## China's Economic Aid

MAY 1977

### ALGERIA

The sixth medical team left for home in May 1977 (NCNA May 19, 1977).

### CONGO (Brazzaville)

China and Congo signed minutes of talks on the construction of a 'People's Palace' in Brazzaville (NCNA May 6, 1977).

The second cargo-passenger ship built by the Brazzaville shipyard was launched on May 26. The Congolese Transport Minister "highly appreciated the Chinese-Congolese cooperation in shipbuilding" (NCNA May 28, 1977).

### GAMBIA

On May 25 China and Gambia signed minutes of talks on the construction of a stadium and a sportsmen's hostel in Banjul (NCNA May 27, 1977).

### GUYANA

A Chinese expert team which had stayed in Guyana for five years has completed its work of introducing cotton-planting techniques to Guyana. The experts worked with their Guyanese counterparts along the coastal area and at the Kibilibiri state farm to cultivate cotton in consecutive crops, and achieved experience in planting cotton in acid and sandy soil of savanna areas (NCNA May 28, 1977).

### JAMAICA

China will help Jamaica in constructing a textile mill. A study and design team arrived in January this year (NCNA May 7, 1977).

### LAOS

The Itsala Order was conferred on a team of Chinese specialists in Yunnan province for their achievements in training Lao motor mechanics and in cooperating in the field of broadcasting work in Oudomsai (KPL May 6, 1977; cit. SWB 5510).

Chinese workers and engineers are helping to build roads in Northern Laos, as follows: a) the 300km long road from Muong Sai in Oudomsai province to Muong Hiam in Houphan province. Chinese workers are now building the Nam-ou bridge in this part of the road, more than 40km of which have been asphalted and more than 200km, tarmaced; b) the 111km long road from Nambak to Pakmong in Luang Prabang province; c) the road from Muong Sai to Botem near the Lao-Chinese border, built with Chinese aid during the war, has been asphalted (KPL May 11, 1977; cit. SWB 5511).

### PAKISTAN

A textile mill completed at a cost of 50,700,000 rupees at Mirpur, Azad Kashmir, began trial production on May 25. The mill, built with Chinese assistance, will have a capacity of 25,000 spindles and will annually produce 9,000,000 lbs. of yarn (Karachi Radio May 23, 1977).

### TANZANIA

The Chinese medical team working in Zanzibar completed its work and was replaced by another one from China (NCNA May 11, 1977).

### TOGO

A rice-growing centre built with Chinese aid was handed over to Togolese authorities (NCNA May 13, 1977).

### YEMEN, Arab Republic

The Chinese medical team completed its work and was replaced by another one from China (NCNA May 3, 1977).

### Known Cadres on New Posts

#### Chou Tse 周泽

Identified as vice-chairman of the Kiangsu Revolutionary Committee and as member of the Party Committee's Standing Committee (Nanking Radio, May 23, 1977).

Chou, chairman of the Kiangsu Trade Unions before the Cultural Revolution, was elected member of the Kiangsu Revolutionary Committee in 1970 but disappeared soon afterwards. He was reactivated recently.

#### Han Pei-hsin 韩培信

Identified as secretary of the Kiangsu Party Committee NCNA May 14, 1977).

Before he had been a member of the Standing Committee of that Committee, and has also been vice-chairman of the Kiangsu Revolutionary Committee since October 1975.

#### Hsü Ya 许亚

Identified as vice-chairman of the Fukien Revolutionary Committee (Fuchou Radio, May 8, 1977).

Hsü had been vice-governor of Fukien from the 1950s until the Cultural Revolution, and was reactivated in November 1976 when he became a member of the Fukien Party Committee.

#### Hu Hung 胡宏

Identified as secretary of the Kiangsu Party Committee (Nanking Radio, May 23, 1977).

Hu has been a vice-chairman of the Kiangsu Revolutionary Committee since October 1975.

#### Huang Chih-chen 黄知真

Identified as vice-chairman of the Kiangsi Revolutionary Committee (Nanchang Radio May 2, 1977).

Huang, an alternate member of the CCP Central Committee since 1973, has also been secretary of the Kiangsi Party Committee since April 1973.

#### Janabil 贾那布尔

Identified as deputy secretary of the Sinkiang Party Committee (Urumchi Radio May 20, 1977).

Before this he had been a member of that Committee's Standing Committee. Besides he is an alternate member of the CCP Central Committee (elected in 1973), a vice-chairman of the Sinkiang Revolutionary Committee, and first secretary of the Autonomous Chou Ili in Sinkiang.

#### Ku Ta-ch'un 顾大椿

Identified as secretary of the Hupei Party Committee (Wuhan Radio, May 5, 1977).

Ku had been secretary and vice-chairman of the Chinese Trade Unions before the Cultural Revolution. He was not reactivated until 1973 when he appeared as a cadre in an unknown Central Committee department of the CCP. He again disappeared one year later, and was recently reactivated for the second time.

#### Kuo Feng-lien 郭风莲

Identified as vice-chairman of the Shansi Revolutionary Committee and as a member of the Standing Committee of the Shansi Party Committee (NCNA May 23, 1977).

Kuo is chairman and Party secretary of the Tachai Production Brigade, - posts formerly held by Ch'en Yung-kuei.

#### Liu Hsi-wen 刘希文

Identified as vice-minister of foreign trade (NCNA May 2, 1977).

Liu had been an assistant minister in the same ministry since 1964.

#### Lo Yü-ch'uan 罗玉川

Identified as vice-minister of agriculture and forestry (NCNA May 20, 1977).

Lo had been vice-minister of forestry from 1958 until the Cultural Revolution. He was reactivated in 1974, and has been a cadre of the State Council since.

#### Nieh Feng-chih 聂风智

Identified as commander of the Nanking Military Region (Nanking Radio, May 22, 1977).

Nieh is the successor of Ting Sheng, the only commander of a Military Region to be purged after the downfall of the 'Gang of Four'. (see also "BIOGRAPHIES").

#### Shih Ching-yeh

Identified as vice-minister of culture (NCNA May 2, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Shih had been a council member of the Journalists' Association. He was reactivated in November 1976, and became a cadre of the Ministry of Culture in last January.

#### Shih Huai-pi 史怀璧

Identified as vice-chairman of the Shansi Revolutionary

Committee (NCNA May 2, 1977).

Shih had been a vice-governor of Yünnan province before the Cultural Revolution, and was reactivated, as deputy secretary-general of the Shansi Revolutionary Committee in October 1973.

### Sun Kuo-chih 孙国治

Identified as secretary of the Hunan Party Committee (Changsha Radio, May 6, 1977).

Sun had been director of the Communications Department of the Hunan Provincial Party Committee before the Cultural Revolution, and was reactivated as member of the Standing Committee of the Hunan Provincial Party Committee in 1973.

### Ting K'e-tse 丁可则

Identified as vice-chairman of the Kiangsi Revolutionary Committee and as member of the Standing Committee of the Hunan Provincial Party Committee (Nanking Radio, May 23, 1977).

Ting was elected member of the Central Committee of the CCP in 1973. Until that time he had been practically unknown. He disappeared after Mao Tse-tung's funeral and was recently reactivated.

Nieh Feng-chih 聂凤智

Military rank: Lieutenant-General  
Military post: Commander of Nanking Military Region

Nieh was born in Shansi province in 1917. In 1934/5 he took part in the Long March. In 1945 he was commander of the Third Military Sub-District in the East Shantung Military District and at the same time, commander of the 5th Division. At the end of the year he became commander of the 6th Division of the Shantung Field Army. In early 1947 he was in command of the 25th Division of the East China Field Army and at the end of the year he was appointed commander of the 9th Column of that Field Army. In March 1949, Nieh commanded an army under the Third Field Army. In summer 1949 he was appointed chief of staff of the East China Military and Administrative Academy.

- 1950, Dec Appointed commander of the 4th Air Force Army responsible for the training of air force units to fight in the Korean war
- 1952-3 Nieh was entrusted with the strategic command of the air force units of the Chinese People's Volunteers in the Korean war. In this position he took the standpoint that air fights should be conducted in a mobile way, under the principle of "fighting under favourable conditions only". This was contrary to the line adopted by P'eng Te-huai and Soviet advisors of "fighting at all events".
- 1954 Identified as air force commander in the East China Military Region
- 1955, Jan Identified as air force commander in the Nanking Military Region
- 1957, Aug Identified as deputy commander of the Nanking Military Region (at the same time retaining the position of an air force commander in the Nanking Military Region); identified as holding the rank of lieutenant-general
- 1960 Nieh disappeared from the public eye for unknown reasons
- 1975, Jun Identified as deputy commander of the Nanking Military Region
- 1977, May Identified as commander of the Nanking Military Region

Tseng was born in Szechuan province in 1907. Before the Long March he had already made a military career in the First Front Army where he had then attained the post of regimental commander. 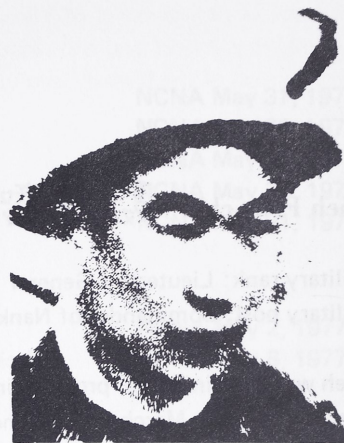

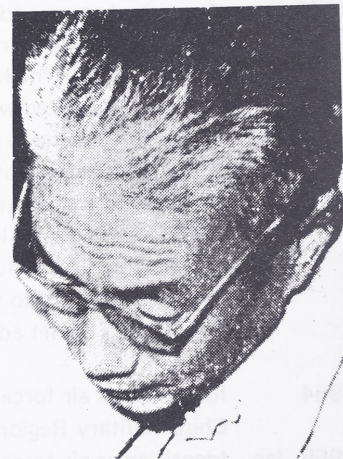
