- 12 FRANCE Agreement with the Société Nationale de Télévision Française on the exchange of television reporters for news coverage, exchange of TV programmes and the further development of cooperation (2)

CAMEROON

The second Chinese medical team arrived recently to replace the first one (NCNA Sep 10, 1978).

CHAD

A protocol on economic and technical cooperation was signed on Sept 23, 1978 (NCNA Sep 23, 1978).

JAMAICA

A contract for the supply of equipment and materials for the Jamaican Cotton Polyester Textile Company Ltd. which is to be built with Chinese aid, was signed on September 22, 1978 (SWB/W 1000).

KOREA

The first stage of the Ponghwa chemical works, a reliable giant chemical industry base, has been completed and production has started. Gifts sent by Kim Il-sung to Chinese technicians were conveyed and orders and medals awarded to them (KCNA Sept 8, 1978; cit. SWB/W 999). The first stage of the chemical works accounts for the greater part of the whole construction project, and was completed in little over one year (KCNA Sep 6, 1978; cit. SWB/W 999).

LAOS

A document on China's construction of a brick factory for Laos in Oudomsai Province was signed on September 11, 1978 (KPL Sep 13, 1978; cit. SWB 5917).

A group of technicians from China's Ministries for the Petroleum and Chemical Industries arrived in Vientiane to prepare for the construction of an oxygen factory with

Chinese assistance (KPL Sep 28, 1978; cit. SWB 5930).

NEPAL

The Chinese industrial survey team which conducted a feasibility study with a view to setting up cement, paper and sugar industries left Nepal on September 23, 1978 (Kathmandu Radio Sep 23, 1978; cit. SWB 5928).

NIGERIA

The Chinese-assisted Itoikin rice technical popularizing station established in accordance with a protocol signed in 1976 cultivates over 170 hectares of wasteland for rice plantation (NCNA Sep 27, 1978).

TANZANIA

44 Chinese doctors who had completed a two-year working tour in Tanzania left for home. Another group of 44 doctors has arrived to take over the work (NCNA Sep 23, 1978).

A protocol on the further development of economic and technical cooperation was signed on September 14, 1978 (NCNA Sep 14, 1978).

Known Cadres on New Posts

CHANG HSIU-LUNG 张秀龙

Identified as deputy commander of the Wuhan Military Region (Wuhan Radio, Sep 4, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Chang was known as a major-general in Sinkiang Province. Since 1976 he has been known to have been commander of the Hupei Military District and vice-chairman of the Hupei Revolutionary Committee.

CHANG YU-HSÜAN 张友萱

Identified as vice-minister of the Sixth Ministry of Machine-Building (NCNA Sep 1, 1978).

From 1958 until 1965 Chang had been vice-chairman of the State Technology Commission. He was purged during the Cultural Revolution and not reactivated until 1976.

CHAO WEN-CHIN 赵文进

Identified as deputy commander of the Chengtu Military Region and as commander of the Szechuan Military District (Chengtu Radio, Sep 29, 1978).

Before, during and after the Cultural Revolution Chao was a deputy commander of the Tibet Military Region. He disappeared in 1974 to be reactivated early this year.

HSI CHUNG-HSÜN 习仲勋

Identified as second political commissar of the Canton Military Region (Canton Radio, Sep 21, 1978).

Hsi, a vice premier before the Cultural Revolution, was purged in 1962. He was reactivated early this year to become second secretary of the Kuangtung CP Committee in April and vice-chairman of the Kuangtung Revolutionary Committee in the same month.

HU PING-YÜN 胡炳云

Identified as secretary of the Shensi CP Committee (Sian Radio, Sep 25, 1978) and as deputy commander of the Shenyang Military Region (Sian Radio, Sep 23, 1978).

Hu is a PLA major-general and had been commander of the Shensi Military District until 1967. He disappeared during the Cultural Revolution and was reactivated in October 1974. In July 1977 he was made commander of the Shensi Military District again.

HUAN HSIANG 宦乡

Identified as vice president of the Academy of Social Sciences (NCNA Sep 15, 1978).

Huan comes from the diplomatic service. From 1949 until 1953 he was director of the Department for Western Europe and Africa in the Foreign Ministry. From 1953 until 1962 he was ambassador to Great Britain. Huan was purged during the Cultural Revolution and reactivated in 1976, when he was appointed ambassador to Belgium, to the European Community and to Luxembourg. He held these posts until March 1978.

JEN CHUNG-YI 任仲夷

Identified as first secretary of Liaoning CP Committee, as chairman of the Liaoning Revolutionary Committee and as first political commissar of the Liaoning Military District (Shenyang Radio, Sep 29, 1978).

Before his new appointments, Jen, who is a member of the 11th Central Committee of the CCP, was second secretary of the Liaoning CP Committee and first vice-chairman of the Liaoning Revolutionary Committee. He succeeds Tseng Shao-shan who was last seen on September 1, 1978.

KAO YANG-WEN 高扬文

Identified as vice-minister of the metallurgical industry (NCNA Sep 19, 1978).

Kao had been on the same post from 1957 until 1964. In 1965 he was appointed deputy chairman of the State Economic Commission. He disappeared during the Cultural Revolution and was reactivated in 1973.

LI LI-KUNG 李立功

Identified as secretary of the Peking Municipal CP Committee

(NCNA Sep 25, 1978).

Li had been a cadre of the Communist Youth League before the Cultural Revolution, during which he was purged. Re-activated at the end of 1977, he became vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee in December 1977.

LI YI-LIN 李艺林

Identified as vice-minister of petroleum industry (Hangzhou Radio, Sep 24, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Li had been vice-minister of chemical industry. He disappeared during the Cultural Revolution and was reactivated in 1974. In November that year he became vice-minister of the fuel and chemical industries and in November 1975, vice-minister of the petroleum industry and chemical industry.

LIAO CH'ENG-CHIH 廖承志

Identified as head of the Overseas Chinese Affairs Office under the State Council (NCNA Sep 19, 1978).

Liao, who is a member of the 11th Central Committee of the CCP, is chiefly concerned with Sino-Japanese affairs. Besides, he is one of the vice-chairmen of the Standing Committee of the Fifth National People's Congress.

LIU TA 刘达

Identified as president of Tsinghua University (NCNA Sep 16, 1978).

Liu was elected deputy for Peking to the Fifth National People's Congress in March 1978.

WANG JEN-CHUNG 王任重

Identified as second secretary of the Shensi CP Committee and as first vice-chairman of the Shensi Revolutionary Committee (Sian Radio, Sep 25, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution, Wang had been an alternate member of the 8th Central Committee of the CCP. The most prominent post he held before the Cultural Revolution was that of first secretary of the Central South Bureau of the CCP Central Committee. In January 1976 he was criticized as a follower of the Liu Shao-ch'i line. He was reactivated only now.

WANG TAO-HAN 汪道涵

Identified as vice-minister of economic relations with foreign countries (NCNA Sep 14, 1978) and as chairman of the Society of Mechanical Engineering (NCNA Sep 19, 1978).

Between 1945 and 1963 Wang had been vice-minister of the First Ministry of Machine Building. From 1964 until the Cultural Revolution he was vice-chairman of the State Commission for Economic Relations with Foreign Countries. He was purged during the Cultural Revolution and reactivated only now.

WANG YANG 汪洋

Identified as deputy commander of the Peking Military

Region (NCNA Sep 26, 1978).

Before being appointed minister of the 7th Ministry of Machine Building by the Fourth National People's Congress in January 1975, Wang had been known as a leading military person. He was not reappointed to his ministerial post by the Fifth NPC in March 1978.

YAO CHIN 姚进

Identified as vice-minister of finance (NCNA Sep 7, 1978).

Yao had been known as a cadre in the Ministry of Finance since January 1976.

YÜAN PAO-HUA 袁宝华

Identified as vice-minister of the State Economic Commission (NCNA Sep 11, 1978).

Yüan who is an alternate member of the 11th Central Committee of the CCP was minister for the allocation of material before the Cultural Revolution. From 1974 until the spring of this year he was vice-chairman of the State Planning Commission.

CHANG JUI-CHING

Identified as vice-minister of finance (NCNA, Sep 7, 1978).

HSIN YÜAN-HSI

Identified as vice-minister of finance (NCNA, Sep 7, 1978).

LI TIEN-HSIANG

Identified as vice-minister of petroleum industry (NCNA Sep 25, 1978).

Li is a former **mechanical** engineer of the Ministry of Petroleum. He made valuable contributions to the development of China's petroleum mining industry and the improvement of China's petroleum technology and equipment.

LIAO SHIH-CH'ÜAN

Identified as vice-minister of railways and as second secretary of the Chengchou Railway Bureau's CP Committee (Chengchou Radio, Aug 31, 1978).

LIU PEI-TAO

Identified as vice-minister of railways and as secretary of the Shanghai Railway Bureau's CP Committee (Shanghai Radio, Sep 16, 1978).

LU PEI-CHIEN

Identified as vice-minister of finance (NCNA, Sep 7, 1978).

WANG SZU-HUI

Identified as vice-chairman of the Tientsin Revolutionary

Committee (NCNA Sep 9, 1978).

YANG HSIN-PEI

Identified as vice-chairman of the Shanghai Revolutionary
Committee (NCNA Sep 14, 1978).
