China's Economic Aid

August 1978

CAMEROON

In Yaounde a Palace of Congress is under construction with Chinese aid (NCNA Aug 13, 1978).

ETHIOPIA

The Bati diesel power station was handed over. It has a generating capacity of 270 kW and seven kilometres of distribution line. It is the sixth such station built under the Sino-Ethiopian economic cooperation accord (NCNA Aug 26, 1978).

IRAQ

Minutes of the talks on the construction of the Sherquat highway bridge crossing the Tigris in Northern Iraq were signed on Aug 27 (NCNA Aug 28, 1978).

NEPAL

A Chinese expert team has completed a feasibility survey for paper and sugar mills as well as ceramic factories to be set up in Nepal (Kathmandu Radio Aug 16, 1978; cited SWB 5897).

PAKISTAN

A (mini?) steel plant based on indigenous iron-ore reserves is being planned for Baluchistan with Chinese assistance (Karachi Radio, Aug 5, 1978; cited SWB/W 993).

SIERRA LEONE

A Chinese team has come to inspect the Sierra Stadium Project which is being built with Chinese assistance (NCNA Aug 15, 1978).

SOMALIA

In the presence of Ch'en Mu-hua (f), alternate member of the Political Bureau of the Chinese Communist Party's Central Committee, the completion of the Beletweyne-Burao highway in Northern Somalia was marked by a ceremony. The construction of this highway started in July 1973. During the construction 2,500 Somali workers were given training in various skills (NCNA Aug 1, 1978).

SRI LANKA

The Uda Walawe freshwater fish-breeding experimental station, which was built with Chinese aid, was handed over on August 12. Located some 100 miles from Colombo, the station was completed in March 1977. The artificial hatching of the Chinese grass carp turned out to be a success for the first time in Sri Lanka. More than 200,000 fry were produced. A successful artificial hatching of the Chinese "bighead" fish in June 1978 produced 284,000 fingerlings, which are being raised in rivers, lakes and reservoirs (NCNA Aug 14, 1978).

UGANDA

A survey group of the Chinese medical group now in the country arrived on Aug 6 (NCNA Aug 8, 1978).

YEMEN, Arab Republic

In an agreement China has undertaken to render assistance during Yemen's Five-Year Plan. Among the projects China intends to help with are a textile mill, an oil-processing plant, both in Hodeida, a hospital, the cultivation of land for agriculture in Hajja region, and a 90km highway between Amram and Hajja (NZZ Aug 18, 1978, cit. Reuter, Aug 16, '78).

CH'EN P'I-HSIEN

陈丕显

Identified as first secretary of the Hupei Provincial Party Committee (Wuhan Radio Aug 11, 1978).

Ch'en is also a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee. Before his new Hupei appointment, he served as second secretary in that province's Party Committee.

The fate of the former first secretary, Chao Hsin-ch'ü, is unknown. He disappeared in July 1978.

CH'IENT MIN

Appointed minister of the Fourth Ministry of Machine-Building (NCNA Aug 18, 1978).

Before this appointment Ch'ien had been a vice-chairman of the Szechuan Revolutionary Committee (since December 1977) and first secretary of the Chungking Party Committee (April 1978).

CHOU HUI

周惠

Identified as second secretary of the Inner Mongolia CP Committee and as vice-chairman of that region's revolutionary committee (Huhehot Radio Aug 1, 1978).

Chou, a Party secretary of Hunan province before the Cultural Revolution, was reactivated in October 1977 to become vice-minister of communications. In this capacity he visited France and Great Britain in May 1978.

CHOU KUAN-WU

周贯五

Identified as vice-minister of metallurgical industry (NCNA Aug 23, 1978) and as general manager of the Peking Iron and Steel Company (NCNA Sep 3, 1978).

Chou is one of the few cadres unharmed during the Cultural Revolution. A PLA lieutenant-general, he was commander of the Chekiang Military District from 1963 until 1965 and deputy political commissar of the Nanking Military Region afterwards. In 1975 he was identified as leading military cadre of

the air-force in Nanking Military Region.

HSIA CH'I

夏琦

Identified as secretary of the Chekiang CP Committee (Hangzhou Radio Aug 27, 1978).

Hsia had been known as a member of the Standing Committee of the Chekiang CP Committee before.

HSIAO CHING-KUANG

肖劲光

Identified as second secretary of the PLA Navy's Party Committee (NCNA Jul 28, 1978).

Hsiao has been a member of the CCP Central Committee ever since 1956 and commander of the PLA Navy since 1954. The first secretary of the Navy Party Committee - a body which has been mentioned for the first time now - is Su Chen-hua (see below).

HSIEH CHEN-HUA

谢振华

Identified as deputy commander of the Shenyang Military Region (NCNA Aug 2, 1978).

Hsieh is a PLA major-general and was a leading military in the Shansi Military District before the Cultural Revolution. He became commander of that district in 1970 and was elected first secretary of the Shansi CP Committee one year later. Having been elected alternate member of the 10th Central Committee of the CCP in 1973, he disappeared from the political scene in the fall of 1975.

KAO JUI

高锐

Identified as vice-president of the PLA Military Science Academy (NCNA Aug 18, 1978).

Kao had been second secretary of the Ningshia CP Committee from 1971 to 1973, and has been known as a leading military cadre in Peking since October 1977.

KAO TSUN-HSIN

Identified as deputy commander of the PLA Artillery Corps

(NCNA Aug 18, 1978).

It was at Chou En-lai's funeral that Kao was mentioned as a military cadre for the first time.

KUNG TA-FEI 宫达非

Identified as assistant minister of foreign affairs (NCNA Aug 2, 1978).

Kung has been known to be active in the diplomatic field since 1965. He was an official in the Foreign Ministry until his appointment as ambassador to Iraq (1970) and Zaire (1973-1978).

LI CH'AO-PO 李超伯

Identified as vice-minister of the State Capital Construction Commission (NCNA Aug 24, 1978).

Li had been vice-minister of chemical industry from 1960 to 1962 and was then made member of the State Economic Commission. During the Cultural Revolution he was purged. After his reactivation in 1977 Li was made secretary of the Kansu CP Committee.

LIU FU-CHIH 刘复之

Identified as vice-minister of public security (NCNA Aug 14, 1978).

Liu had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution during which he disappeared. Reactivated in 1972 he was given the same post but disappeared again in 1973. In 1978 he was again reactivated and made vice-minister of culture.

MA CHI-KUNG 马继孔

Identified as secretary of the Kansu CP Committee (Lanchou Radio, Aug 22, 1978).

Ma had held the same post before the Cultural Revolution when he disappeared. He was reactivated in January 1978 and appointed vice-chairman of the Kansu Revolutionary Committee.

MA WEN-JUI 马文瑞

Identified as vice-president of the Party School of the CCP Central Committee (NCNA Aug 11, 1978).

A former minister of labour, Ma was purged during the Cultural Revolution and reactivated in 1974. He became vice-minister of the State Planning Commission in July 1977 and was elected a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee one month later.

MA YI 马义

Identified as vice-minister of the State Economic Commission (NCNA Aug 23, 1978).

Between 1972 and 1977 Ma was vice-minister of the First Ministry of Machine-Building, to become vice-minister of the State Planning Commission in February 1978.

SHANG KAN

Identified as commander of the Honan Military District (Chengchou Radio, Aug 24, 1978).

Shang had been known to be deputy commander of that District since March 1978. We do not know what has become of the former commander, Chang Shu-chih, who had held that post since 1964.

SU CHEN-HUA 苏振华

Identified as first secretary of the PLA Navy's Party Committee (NCNA Aug 28, 1978).

This is the first time that the Navy's Party Committee has ever been mentioned.- Su is also a member of the Political Bureau of the 11th Central Committee of the CCP.

SZUT'U HUI-MIN 司徒惠敏

Identified as vice-minister of culture (NCNA Aug 10, 1978).

Szut'u had been vice-director of the Film Industry Administration under the Ministry of Culture from 1959 to 1964 and vice-director of that Ministry's Film Bureau from 1960 until the Cultural Revolution in which he was purged. He was reactivated in 1975.

TENG CHIA-T'AI 邓家泰

Identified as deputy commander of the PLA Armoured Corps (NCNA Aug 12, 1978).

Teng was a PLA major-general before the Cultural Revolution during which he disappeared. Since 1976 he had been chief of staff of the Headquarters of Nanking Military Region.

WANG TO 王铎

Identified as secretary of the Inner Mongolia CP Committee (Huhehot Radio Aug 17, 1978).

Before Wang had been a member of that region's CP Standing Committee.

YAO YI-LIN 姚依林

Appointed minister of commerce (NCNA Aug 18, 1978).

Yao, who is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee, was first vice-minister of the ministry of foreign trade before his present appointment.

Deceased Cadres

LO JUI-CH'ING 罗瑞卿

Decased August 3, 1978 (NCNA Aug 8, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Lo had been PLA Chief of Staff under Lin Piao.

Reactivated in 1975, he was reelected member of the CCP Central Committee in 1977.

WANG CHENG 王淨

Deceased Aug 13, 1978 (NCNA Aug 20, 1978).

Wang was minister of the Fourth Ministry of Machine-Building, deputy chief of staff of the PLA and member of the 11th CCP Central Committee.

New Cadres

CHAO YU-YU

Identified as vice-chairman of the Chekiang Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Aug 30, 1978).

CHEN LIEH-MIN

Identified as vice-minister of petroleum industry, secretary of the Heilungkiang CP Committee and Party secretary of the Taching oilfield (NCNA Aug 31, 1978).

LI FEI-PING

Identified as vice-minister of the Ministry of Metallurgical Industry (NCNA Aug 1, 1978).

LI HSIEH-PO

Identified as vice-minister of railways NCNA Aug 31, 1978).

LI HUANG

Identified as secretary of the Liaoning CP Committee and as first secretary of the Lüta CP Committee (NCNA Aug 2, 1978).

LI YÜAN-JU 李元如

Identified as vice-minister of the Fourth Ministry of Machine-Building, director of the General Broadcasting and Television Industry Bureau (NCNA Aug 10, 1978).

Appointed ambassador to Zaire (NCNA Aug 29, 1978).

MENG YING 孟英

Appointed ambassador to the Mongolian People's Republic (NCNA Aug 2, 1978).
