China's Economic Aid

May 1978

ALBANIA

The Lushne Plastic Articles factory, built with Chinese aid, has been put into operation. It is the biggest of its kind in Albania and can produce more than 270 varieties of plastic products for use in daily life and in industrial and agricultural development (NCNA May 29, 1978).

BURMA

A technical group from China which will make a feasibility study on the construction of a 10,000-seat indoor stadium, arrived in Rangoon on May 8. The stadium is planned for the Kyaikkasan ground in Rangoon (Rangoon Radio May 8, 1978; cit. SWB/W 981).

EQUATORIAL GUINEA

A Chinese technical team is now working at Bicombo hydraulic power station (NCNA May 25, 1978).

KUWAIT

The first Chinese medical team was replaced by the second one (NCNA May 4, 1978).

LAOS

At Muong Sai in Oudomsay Province the Chinese-aided Laos-China Friendship Textile Factory is taking shape. Although starting only in March this year (NCNA Mar 14, 1978), 20% of the construction work has been completed by now. All the machinery and repair equipment to be installed is of modern design. Although the factory will contain twenty looms and require 150 kW of electric power, it will be run by only thirty workers, and production will rely on local raw material. It will produce shirts, trousers, and other clothes (Vientiane Radio May 14, 1978; cit. SWB/W 982).

MAURITANIA

Chinese agro-technicians are constructing the Belle Vue rice research station (NCNA May 19, 1978).

NIGERIA

A Chinese well-sinking team is working in the Lake Chad Basin, an important husbandry area of Nigeria. In the village of Dawo it completed the eleventh well (NCNA May 8, 1978).

SEYCHELLES

An agreement on economic and technical cooperation was signed on May 2, 1978.

SRI LANKA

The Minneriya cotton-spinning mill was inaugurated on May 18, 1978. Its construction started in April 1976. The mill is one of the largest of its kind in Sri Lanka. It has 25,000 spindles with an annual output of 1.6 million kilograms of yarn (NCNA May 19, 1978).

SUDAN

The inaugural ceremony of the second stage project, printing and dyeing sections, of the friendship textile mill in Hassaheisa, Gezira province, was held on May 28. The construction of the mill started in January 1974. The spinning and weaving sections of the mill were put into operation in May 1976. With the commissioning of the printing and dyeing sections, the entire mill is now completed. The mill, the first state-owned textile mill in Sudan, has 1,700 workers at present (NCNA May 29, 1978). It has an annual productive capacity of 14 million metres of cotton cloth. During the past two years, the mill has become famous throughout Sudan for its high-quality cotton yarn and cotton cloth. The Sudanese workers are at present working on a two-shift system (NCNA May 28, 1978).

TOGO

The first Chinese medical team was replaced by the second one (NCNA May 1978).

YEMEN, Arab Republic (North Yemen)

An eleven-member Chinese technical team arrived in Sanaa to help build a cotton-ginning and oil-pressing plant in Hodeida (NCNA May 10, 1978). One Chinese medical team was replaced by another one (NCNA May 15, 1978).

Personal Data

Known Cadres on New Posts

CHANG HUAI-CHUNG 张怀忠

Identified as vice-minister of the First Machine Industry Ministry (NCNA May 4, 1978).

Chang has been a government cadre since 1975.

CHANG SU 张苏

Appointed deputy chief procurator in the Supreme People's Procuratorate (NCNA May 25, 1978).

Chang, who was reactivated in February 1978 only, had been an alternate member of the 8th CCPC and vice-president of the Higher People's Court before the Cultural Revolution.

CH'EN MING-YI 陈明文

Identified as deputy commander of the Chentu Military Region (Chengtu Radio May 25, 1978).

Ch'en had been commander of the Tibet Military District between 1971 and 1975. He is a major-general in the PLA.

CHIAO SHAN-MIN 焦善民

Identified as vice-minister of textile industry (NCNA May 10, 1978).

Chiao had been a vice-minister of building materials before the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in 1972, he has been a vice-minister of light industry since.

CHIN KUEI-HSIEN (f) 金桂仙

Identified as vice-chairman of the Yunnan Revolutionary Committee (Kunming Radio May 7, 1978).

Chin who is a national of the Hui minority comes from the Red Guards Movement which commenced during the Cultural Revolution. She has been a member of the Yunnan Party Committee's Standing Committee and secretary of the Yunnan Communist Youth League since 1975.

CHOU KUANG-CH'UN 周光春

Identified as vice-chairman of the Kuangsi Revolutionary

Committee (Nanning Radio May 5, 1978).

This was the first reference to Chou's reactivation. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been chairman of the Economic Committee of the CCPC's Central-South Bureau.

FENG CHI-HSIN 冯纪新

Identified as secretary of the Kansu CP Committee (Lanchou Radio May 18, 1978).

Feng was elected vice-chairman of the Kansu Revolutionary Committee in December 1977. Before the Cultural Revolution he had held posts in Heilungkiang (1960-1964) and in Kiangsu (1964-1965).

FENG CHIH 冯至

Identified as director of the Academy of Sciences' Institute of Foreign Literature (Peking Rundschau May 16, 1978).

Feng, who was reactivated very recently (see above), had studied in Germany. He became renowned as a Chinese poet, and was made a member of the Philosophy and Science Institute of the Academy of Sciences in 1961, and a council member of the Writers' Association in 1966.

HSIUNG TSO-FANG 熊作芳

Identified as deputy commander of the Tsinan Military Region (Tsinan Radio May 13, 1978).

Hsiung was first mentioned to be a leading military person in that region in 1973.

HU MING 胡明

Identified as vice-minister of textile industry (NCNA May 10, 1978).

Hu, who was reactivated quite recently (see above), had been a vice-minister of food industry until 1959 when he disappeared.

HUNG HSÜEH-CHIH 洪学智

Identified as director of the General Office, National Defence Industry (NCNA May 4, 1978).

We do not know whether the "National Defence Industry" comes under the State Council, under the PLA or directly under the CCP Central Committee's Military Council.

Hung was reactivated in October 1977. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been a PLA colonel-general and an alternate member of the 8th CCP Central Committee. In March 1978 he was elected member of the 5th NPC's Standing Committee.

JEN CHIH-HENG 任之恒

Identified as vice-minister of coal industry (NCNA May 22, 1978).

Jen was referred to as a government cadre some weeks ago.

JEN P'U-CHAI 任朴斋

Identified as vice-minister of the Capital Construction Commission (NCNA May 4, 1978).

Jen is a well-known architect who had worked in the Ministry of Building before the Cultural Revolution, and was made vice-minister in that ministry in 1971 until the ministry was dissolved in 1975.

KAO HOU-LIANG 高厚良

Identified as political commissar of the PLA Air Force (NCNA May 28, 1978).

Kao, a major-general and alternate member of the CCPC since 1977, had been deputy political commissar of the PLA Air Force before.

K'UNG TS'UNG-CHOU 孔从周

Identified as deputy commander of the PLA Artillery (NCNA May 8, 1978).

K'ung was head of the PLA Artillery School before the Cultural Revolution. In 1971 he was first identified as a leading military of the PLA Artillery. The 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference elected him a member of its Standing Committee in March 1978.

LI CHAO CHI 李兆吉

Identified as vice-minister of the Fourth Machine-Building Ministry (NCNA May 4, 1978).

Li is an expert in electronics and president of the Communications Engineering Research Institute.

LI HUA-MIN 李华民

Identified as deputy commander of the Shenyang Military Region (NCNA May 2, 1978).

Li, a PLA major-general and alternate member of the CCP Central Committee since 1969 had been in the same position in the Wuhan Military Region until the autumn of 1977.

LI TENG-YING 李登瀛

Identified as secretary of the Kansu CP Committee (Lanchou Radio May 18, 1978).

Li was elected vice-chairman of the Shensi Revolutionary Committee in December 1977.

LI YU-CHIU 李友九 (?)

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture and forestry (NCNA May 21, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution had been secretary of the Kuangsi CP Committee (?).

LIN CHUNG 林中

Identified as assistant minister of foreign affairs (NCNA Aug 25, 1978).

Lin worked in the diplomatic service for more than a decade, his last post being that of ambassador to Mozambique (until January 1977).

LÜ K'E-PAI 吕克白

Identified as vice-minister of the Capital Construction Commission (NCNA May 13, 1978).

Lü was reactivated in April 1978. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been member of the State Planning Commission (since 1961) and vice-chairman of the Capital Construction Commission (since 1965).

PAI CHIEF-FU 白介夫

Identified as vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee (NCNA May 17, 1978).

In 1972 Pai was first identified as a council member of the Scientific and Technical Association.

SHEN YEN-PING 沈雁冰

Identified as chairman of the Writers' Association (NCNA May 27, 1978).

Shen, the most famous Chinese poet alive, had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution. Between 1949 and 1965 he was also minister of culture.

WU HSÜEH-CH' IEN (f) 吴学谦

Identified as vice-director of the CCP Central Committee's International Department (NCNA May 7, 1978).

Wu, who was not reactivated until February 1978, had held various posts in mass organizations before the Cultural Revolution.

WU SHENG-JUNG 伍生荣

Identified as secretary of the Chinghai CP Committee (Sining Radio May 12, 1978).

Wu is a deputy commander of the Lanchou Military Region (since 1975) and commander of the Chinghai Military District (since 1977).

New Cadres

WU YEH-SHAN 吴冶山

Identified as vice-minister of railways (NCNA May 4, 1978).

YU CHIEN-TING

Identified as vice-minister of light industry (NCNA May 25, 1978).

YU PING

Identified as deputy chief procurator, Supreme People's Procuratorate (NCNA May 25, 1978).

Deceased Cadres

CHANG CHIH-JANG 张志让

Died April 26, 1978 (NCNA May 6, 1978).

Chang had been vice-president of the Supreme People's Court before the Cultural Revolution and was made a member of the 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference in March 1978.

CHANG LIEN-K'UEI 张连奎

Died April 22, 1978 (NCNA May 4, 1978).

Chang had held several government posts before the Cultural Revolution, the most important one being that of minister of the Third Machine Building Ministry (1960-1963). Reactivated in February 1978, he was elected a member of the Standing Committee of the 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference one month later.

OUYANG CH'IN 欧阳钦

Died May 15, 1978 (NCNA May 20, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Ouyang had been a member of the 8th CCP Central Committee (first elected in 1956) and first secretary of the Heilungkiang CP Committee (from 1956 until his purge in 1966). Reactivated in 1975, Ouyang was elected of the 5th National People's Congress Standing Committee and vice-president of the 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference in March 1978.

P'AN CHEN-YA 潘震亚

Died May 22, 1978 (Nanchang Radio May 24, 1978).

Having been a vice-governor of Kiangsi province before the Cultural Revolution, P'an was reactivated and elected a member of the 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference in March 1978.

PI CHOU CHE (P'I SHUH-SHIH) 皮漱石

Before the Cultural Revolution, when he was purged, P'i had been chairman of the Chinese Patriotic Catholic Association and archbishop of the Shenyang Diocese.

CHANGES IN THE DIPLOMATIC SERVICE

CH'AI TSE-MIN 柴泽民

Appointed chief of the Liaison Office of the PR China in the USA (May 20, 1978).

Before his present appointment, Ch'ai had been ambassador to four countries, viz. Hungary May 1961 until July 1964, Guinea August 1964 until 1967, Egypt June 1970 until Sept 1974, and Thailand January 1976 until May 1978.

CHAO YUAN 赵源

Appointed ambassador to Mauritania (NCNA May 16, 1978).

Former appointments:

1973-1975 vice-director of the Foreign Ministry's Department for African Affairs

June 1975- embassy counsellor in Mozambique

CH'ENG WEI-CHIH 郑为之

Appointed ambassador to Venezuela (NCNA May 2, 1978).

Aug 1961-1964 director, Foreign Ministry's Department for America and Australia (disappeared in 1964)

Sep 1972-Oct 1977 ambassador to Argentina

K'ANG MAO-CHAO 康矛召

Appointed ambassador to Belgium (NCNA May 4, 1978)
