## China's Economic Aid

### CAMEROON

Minutes of talks on a high-voltage transmission and transformation project for the Lagdo hydroelectric station to be built with Chinese assistance were signed on June 21 (NCNA June 22, 1978).

### CENTRAL AFRICAN EMPIRE

The first Chinese medical team arrived in Bangui on June 21 (NCNA June 23, 1978).

### LIBERIA

An agreement on economic and technical cooperation was signed on June 28, 1978 (NCNA June 28, 1978).

### MADAGASCAR

Chinese technicians helped to improve a bamboo workshop (NCNA June 26, 1978).

### NEPAL

A Chinese industrial survey team arrived in Nepal to start a feasibility survey of ceramics, paper pulp and sugar industries (Kathmandu Radio June 14, 1978; cited SWB 5841).

### PAKISTAN

The Karakoram highway which was built with Chinese assistance and has a total length of 500 miles, was inaugurated on June 18, with the Chinese Vice-Premier Keng Piao and the Pakistani Chief Martial Law Administrator, General Ziaul Haq, attending.

The section of the Karakoram highway within Pakistan, totalling 616 km, starts from the Sino-Pakistan border area at Khunjerab Pass in the North. It runs southward through the Karakoram and Himalaya mountains and along the Hunza, Gilgit and Indian rivers, and passes by Gilgit to Thakot, 200 km North-West of Islamabad. Some sections of the highway coincide with parts of the famous "Silk Road". In the area between Gilgit and Skardu, there are 100 peaks of over 5,500m in height and between these lie numerous valleys with torrential rivers and with many villages dotted along their banks. This area is abundant in ... minerals and precious stones, including mica, diamond, and gold. It is also rich in hydraulic resources ...

Strong and frequent movements of the (earth's) crust have resulted in topographical complexity and serious erosion of the rocks which inevitably brought unimaginable obstacles

and difficulties to the building of the highway. The glacier avalanche near Halleh-Gush caused a major landslide in 1974, dumping 5,000,000 cu.m. of earth into the Hunza river. The strong earthquake in Pattan at the end of the same year triggered landslides and suspended traffic along 200 km of one road there. The landslide in Yal in 1976 brought down 60,000 cubic metres of earth at one fell swoop. During the building of the highway, 800,000 cu.m. of earth and rock caused by landslides had to be removed in the section between Halleh-Gush and Thakot alone.

Thakot, the terminal of the Karakoram highway, is 208km away from the capital of Islamabad. The Thakot bridge across the Indus is at the southernmost end of the highway.

### RWANDA

An agreement on economic and technical cooperation was signed on June 10 (NCNA June 10, 1978).

### SUDAN

A Chinese survey team for the construction of a factory for ready-made clothing started work (NCNA June 7, 1978).

### TOGO

Minutes of talks on the Anie sugar complex to be built with Chinese assistance were signed on June 7 (NCNA June 8, 1978).

### YEMEN, PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC (South Y.)

After the inauguration of the Aden-Mukalla highway, another one linking Mukalla in the Fifth Province and the Hadramawt Valley is now under construction. The total length of the highway will be 325 km. When completed, the highway network will link the agricultural area of the Hadramawt Valley and the cotton and cereal producing provinces (third and fifth) with the capital (NCNA June 22, 1978).

### VIETNAM

A large-sized oil bunker, the A 320 Project, was recently completed with Chinese aid. It was started in February 1974 (NCNA June 28, 1978).

The Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs on June 9 issued a statement bringing out in the open the unilateral decision "to cancel part of its complete-factory aid projects to Vietnam" (VNA June 17, 1978; cit. SWB 5842).

## Personal Data

### Known Cadres on New Posts

CHANG HAI-FENG 张海峰

Identified as vice-minister of foreign affairs (NCNA June 6, 1978).

Chang is a cadre of long standing in the diplomatic service. Before his present appointment, he was ambassador to the German Democratic Republic, Romania and Yugoslavia.

CH'ENG SHIH-TS'AI 程世才

Identified as deputy commander of the PLA Armoured Forces (NCNA June 6, 1978).

Ch'eng, a lieutenant-general, had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution. He was reactivated in 1974 and elected member of the 5th National People's Congress in March 1978.

CHIANG MING 江明

Identified as vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technological Commission (NCNA June 27, 1978).

The present appointment marks Chiang's reactivation. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been vice-minister of foreign trade especially engaged in trade with Eastern Europe.

CHOU P'EI-YÜAN 周培源

Identified as president of Peking University (NCNA June 5, 1978).

Chou, a vice-president of this university before the Cultural Revolution, is one of the most famous Chinese scientists alive.

FAN TZU-YÜ 范子瑜

Identified as vice-director, PLA Logistics Department (NCNA June 26, 1978).

Fan, a major-general, had held military posts before the Cultural Revolution and was minister of commerce between December 1972 and September 1977 when he disappeared.

HAN PEI-HSIN 韩培信

Identified as vice-minister of light industry (NCNA June 3, 1978).

Han had been a vice-chairman of the Kiangsu Revolutionary

Committee before.

HO YI-HSIANG 何以祥

Identified as commander of the Shanghai Garrison (NCNA June 9, 1978).

This appointment marks Ho's reactivation. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been deputy commander of the Chekiang Military District, with the rank of major-general. - Chou Ch'un-lin, who had preceded Ho as commander of the Shanghai Garrison, does not seem to have been purged, as he was mentioned in connection with the memorial meeting for Ts'ao Ti-ch'iu on June 24.

HOU HSIANG-LIN

Identified as vice-minister of oil industry (NCNA June 10, 1978).

In March 1978 Hou, then a newcomer, was made a member of the 5th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference's Standing Committee.

HU CHAO-HENG 胡昭衡

Identified as vice-chairman of the Tientsin Municipal Revolutionary Committee (NENA June 24, 1978).

Hu, formerly mayor of Tientsin, had been elected to the above post in 1968, when the Tientsin Revolutionary Committee was founded. He disappeared soon afterwards.

HUANG HU 黄斗

Identified as vice-president of the Academy of Medical Sciences (NCNA June 11, 1978).

Huang had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution and was not reactivated until now.

JAO PIN 武饶

Identified as vice-minister of the First Ministry of Machine-Building (NCNA Jun 2, 1978).

Jao had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution, in 1960-1961, when he was appointed vice-chairman of the State Economic Commission.

LI CHENG

Li Cheng was identified as vice-chairman of the Liaoning Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA June 9, 1978).

In 1958 Li was found to hold the post of director of the Capital Construction Department of the Liaoning CP Committee.

LI FENG-P'ING 李丰平

Elected secretary of the Chekiang CP Committee (Hangzhou Radio June 13, 1978).

Li had held the same post, and that of a vice-governor of Chekaing province as well, before the Cultural Revolution. His present election marks his reactivation.

LI JEN-LIN 李人林

Identified as vice-minister of the State Capital Construction Commission (NCNA June 11, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Li had been vice-director of the Political Department in the Communications Department of the CCP Central Committee. Reactivated in 1974, he was identified as director of the Capital Construction Engineer Corps in July 1977.

LI KUANG 黎光

Identified as vice-minister of railways (NCNA June 10, 1978).

Li's present appointment marks his reactivation. Before the Cultural Revolution he had been vice-director of the Political Department of the Ministry of Railways.

LIN HU-CHIA 林乎加

Identified as first secretary of the Tientsin Municipal CP Committee and chairman of the Tientsin Revolutionary Committee (Tientsin Radio, June 12, 1978).

Lin, a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee and secretary of the Shanghai CP Committee before his present appointments, is the successor of Hsieh Hsüeh-kung who was purged on the charge of mishandling the anti-Gang campaign.

LIN YI-HSIN 林一心

Identified as vice-chairman of the Fukien Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA June 6, 1978).

Lin has been secretary of the Fukien CP Committee since 1975 and had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution after which he was reactivated in 1972.

LIU FA-HSIU

Identified as deputy commander of the Sinkiang Military Region (Urumchi Radio June 4, 1978).

Lin had been known as a leading military cadre in this military region since March 1977.

LIU HSI-KENG

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture and forestry (NCNA June 12, 1978).

Liu was elected vice-chairman of the Kiangsu Revolutionary

Committee in January 1978 - then a newcomer.

LU CHIN-TUNG 路全栋

Identified as vice-minister of the Physical Culture and Sports Commission (NCNA June 20, 1978).

Lu had been a youth cadre before the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in 1973, he has been a cadre of the Physical Culture and Sports Commission since 1975.

SU PU-CH'ING 苏步青

Identified as president of the Fudan University (NCNA June 7, 1978).

Su was vice-president of this university before the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in February 1978, he was elected member of the 5th NPC's Standing Committee in March.

SUN HSIAN-FENG 孙晓

Identified as vice-minister of oil industry (NCNA June 5, 1978).

Sun had been a vice-minister of the Ministry of Oil and Chemical Industries until this ministry was divided up at the 5th National People's Congress meeting in March 1978.

SUNG CH'ENG-CHIH 宋承志

Identified as commander of the PLA Artillery Corps (NCNA June 6, 1978).

Sung is a PLA major-general and had held the post of deputy commander of the PLA Artillery Corps since 1970.

T'AO TAO (f) 陶涛

Identified as vice-minister of chemical industry (NCNA June 1, 1978).

T'ao had been a vice-minister in the Ministry of Oil and Chemical Industries from 1975 until March 1978 when the ministry was divided up.

WANG SHU 王殊

Identified as vice-minister of foreign affairs (NCNA June 8, 1978).

Wang, a Hsinhua correspondent before the Cultural Revolution, was ambassador to the Federal Republic of Germany between 1974 and 1976, to become editor-in-chief of the Chinese monthly "Red Flag" (HCh) in April 1978.

WANG TE-JUN 王德润

Identified as deputy commander of the PLA Artillery Corps (NCNA June 15, 1978).

Before his present appointment Wang had been a deputy commander of the Lanchow Military Region.

YANG SHIH-FA 杨士法

Identified as vice-chairman of the Shanghai Revolutionary Committee (NCNA June 20, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Yang had been a member



of the Standing Committee of the Shanghai CP Committee and director of that body's Industry Work Department. His present appointment marks his reactivation.

**YANG WEI-P'ING 杨蔚屏**

Identified as secretary of the Anhui Provincial CP Committee (Hofei Radio June 9, 1978).

Yang, a Party secretary of Honan province between 1959 and 1966, was reactivated in January 1978 when he was made vice-chairman of the Anhui Revolutionary Committee.

**YANG YEH-P'ENG 杨叶澎**

Identified as vice-minister of chemical industry (NCNA June 7, 1978).

Yang had held the same post in 1966 and was not reactivated until now.

**YANG YI-PANG 杨义邦**

Identified as vice-minister of chemical industry (NCNA June 7, 1978).

Yang had been a vice-minister of the Ministry of Oil and Chemical Industries between 1976 and March 1978 when the ministry was divided up.
