BURMA

A summary of talks on the construction of a national indoor stadium for Burma was signed on October 20 (NCNA Oct 20, 1978). It will have 10,000 seats (Rangoon Radio Oct 20, 1978; cit. SWB/W 1004).

LAOS

A group of Chinese technicians arrived in Vietnam to prepare for the construction of an oxygen plant with Chinese assistance (SWB/W 1001).

NEPAL

An agreement on the construction of complete projects by China was signed on October 1 (NCNA Oct 1, 1978).

SRI LANKA

The Chinese technicians who had accomplished their work in building the Minneriya cotton-spinning mill, left the country. They had come to Sri Lanka in 1976 to construct this mill, one of the biggest in that country. The mill produces 1.6 million kilogrammes of yarn every year (NCNA Oct 8, 1978). In 1977 the mill earned 125,000,000 rupees in foreign exchange; the amount envisaged for 1978 is 500,000,000 rupees (Colombo Radio Oct 8, 1978; cit. SWB/W 1004).

VIETNAM

Vice-premier Teng Hsiao-p'ing told Thai newsmen that China had cut off her aid to Vietnam after spending 20,000 million US dollars on assistance programmes to that country (Bangkok Nation Review Oct 13, 1978; cit. SWB 5942).

Known Cadres on New Posts

CHAO HSIN-CH'U 赵辛初

Identified as vice-minister of the State Planning Commission (NCNA Oct 19, 1978).

Chao had been first Party secretary and chairman of the Hupei Provincial Revolutionary Committee until August this year.

CH'EN P'I-HSIEN 陈丕显

Identified as chairman of the Hupei Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Wuhan Radio, Oct 2, 1978).

Ch'en has been first Party secretary of Hupei Province since August 1978.

CH'EN WEI-TA 陈伟达

Identified as first secretary of the Tientsin Municipal CP Committee (Tientsin Radio Oct 13, 1978), and as chairman of the Tientsin Municipal Revolutionary Committee (Tientsin Radio Oct 28, 1978).

Ch'en, a member of the CCP Central Committee, had been Party secretary and vice-chairman of the Revolutionary Committee of Chekiang Province before. He succeeds Lin Hu-chia who took over the post of first secretary of the Peking Municipal CP Committee.

CHIA T'ING-SAN 贾庭三

Identified as third secretary of the Peking Municipal CP Committee (NCNA Oct 28, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Chia had held the post of a vice-mayor of Peking and was purged together with P'eng Chen. After the Cultural Revolution he was active in Kueichou Province and eventually became second secretary of the Kueichou CP Committee in April 1978.

CH'IH PI-CH'ING 池必卿

Identified as vice-chairman of the Kueichou Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Kueiyang Radio Oct 2, 1978).

Ch'ih had been second secretary of Kueichou CP Committee since June this year. He then came from the Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region where he had held the same post until April 1978.

CHOU HUI 周惠

Identified as first secretary of the CP Committee of the Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region (Huhehot Radio Oct 13, 1978).

Chou had been second secretary of the Region's Party Committee before and has now succeeded Yu T'ai-chung who was deprived of his posts in Inner Mongolia, while retaining that of deputy commander of the Peking Military Region.

CHU YÜN-CH'IEH 朱云谦

Identified as vice-director of the PLA General Political Department (NCNA Oct 23, 1978).

Chu, a PLA major-general and deputy commandant of the PLA Air Force Academy before the Cultural Revolution, was reactivated in 1974 to become political commissar of the Air Force in Canton Military Region in 1975.

HAN YING 韩英

Elected first secretary of the Communist Youth League (NCNA Oct 28, 1978).

Han, who has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since 1977, had been Party secretary and vice-chairman of the Shansi Provincial Revolutionary Committee before his present assignment.

HO PIAO 贺彪

Identified as vice-director of the PLA General Logistics Department (NCNA Oct 16, 1978).

Ho, probably a brother of Ho Lung's, had been vice-minister of public health between 1958 and 1967.

HSIUNG FU 熊复

Identified as editor-in-chief of Hung-ch'i (Red Flag) (NCNA

Oct 1, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Hsiung had been secretary-general of the Propaganda Department of the CCP Central Committee. In March this year he was elected a member of the 5th CPPCC.

HSÜ LIANG-TU 徐良图

Identified as vice-minister of the State Economic Commission (NCNA Oct 31, 1978).

Before his present appointment, Hsü had been a vice-minister of the State Planning Commission.

HSÜ SHIH-YU 许世友

Identified as first secretary of the Canton Military Region's Party Committee (NCNA Oct 21, 1978).

Hsü is a member of the CCP Political Bureau and has been commander of the Canton Military Region since 1974.

HUANG CHING-YAO 黄经耀

Identified as deputy commander of the Lanchow Military Region, commander of the Ninghsia Military District and Secretary of the Ninghsia CP Committee (NCNA Oct 24, 1978).

Huang had been commander of the Shensi Military District between 1967 and 1977 and was reelected secretary of the Shensi CP Committee in April 1978.

KUO HUNG-T'AO 郭洪涛

Identified as vice-minister of the State Economic Commission (NCNA Oct 24, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Kuo had already held the same position. In March 1978 he was elected a member of the 5th CPPCC's Standing Committee.

LI YÜ-T'ANG 李玉堂

Identified as vice-minister of the Fifth Ministry of Machine-Building (NCNA Oct 25, 1978).

Li held the same position before the Cultural Revolution during which he disappeared.

LIN HU-CHIA 林乎加

Identified as first Party secretary and chairman of the Peking Municipal Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Oct 20, 1978).

Lin succeeds Wu Te who has, however, retained his positions in the Political Bureau and the National People's Congress.

LIU CHING-FANG 刘景范

Identified as vice-minister of civil affairs (NCNA Oct 24, 1978).

Liu had been vice-minister of geology from 1955 until the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in 1975, he was elected member of the 5th CPPCC in March 1978.

NI CHIH-FU 倪志福

Elected president of the All-China Federation of Trade Unions (NCNA Oct 23, 1978).

TUAN CHÜN-YI 段君毅

Identified as first secretary of the Honan Provincial CP Committee, chairman of the Honan Provincial Revolutionary Committee and first political commissar of the Honan Military District (Nov 1978).

Tuan, who is a member of the 11th Central Committee of the CCP, was minister of railways before his present appointment.

WANG HUI-TE 王惠德

Identified as director of the Bureau for the Translation of the Works of Marx, Engels, Lenin and Stalin under the CCP Central Committee (NCNA Oct 11, 1978).

Wang had been a member of Jen-min jih-pao's Editorial Department before the Cultural Revolution.

WANG KAN-CH'ANG 王淦昌

Identified as director of the Institute of Atomic Energy under the Academy of Sciences (NCNA Oct 18, 1978).

Wang, a well-known nuclear scientist, had been vice-director of the above Institute before the Cultural Revolution. He succeeds Ch'ien San-ch'iang, who had been appointed vice-president of the Academy of Sciences in March 1978.

WEI YUNG-CH'ING 韦永清

Identified as director of the Protocol Department, Foreign Ministry (NCNA Oct 15, 1978).

Wei had been ambassador to Turkey until September 1978.

WEN FU-SHAN

Identified as vice-chairman of the Fukien Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Fuchou Radio Oct 2, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Wen had been vice-director of the Financial and Economic Department of the Fukien CP Committee.

WU HUNG-HSIANG 伍洪祥

Identified as secretary of the Fukien Provincial CP Committee (Fuchou Radio Oct 14, 1978).

Before this assignment, Wu had been a member of the Standing Committee of the Fukien Party Committee.
