
Janabil, a Kazakh, born in 1933, elected alternate member of the CPCCC in 1973, comes from a shepherd's family of the Altai grasslands.



Remarks:

Hua's rise to the top of Party leadership cannot be directly explained from the biographical data as specified above. There is no indication of his having excelled as a worker activist or in any similar capacity like all of the younger generation of cadres. On the other hand, Hua's activities in Shaoshan, Mao Tse-tung's place of birth, and the fact that he was received by Mao Tse-tung in September 1967 may well prove to be keys to his rise. This suggests that, for reasons we have not yet been able to identify, there may be a special relationship between Mao and Hua.

Kan Tsu-ch'ang



POST

Member of the Standing Committee of the 4th National People's Congress.

Kan was born in Yenpei, Lienhua hsien, at the foot of the Chingkang Mountains in Kiangsi Province in 1905. In 1927 he joined the Red Workers' and Peasants' Army. In 1934/5 he took part in the Long March. As a result of fighting during Revolution, Kan was badly wounded on three occasions.

- 1957 Kan, then Director of the PLA Logistics Department in the Sinkiang Military Region, is demobilized in view of his wounds, and returns to his home village.
- afterwards Kan excels by initiating and implementing various projects of agriculture and irrigation in his home village.
- 1975, Jan. Elected member of the Standing Committee by the 4th National People's Congress.

China's economic aid

ETHIOPIA

Under a protocol of July 1974 a bamboo weaving training class was opened with Chinese assistance in Addis Ababa. 14 students have recently completed their study programs after 18 months work. They are now qualified to make 24 bamboo articles including tables, chairs, suitcases, baskets and injera containers, as well as artistic bamboo-ware such as vases and lamp shades (NCNA Feb 5, 1976).

LAOS

On 3rd February, a ceremony was held at the office of the National Planning Committee to receive aid materials given by the PRC. The aid materials include 150 lorries, 8000 bicycles, 10,000 tons of rice, 10,000 tons of oil, 3000 tons of cement, a quantity of textiles, medicine and other materials. Several thousand tons of the aid have arrived in Vientiane via the Democratic Republic of Vietnam (Vientiane Radio, 3 Feb 1976; cit SWB/W 865).

MALI

A rice mill, built with Chinese aid under the 1961 economic co-operation agreement, was inaugurated in Mopti on 14th February (NCNA Feb 18, 1976).

Mali's total output of fresh tealeaves in 1975 was 364 tons as against the estimated figure of 240 (NCNA Feb 23, 1976). The Balinkoni tea plantation and processing factory constructed with Chinese aid in the Sikasso district from 1971 to 1973 had a scheduled annual production of 3,000 tons (PR Jan 18, 1976).

MOROCCO

A protocol on the construction of a sports complex was signed on Feb 20, 1976 (NCNA Feb 20, 1976).

NIGERIA

China and Nigeria signed a protocol for the sinking of boreholes in the Chad basin area of the North Eastern State, with Chinese assistance (Lagos Radio Jan 29, 1976; cit SWB/W 865).

SRI LANKA

China is to provide Sri Lanka with assistance in setting up an apatite fertilizer works (SWB/W 866).

TANZANIA

The 4th medical team ended its work in Zanzibar and the 5th started work in February 1976 (NCNA Feb 15, 1976).

China presented a batch of sports equipment and sports uniforms (NCNA Feb 24, 1976).

TOGO

Chinese doctors of the medical team, in Togo since Dec 3, 1974 (NCNA Dec. 10, 1974) successfully removed a 40 kilogram tumour under acupuncture anaesthesia from a woman at a clinic affiliated to the Lome General Hospital at the end of last year (NCNA Feb 18, 1976).

UGANDA

The rice scheme at Kibimba in Busoga district, eastern Uganda at which works started in Nov 1973 (NCNA Nov.22, 1973) was completed at the end of 1975 (SWB 5130).

VIETNAM, Dem. Rep.

A group of Chinese experts who helped in the rebuilding and extension of the chemical works at Viet Tri, north-west of Hanoi, received the Order of Labor, Second Class (VNA Feb 26, 1976; cit. SWB 5147).
