## Agreements with Foreign Countries

China will import 30,000 tons of rubber; 10,000 tons of chemical fibre; maize, gunny bags, tapioca flour, kenaf, green beans, tobacco.  
Thailand will import 600,000 tons of crude oil; 24,000 tons of high-speed diesel oil (3)  
3) Plan for scientific and technical cooperation 1978-1979 (4)  
The Thai side has approved twelve projects proposed by the Chinese side. These include the sending of Chinese officials to Thailand to study potash mining, sugar production, rubber planting and production, shrimp and fish breeding, botany, cultivation of grapes, planting of rice, control and prevention of crop diseases, information on rice production, and the production of certain herbs and medicines.  
The 17 projects which the Thai side proposed to the Chinese side and which were approved, include the sending of Thai officials to China to study Chinese herbs, rural health methods, silk production, domestic and handicrafts industries, farm tool production, petrochemical industry, fresh-water fish-breeding, reforestation, irrigation, pig raising, farm mechanization, flower growing and meteorological data on the Upper Mekong River during floods (5).

## China's Economic Aid

November 1978

### LIBERIA

A Chinese survey team left Monrovia after having surveyed the sports complex of Liberia for 13 days (NCNA Nov 29, 1978).

### MAURITANIA

The first stage of the Nouakchott power station project which is being built with Chinese aid, has been completed. The new station, together with the already existing 8,500-kilowatt station, will meet the capital's growing need for electricity (NCNA Nov 28, 1978).

### PAKISTAN

A sugar mill set up with Chinese assistance near Larkana in Sind Province has started functioning. The mill which has cost 120,000,000 rupees will have a capacity to produce over 400,000 tons of sugar annually (Karachi Radio Nov 6, 1978).

### RWANDA

Projects which have been planned for Rwanda and undertaken with Chinese assistance, but which are not yet under way, include the Rubindi-Rwamagana rice scheme, a cement works, a large hospital, a sports stadium to accommodate 22,000 persons, a flour mill of 6,000 tons' annual capacity, and a small ceramics factory (Kigali Radio Nov 2, 1978; cit. SWB/W 1007).

### SUDAN

An agreement has been signed in which China agreed to build in Sudan a factory to produce ready-made clothing, with an annual output of 200,000 garments. China will provide equipments, spares and staff training (NCNA Nov 14, 1978, and SWB/W 1008).

### Known Cadres on New Posts

CHANG WEN-CHOU 张 文 舟

Identified as deputy commander of the PLA Armoured Forces (NCNA Nov 23, 1978).

Chang had held the same posts before the Cultural Revolution in which he disappeared. He was reactivated in 1974.

CHAO CH'ANG-CH'UN 赵 长 春

Identified as vice-minister of foreign trade (NCNA Nov 29, 1978).

Before his present appointment, Chao had been director of the ministry of foreign trade's General Office.

CHAO TS'ANG-PI 赵 苍 璧

Identified as deputy leader of the Central Political and Judicial Group (NCNA Oct 29, 1978).

This group seems to be a new central organ. Chao's other posts also include that of minister of public security and member of the 11th Central Committee of the CCP.

CH'EN HSI-LIEN 陈 锡 联

Identified as deputy leader of the National People's Air Defence Leading Group (NCNA Nov 1, 1978).

This group seems to be a new central organ, too. Ch'en is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee's Political Bureau and commander of the Peking Military Region.

CH'ENG WANG

Identified as vice-minister of communications (NCNA Nov 22, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Ch'eng held the post of a vice-director of the Shipbuilding Industry Bureau of the First Ministry of Machine-Building. He was reactivated in 1977 when he was identified as Council member of the Shipbuilding Engineering Society.

CHI TENG-K'UEI 纪 登 奎

Identified as leader of the Central Political and Judicial Group (NCNA Oct 29, 1978).

Chi is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee's Political Bureau and vice-premier of the State Council.

CH'IN CHI-WEI 秦 基 伟

Identified as first political commissar of the Peking Military Region (NCNA Nov 21, 1978).

Ch'in is a member of the 11th CCP Central Committee. He had been commander of the Chengtu Military Region from 1974 until 1975 when he was made second political commissar of the Peking Military Region. In his new position he is a successor to Chi Teng-k'uei who had held this important military position as a civilian since 1974.

KAN TZU-YÜ 甘 子 玉

Identified as vice-minister of the State Planning Commission (NCNA Nov 26, 1978).

Except an article Kan published in 'Red Flag' (HCh) in the August 1961 number, nothing is known about him.

K'UNG FEI 孔 飞

Identified as chairman of the Revolutionary Committee of the Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region (Huhehot R. Nov 15, 1978) and as secretary of that Region's Party Committee (Huhehot R. Nov 9, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution K'ung had been deputy commander of the Inner Mongolia Military Region. He was reactivated in May 1978.

As Chou Hui was identified as first secretary of the Inner Mongolia Party Committee at the same time, Inner Mongolia is now the only region/province where the posts of first secretary of the Party Committee and of chairman of the Revolutionary Committee are not in one man's hands.

KUO WEI-CH'ENG 郭 维 城

Identified as minister of railways (NCNA Nov 3, 1978).

Before his present appointment Kuo was a vice-minister in the same ministry. He has succeeded Tuan Chün-yi, who became first secretary of the Honan Provincial Party Committee in August 1978.

LI YI-CH'ING

李 一 清

Identified as vice-minister of posts and telecommunications (NCNA Oct 24, 1978).

Before the Cultural Revolution Li had been director of the Wuhan Iron and Steel Company and had held posts in the technical field under the CCP Central Committee's Central South Bureau (since 1963). He was reactivated when he got his new appointment (see above).

LIU FU-CHIH

刘 复 之

Identified as vice-minister of culture (NCNA Nov 11, 1978).

Liu had been vice-minister of public security between 1964 and 1973 when he disappeared. In January 1978 he was reactivated as vice-minister of culture and was referred to as vice-minister of public security by NCNA on Aug 18, 1978, but this was probably a mistake.

LIU HUA-CH'ING

刘 华 清

Identified as vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technical Commission (NCNA Nov 15, 1978).

Liu, who had been a vice-admiral in the PLA Navy and commander of the Talién Navak Base before the Cultural Revolution, was reactivated in 1975.

PAI CHIH-MIN

白 浩 民

Identified as secretary of the Fukien Provincial Party Committee (Fuchou R. Nov 2, 1978).

Since January 1978 Pai has also been vice-chairman of the Fukien Provincial Revolutionary Committee.

WANG LEI

王 磊

Identified as secretary of the CCP Committee and vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee (Peking R. Nov 10, 1978).

Wang has been a Peking cadre since the early seventies and a vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee since 1973. He was appointed minister of commerce by the 5th NPC in March 1978 but only four months later Yao Yi-lin succeeded him in that position.

WANG TZU-KANG

王 子 纲

Identified as minister of posts and telecommunications (NCNA Nov 17, 1978).

Wang had been a vice-minister in the same ministry from 1959 until the Cultural Revolution in which he disappeared. Reactivated in 1973, he became vice-minister of the Fourth Ministry of Machine-Building in November last year.

WANG YÜ-CH'ING

王 雨 清

Identified as vice-minister of metallurgical industry (NCNA Nov 28, 1978).

Wang had held the same position before the Cultural Revolution. Reactivated in 1973, he has been vice-director of the Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC) since.

YÜN SHIH-YING

云 世 英

Identified as secretary of the Inner Mongolian Autonomous Region's Party Committee (Huhehot R. Nov 15, 1978).

Yün, a deputy mayor of Paotou Municipality before the Cultural Revolution, was elected vice-chairman of Inner Mongolia's Revolutionary Committee in December last year.

KAO WEN-LI

Identified as vice-minister of public security (NCNA Oct 24, 1978).

MA PIN

Identified as vice-minister of metallurgical industry and as CP secretary of the Anshan Steel Company (NCNA Nov 15, '78).

Died on October 21, 1978 (NCNA Oct 27, 1978).

Identified as secretary of the CCP Committee and vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee (Peking R. Nov 10, 1978). Wang has been a Peking cadre since the early 1950s and a vice-chairman of the Peking Revolutionary Committee since 1973. He was appointed minister of commerce by the CPC in March 1978 but only four months later Yao Yimin succeeded him in that position.

WANG TZO-KANG  
Identified as minister of posts and telegraph communications (NCNA Nov 13, 1978). Wang had been a vice-minister in the same ministry from 1958 until the Cultural Revolution in which he disappeared. Recalled in 1973, he became vice-minister of the Ministry of Machine-Building in November last year.

WANG YU-CHING  
Identified as vice-minister of metallurgical industry (NCNA Nov 28, 1978). Wang had held the same position before the Cultural Revolution. Recalled in 1973, he had been vice-director of the Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC) since 1971.
