the Commission of Cultural Relations with Foreign Countries before the Cultural Revolution. Purged in 1967, he was reactivated in 1974,

LIU CHEN 刘震

Identified as second secretary of the Sinkiang Party Committee (Urumchi Radio Mar 21, 1978).

Since September 1977 Liu had been third secretary of the same Committee, and became commander of the Sinkiang Military Region during the same month. In August 1977 he was elected member of the 11th CCP Central Committee.

T'AN YÜN-HO 谭云鹤

Identified as vice-minister of public health (NCNA Mar 3, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution T'an had been a deputy secretary-general of the Heilungkiang Party Committee.

TENG LI-CH'ÜN 邓力群

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Social Sciences (NCNA Feb 28, 1978).

Teng, who was reactivated in 1975, had been a deputy editor-in-chief of "Red Flag" (HCh).

TS'AO CH'UN-KENG 曹春耕

Identified as assistant minister of the Foreign Ministry (NCNA Mar 22, 1978).

Ts'ao was ambassador to Norway between 1972 and 1976 then to become head of the Foreign Ministry's General Office.

T'UNG TA-LIN 童大林

Identified as vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technical Commission (NCNA Mar 9, 1978).

T'ung had been a cadre of the CCP Central Committee before the Cultural Revolution and was reactivated in 1975.

T'UNG TI-CHOU 童第周

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (NCNA Mar 7, 1978).

T'ung is director of the Institute of Biology under the Academy of Sciences (since 1961). He has also been a member of the NPC Standing Committee since 1975.

WANG WEI-KANG 王维纲

Identified as vice-president of the Supreme People's Court (NCNA Mar 7, 1978).

Wang who had held the same post before he was purged in the Cultural Revolution, was reactivated in 1975.

WU CHUNG 吴忠

Identified as deputy commander of the Canton Military Region (Canton Radio Mar 3, 1978).

Wu was elected alternate member of the CCP Central Committee in 1969. Before his new appointment was announced he had been commander of the Peking Garrison.

WU HENG 武衡

Identified as vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technical Commission (NCNA Mar 12, 1978).

Before being purged during the Cultural Revolution Wu had held the same post. He was reactivated in 1973.

YEN CHI-TZ'U (Ny Tzu-zu) 严济慈

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Sciences (NCNA Mar 7, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution, Yen had held several posts, as e.g. that of director of the Department for Technical Sciences under the Academy of Sciences and that of a vice-president of the Peking Scientific and Technical University. He was made a member of the NPC Standing Committee in 1965, and still is a member of that Committee.

YÜ KUANG-YÜAN 于光远

Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Social Sciences (NCNA Feb 28, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Yü was head of the Science Section of the Propaganda Department of the CCP Central Committee and also a vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technical Commission, a position to which he was re-appointed in December 1977.

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture and forestry (NCNA Mar 26, 1978).

FANG WEI-CHUNG

Identified as vice-minister of the Planning Commission (NCNA Mar 28, 1978).

MULLER, HANS

Vice-director of the Peking Medical College's Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Mar 6, 1978).

This is the first time that a person of obviously German origin has been referred to as a cadre in a Chinese institution.

WANG WEI

Identified as vice-minister of public health (NCNA Mar 6, 1978).

died on March 7, 1978 (NCNA Mar 1, 1978).

Ts'ao was a vice-minister of light industry.
