China's Economic Aid

November 1977

BURUNDI

The foundation-laying ceremony for the Mugere hydro-electric station to be built with China's aid at the town of Mutambu in Bujumbara took place on Nov 16, 1977 (NCNA Nov 18, 1977).

CENTRAL AFRICAN EMPIRE

A Chinese road-study group arrived on Nov 9, 1977 (NCNA Nov 16, 1977).

LAOS

A new highway, built with Chinese aid, which links Oudomsa province with Nam Bak in Luang Prabang province, both in northern Laos, has been asphalted (Vientiane Radio Nov 22, 1977; cit. SWB 5676).

MADAGASCAR

During the past two years the Chinese medical team collected more than 100 varieties of herbs of medical value and made six preparations for curing cough alone. The medical team found the island "virtually a treasure-house of herbs of high medical value" (NCNA Nov 22, 1977).

MALTA

A protocol on economic and technical cooperation was signed on Nov 6, 1977 (NCNA Nov 6, 1977).

MAURITANIA

The National Hygienics Centre, built with Chinese assistance, was inaugurated on Nov 28, 1977. It has eleven laboratories and is the first well-equipped institute against epidemics in the country (NCNA Nov 29, 1977).

A garment factory built with Chinese assistance was inaugurated on Nov 28, 1977. It was completed in April 1977 and has an annual capacity of 100,000 garments (NCNA Nov 29, 1977).

MOZAMBIQUE

In August last year the Chinese medical team helped to save the survivals of a massacre in a Zimbabwean refugee camp after an attack by Rhodesian troops (NCNA Nov 22, 1977).

PAKISTAN

Material for the construction of the Tarbela spinning mill has started arriving from China. The mill is expected to be completed within two years (Karachi Radio Oct 28, 1977; cit. SWB/W 955).

SIERRA LEONE

A launching ceremony for the construction of a sugar mill and a sugar-cane farm (to be built with Chinese assistance) was held on Oct 31, 1977, in the village of Mamunta in the Northern Province of Sierra Leone (NCNA Nov 1, 1977).

Six Chinese-aided agrotechnical stations (at Makali, Rolako, Njagboima, Ogoo, Mahera and Torma Bum) were handed over on Nov 24, 1977, as part of the inter-governmental agreements on the construction of rice technical stations. These stations have reclaimed 800 hectares of land, built two small dams and dug 122 thousand metres of irrigation canal in the past three years. Good rice harvests have been gathered on the stations' demonstration plots and in the popularizing areas. The Makali station, which is mainly cultivating fine strains of rice, gathered in a per-hectare yield of 10,395 kg this year on a 4-hectare plot, which is 4-5 times as much as the local average. The rice output in the 280 hectares of Makali's popularization area doubled the local average yield. The station has provided the whole country with large quantities of good rice seeds in the past few years. (NCNA Nov 25, 1977).

SOMALIA

The Chinese-aided Mogadishu stadium was handed over on Nov 15, 1977. Construction had started in December 1975. The stadium has a capacity of 30,000 seats and its buildings cover more than 23,000 sq.m. (NCNA Nov 15, 1977). The whole complex occupies 210,000 sq.m. and has playing fields and training facilities for athletics and ball games, as well as a dormitory building which can house 200 sportsmen (NCNA Nov 16, 1977).

TANZANIA

The Chinese-aided Bihawana agrotechnical centre in Dodoma region was handed over on Nov 7, 1977. This centre has helped the local people realize their ability to overcome hunger, and made contributions to agricultural production, taming oxen to till land and making small farm tools with local raw material. The training centre was established in 1973, 20 km east of Dodoma and has 41 ha of experimental farm land. It provides peasants with seeds and arranges training courses (NCNA Nov 9, 1977).

UGANDA

Chinese agrotechnical experts are helping construct the Doho rice-growing area in Bunyoro country of Uganda's Eastern Province. They came to Doho in November 1975 and started with a river-harnessing programme at the Manafwa R. They made experimental plots to teach local peasants (NCNA Nov 3, 1977).

CHANG P'ING-HUA 张平花

Identified as director of the CCP Central Committee's Propaganda Department (NCNA Nov 28, 1977).

Chang had been second secretary of the Hunan Provincial Party Committee before, and has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since the 10th Party Congress in 1973.

CHANG SHU-TE 张树德

Identified as secretary of the Liaoning Provincial Party Committee (Shenyang Radio Oct 27, 1977).

Before becoming secretary, Chang had been a member of the Liaoning Party Committee's Standing Committee. He has also held the post of a vice-chairman of the Liaoning Provincial Revolutionary Committee since 1973.

CHANG TS'E 张策

Identified as secretary of the Shensi Provincial Party Committee (Sian Radio November 4, 1977).

Since 1973 Chang had been a member of that Committee's Standing Committee and also a vice-chairman of the Shensi Provincial Revolutionary Committee - a post which he still seems to retain.

CHIANG YI-CHEN 江一真

Identified as minister of public health (NCNA Nov 18, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Chiang was governor of Fu-kien province (until 1959), vice-minister of the Ministry for State Farms and Land Reclamation (1962-1963) and vice-minister of agriculture (1964-1966). He then disappeared to be reactivated in 1974.

CH'IH HAO-T' IEN 迟浩田

Identified as deputy chief of staff of the PLA (NCNA Nov 20, 1977).

Ch'ih had already been a PLA deputy to the Second and Third National People's Congresses. Following his reactivation in 1974, he was made deputy political commissar of the Peking Military Region in the fall of 1975. In March 1977, Ch'ih was identified as deputy editor-in-chief of Jen-min jih-pao.

FANG CHIH-CH'UN 方志纯

Identified as vice-chairman of the Kiangsi Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Nanchang Radio Nov 17, 1977).

Fang had been vice-governor and Party secretary in Kiangsi province in the late fifties already and was elected governor of that province in September 1965. In 1967 he was purged after criticism and not reactivated until October 1977.

HSI CHIN-WU

Identified as secretary of the Tibet Autonomous Region's Party Committee (Lhasa Radio Nov 13, 1977).

Hsi has been commander of the Tibet Military District since 1976.

K'ANG YUNG-HO 康永和

Identified as director of the State Bureau of Labour (NCNA Nov 26, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution K'ang was primarily a trade union cadre. After his reactivation in 1974 he became director of the Labour Bureau under the State Planning Commission. His new post seems to suggest that the Bureau of Labour has been taken from the Planning Commission to be placed under the direct supervision of the State Council.

KUO HSI-LAN 郭锡兰

Elected secretary of the Tibet Autonomous Region's Party Committee (Lhasa Radio Nov 13, 1977).

Kuo had been a deputy secretary before and has also been a vice-chairman of the Tibet Revolutionary Committee since 1971.

LI ERH-CHUNG 李尔重

Identified as vice-chairman of the Shensi Provincial Revolutionary Committee. (Sian Radio Nov 17, 1977).

Before being appointed vice-chairman, Li had been a member of the same revolutionary committee's Standing Committee.

LIU CHUNG-HOU

Identified as vice-minister of education (NCNA Nov 24, 1977).

Liu, then a "newcomer", was identified as a cadre of the Ministry of Education in July this year.

LIU T' IEN-FU 刘田夫

Identified as secretary of the Kuangtung Provincial Party Committee (Canton Radio Nov 27, 1977).

Liu had been a member of the Kuangtung Provincial Party Committee's Standing Committee before.

LU JUI-LIN 鲁瑞林

Identified as deputy commander of the Canton Military Region (Haikou Radio Nov 26, 1977).

Lu, a member of the 9th and 10th Central Committees of the CCP, had been a deputy commander of the Kunming Military Region between 1968 and 1976.

WANG TZU-KANG 王子纲

Identified as vice-minister of the Fourth Ministry of Machine-Building (NCNA Nov 7, 1977).

Wang had been a vice-minister of posts and telecommunications from 1959 until 1966. In January 1965 he was first elected member of the Standing Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference and reelected in January 1975. He has also been chairman of the Society of Electronics since about 1960.

WANG YÜAN-HO 王元和

Identified as secretary of the Tientsin Municipal Party Committee (Tientsin Radio Nov 8, 1977).

Before this he had been a member of that Committee's Standing Committee.

YÜ MING-T'AO 于明涛

Identified as secretary of the Shensi Provincial Party Committee (Sian Radio Nov 4, 1977).

Yü, elected member of the 11th Central Committee in August this year, had been a member of the Shensi Party Committee's Standing Committee before becoming secretary.

New Cadres

CHAO TUNG-WAN

Identified as vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technical Commission (NCNA Nov 7, 1977).

This was the first time after the Cultural Revolution that the above Commission was mentioned again.

HAN FU-JU

Identified as secretary of the Liaoning Provincial Party Committee (Shenyang Radio Oct 18, 1977).

HSÜ LIANG-TU

Identified as vice-minister of the State Planning Commission (NCNA Nov 27, 1977).

WANG CHUN-NIEN

Identified as Party secretary and vice-chairman of the Tientsin Municipality Revolutionary Committee (Tientsin Radio Nov 8, 1977).

Deceased Cadre

CH'EN WANG-TAO 陈望道

died on October 29, 1977, at the age of 87 (NCNA Nov 5, '77).

Ch'en had been president of Fudan University before the Cultural Revolution. In 1975 he was elected member of the Standing Committee of the Fourth National People's Congress.

Reactivated Cadres

CHAO YÜ-T'ING 赵雨亭

Identified as vice-chairman of the Shansi Provincial Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Oct 29, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Chao had been first Party secretary of the Chinnan District in Shansi province.

KUO CHIEN (f) 郭建

Identified as vice-minister of communications (NCNA Nov 15, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Kuo had primarily been a women's cadre. In January 1965 she was elected member of the Standing Committee of the Third National People's Congress.

LIU PING-LIN 刘秉琳

Identified as vice-chairman of the Shantung Provincial Revolutionary Committee (Tsinan Radio Nov 20, 1977).

Before the Cultural Revolution Liu had been a Party secretary and vice governor of Shantung province.

CH'EN FENG 陈枫

Recalled from his post as ambassador to Burundi (NCNA Nov 27, 1977).

HUANG CHEN 黄镇

Recalled from his post as Chief of the Chinese Liaison Office in the United States of America (NCNA Nov 19, 1977).

HUANG SHIH-HSIEH 黄世燮

Appointed ambassador to the Yemen (People's Democratic Republic) (South Yemen) (NCNA Nov 22, 1977).

Biographies

Fang Chih-ch'un 方志純

POST

Provincial Administration: Vice-Chairman of the Kiangsi Provincial Revolutionary Committee

Fang was born in Yiyang, Kiangsi province, in 1911. As a student of the Nanchang middle-school he joined the Communist Youth League in about 1924. Together with his brother, who was later (1935) executed by the Kuomintang as commander of the 10th Red Workers' and Peasants' Army, Fang Chih-min staged peasant rebellions in the northern part of his native province in 1927. Afterwards he commanded one of the units of the 10th Red Workers' and Peasants' Army (until 1931). Between 1932 and 1936 he served in a guerilla unit operating in the Kiangsi-Fukien border region. In 1937 he went to the communist basis at Yen-an and thence to Moscow for medical treatment. In 1940 Fang returned to China's Sinkiang where he was arrested at the instigation of the then governor Sheng Shih-tsai in 1942. It was not until 1946 that he succeeded in breaking out of prison and in fleeing to Yen-an. Shortly afterwards he was sent to Manchuria to become head of the Administrative Office of the Northeast Bureau under the CCP Central Committee. In 1947 he became secretary-general and director of the CCP Administrative Office of Nunkiang province. About 1948 Fang was made deputy secretary of the Heilungkiang Provincial Party Committee. In the spring of 1949 he was a member of the Fourth Field Army units advancing to South China.

1960, Sep: Identified as chancellor of the Kiangsi Provincial Science and Technology University

1965, Aug: Identified as acting governor of Kiangsi province
Sep: Elected governor of Kiangsi province

1967, Sep: Fang was denounced and purged as an "agent of the Chinese Krushchev"

1977, Oct: First reappearance after the Cultural Revolution
Nov: Identified as vice-chairman of the Kiangsi Provincial Revolutionary Committee
