ARTICLES IN THE CHINESE PRESS AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION

APRIL 1977

In view of the fact that the conflict between Peking and Moscow is an essential component of world politics, the editors of CHINA aktuell have decided to publish monthly lists of polemical press and radio items against the Soviet Union, the first of these lists having already been included in the February 1977 number. Roughly fifty per cent. of the items are commentaries from the Chinese press, the rest, citations from articles of foreign press organs. These polemical articles may be regarded as a barometer of Sino-Soviet relations.

## China's Economic Aid

APRIL 1977

### ALGERIA

The sixth group of the Chinese medical team left for home after two years of service. The seventh group arrived in April (NCNA April 25, 1977).

### BIRMA

With the completion in April 1977 - after 10 years' work - of the first phase of the expansion project Merktila textile mill is now able to produce more piece goods and cotton yarn (NCNA April 29, 1977). The Merktila cotton-spinning mill was completed in 1967. It has 600 looms and 40.000 spindles.

### ETHIOPIA

Construction is under way of the Woreta-Waldiya road since May, 1975. Many Ethiopians have been trained into skilled workers since (NCNA April 7, 1977).

### GUINEA

A fishing project built with Chinese aid was handed over in Port Conakry on April 15, 1977. The project includes six 300-ton fishing craft (four of them had already been handed over), a floating dock for repairing the six fishing craft, a cold storage with an ice making workshop, an ice depot and a repair shop (NCNA April 16, 1977).

### LAOS

Twenty-six students have recently completed their studies at the Lao-Chinese motor repair shop in Oudomsai Province. The school was established with the help of the PRC (KPL April 26, 1977, cit. SWB 5499).

### MADAGASCAR

Members of the Chinese medical team which arrived in Madagascar in 1975 are working in the Mahitsy Hospital near Tananarive (NCNA April 6, 1977).

### MALTA

A spinning and weaving mill built with Chinese assistance was inaugurated on April 3, 1977. The construction of the project had been started in April 1975 (NCNA April 4, 1977). A dry dock and a wharf are now under construction with Chinese help (NCNA April 25, 1977).

### MAURITANIA

A new protocol on sending a medical team to Mauritania was signed in Nouakchott on 4th April, 1977 (NCNA April 4, 1977).

### NEPAL

The Kathmandu ring road handed over in March 1977 (C.a. 77/4) links an industrial district in north-western Kathmandu with another one in the south-east. The 128m bridge with a width of 15m across the Bagmati river, the longest bridge in the Kathmandu valley, was built in less than one year (NCNA April 4, 1977).

### SOMALIA

The Mogadishu Cigarette and Match Factory, set up in 1974 with Chinese aid showed an increase of 6,000 boxes over the previous year (each box contains 10,000 cigarettes). The factory now meets 70 per cent of the home demand for cigarettes. It has over 300 employees. Its profit turn-over to the state totalled 30 million Somali shillings in 1976 (NCNA April 26, 1977).

### TANZANIA

Since its establishment in 1971 the Mabibo Vaccine Institute, built with Chinese aid, is now able to produce heat-resistant powder vaccines against small pox and tuberculosis. It has 19 technicians and 53 skilled workers (NCNA April 2, 1977).

An agro-technical popularization centre is under way in Biha-wana in Dodoma region with Chinese assistance. The construction started in 1973. It has cultivated 16 hectares of experiment fields and run 15 training courses including farming technique and small farm tools (NCNA April 16, 1977).

### TUNISIA

Members of the Chinese medical team are working at Mahdia Hospital (NCNA April 27, 1977).

## Personal Data

### Known Cadres on New Posts

CHANG T'ING-FA 张廷发

Identified as commander of PLA airforce (NCNA April 22, 1977). Chang is a general-major and had been a deputy commander of the airforce since 1964. He was purged during the Cultural Revolution and reactivated only in 1973. - The former airforce commander, Ma Ning 马宁 was not heard since September 1976. Some unreliable sources have it he died in an accident.

CHENG YI-SHAN 郑义山

Identified as vice-minister of foreign trade (NCNA April 16, 1977). Chang is a cadre of the state council since 1970 and was with the Chinese delegation to the UNCTAD Conference in Geneva in 1974.

CHIA SHIH 贾石

Identified as vice-minister of foreign trade (NCNA April 15, 1977). He had been appointed to the same post in 1964 but disappeared in 1969 to reappear only in 1975.

HSÜ YÜ-CH'ING 许或青

Identified as secretary of the Fukien CP (Fuchou-Radio April 11, 1977). Hsü was member of that CP's standing committee since 1973 and also holds the post of director of that CP's Unity Front Department.

HU CHI-WEI 胡绩伟

Identified as editor-in-chief of Jen-min jih-pao (NCNA April 28, 1977). Hu had been deputy editor-in-chief of this paper from 1958 until Cultural Revolution when he was purged to be reactivated only in January, 1976.

LI CHUANG 李庄

Identified as deputy editor-in-chief of Jen-min jih-pao (NCNA April 18, 1977). Li belonged to this paper before Cultural Revolution as member of the editorial and the internal departments.

LIU CHUNG-KUEI 刘重桂

Identified as second secretary of the Kuangsi CP (Nanning Radio, April 12, 1977). Liu has been a secretary since 1974 and is vice-chairman of the Kuangsi Revolutionary Committee since 1970.

LU TA-TUNG 鲁大东

Identified as secretary of the Szechuan CP (Chengtu Radio April 6, 1977).

Lu, an alternate member of CCPCC since 1969, has been a member of Szechuan CP's Standing Committee since 1972. He also holds the posts of first party secretary and chairman of the revolutionary committee of Chungking.

P'AN FEI 潘非

Identified as deputy editor-in-chief of Jen-min jih-pao (NCNA April 28, 1977). P'an had been NCNA correspondent in London in 1959 to become vice-director of JMJP's International Redaction from 1960-1964. He disappeared during the Cultural Revolution and was reactivated in 1972. In May 1973 he led a journalists' delegation to the Federal Republic of Germany and was a cadre of a department of the CCPCC since 1974. In the fall of the same year he led a journalists' delegation to Zambia, Tanzania, North-Yemen, and South-Yemen.

TSENG T'AO 曾涛

Identified as vice-director of the Hsinhua News Agency (NCNA April 6, 1977). Tseng has worked in the diplomatic field before. He had been ambassador to Algeria (1962-1967), Yugoslavia (1970-1973), and France (1973-1977).

WANG CHIN-TZU

Identified as secretary of the Shansi CP (Taiyuan Radio March 31, 1977). Wang was a cadre of the Shansi Revolutionary Committee in May, 1967.

WANG JUN-SHENG 王润生

Identified as vice-minister of foreign trade (NCNA April 15, 1977). Wang had been commercial counsellor in embassy in Cambodia from 1962-1964 and has worked in the ministry of foreign trade since the end of 1964. He became a permanent representative of the PRC at the U.N. in March 1973, and disappeared in November of the same year. After four years he now is reactivated.

WANG SHU 王殊

Identified as editor-in-chief of Red Flag (Hung-ch'i) (NCNA April 28, 1977). Wang had been an NCNA-correspondent from 1959-1971 in Ghana, Congo (Brazz.), Cuba, and the Federal

Republic of Germany. He was chargé d'affaires ad interim from 1972-1974 and ambassador from 1974-1976 to the Federal Republic of Germany.

WU FU-SHAN 吴富善

Identified as deputy commander of PLA's airforce (NCNA April 22, 1977). Wu is a lieutenant-general and was active in the airforce of the Canton Military Region from 1959-1967. After the Cultural Revolution he was reactivated in 1973 to become a deputy commander of the Canton Military Region in 1974.

YAO YI-LIN 姚依林

Identified as first vice-minister of foreign trade (NCNA April 19, 1977). Yao is an alternate member of the CCPC since 1973. Before Cultural Revolution he had been minister of commerce and was purged in 1967. Reactivated in May 1973 he became vice-minister of foreign trade in November 1973.

YUNG WEN-T'AO 雍文涛

Identified as vice-minister of education (NCNA April 26, 1977). Yung had been vice-minister of forestry from 1959-1962 and was a secretary of the Kuangtung CP from 1965 until Cultural Revolution, and again since 1976.

Identified as vice-chairman of the Chinghai Revolutionary Committee (Sining Radio April 4, 1977).

LI TZU-CHAO

Identified as vice-chairman of the Shantung Revolutionary Committee (NCNA April 21, 1977).

Identified as vice-chairman of the Heilungkiang Revolutionary Committee (NCNA April 21, 1977).

YANG CHIEN

Identified as vice-minister of the first machine building ministry (NCNA April 30, 1977).
