Known Cadres on New Posts

AN P'ING-SHENG 安平生

Identified as chairman of the Kuangsi Revolutionary Committee (NCNA Mar 20, 1976).

An, a member of the CCPCC, who has held the post of third secretary of the Kuangsi CP since December 1975, is now taking over the second post that Wei Kuo-ch'ing had occupied before he was transferred to Kuangtung.

CHANG PAI-FA 张百发

Identified as vice-chairman of the State Capital Construction Commission (NCNA Mar 11, 1976).

Chang, a deputy to the 2nd and 3rd National People's Congresses, had been purged in the cultural revolution and was reactivated in 1975. He is also a vice-chairman of the Association for Architecture.

HAO LIANG 浩亮

Identified as vice-minister of culture (NCNA Mar 19, 1976).

Hao first attracted attention as a worker in the field of Peking operas in 1969. As Li Yü-ho he was the star in the Peking opera "The History of a Signal Lantern". In August 1971 Hao was identified as a member of the State Council's Cultural Group. In January 1975 the National People's Congress elected him a member of its Standing Committee. In April 1975 Hao was identified as a cadre of the Ministry of Culture.

HSÜ MING-TE 徐明德

Identified as deputy Chief of Staff of the PLA Navy (NCNA Mar 16, 1976).

Hsü was mentioned as vice-admiral in 1964.

LI HSI-MING

Identified as vice-minister of water conservancy and power. Li was first mentioned as a Government cadre in October 1975.

LI KUO-TSAI

Identified as vice-minister of oil and chemical industries (NCNA Mar 22, 1976).

Li's first appearance was at the mourning ceremony for Chou En-lai in January 1976.

LIU CH'ING-T'ANG 刘庆堂

Identified as vice-minister of culture (NCNA Mar 10, 1976).

Li became known as one of the stars in the Peking opera "The Red Womens' Company". In August 1971 he was identified as a member of the State Council's Cultural Group. In April 1975 he was mentioned as a cadre of the Ministry of Culture.

LO TUNG

Identified as vice-director of Peking Radio (NCNA Mar 19, 1976). Lo was unknown before.

LU YING 鲁英

Identified as chief editor of Jen-min Jih-pao .

T'ANG K'E 唐克

Identified as vice-minister of metallurgical industry (Shenyang Radio Mar 22, 1976).

T'ang was a vice-minister of oil industry from 1965 till May 1972, when he became a vice-minister of fuel and chemical industries. In January 1975 he was appointed vice-minister of oil and chemical industries.

CH'IU LI-HSING 邱立行

Identified as a deputy director of one of the Foreign Ministry's departments (NCNA Mar 19, 1976).

Ch'iu was an embassy counsellor in Hanoi between 1973 and 1975.

KUO YU-CH'ANG 郭又昌

Identified as charge d'affaires ad interim in Sao Tome and Principe (NCNA Mar 30, 1976).

Kuo had held the corresponding post in Togo in 1972.

LIU CH' UN 刘春

Called back from his post as ambassador to Turkey (NCNA Mar 18, 1976).

LIU HSIN-CH'ÜAN 刘新权

Called back from his post as ambassador to the Soviet Union (NCNA Mar 2, 1976).

China's Economic Aid

MARCH 1976

ETHIOPIA

On 22nd March China and Ethiopia signed agreements on economic and technical cooperation (NCNA Mar 22, 1976).

LAOS

China and Laos signed an agreement on economic and technical cooperation on March 18, 1976 (NCNA Mar 18, 1976). A group of Chinese communications technicians arrived in Vientiane to discuss preparations for the continuation of the construction of a road between Nam Bak and Luang Prabang which connects the Laos-China border with the Laos-Cambodia border (SWB/W 870).

MADAGASCAR

Minutes of talks on the construction of the Moramanga-Andranonampango highway were signed on 20th March. The highway will connect the capital with the biggest harbour at Tamatave (NCNA Mar 22, 1976).

SIERRA LEONE

On March 19 the Mange highway bridge over the Little Scarcies river was opened to traffic. The bridge, which is the largest highway bridge in Sierra Leone, is 363 m long and 9 metres wide (NCNA Mar 20, 1976).

SUDAN

The 107 km-long Hantoub-Fau mountain section of the Medani-Gadaref highway was opened to traffic on March 1, 1976 (NCNA Mar 1, 1976).

VIETNAM, DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC (North Vietnam)

Chinese experts rendered assistance in building the Ninh Binh thermal power station, 100 km south of Hanoi. This power station with a 100,000 kW capacity, was set up in April 1971 and formally went into operation in March 1976 (SWB/W 870).

YEMEN, ARAB REPUBLIC (North Yemen)

On March 25, the Hodeida cotton ginning workshop took up production. The equipment of this China-aided workshop was installed last December (NCNA Mar 26, 1976).

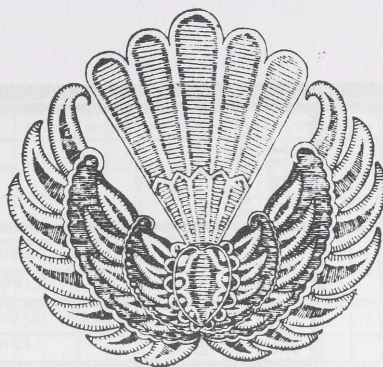

Vorwort

Die deutschsprachige Literatur über die südostasiatische Inselwelt, die heute die Republik Indonesien bildet, ist reichhaltig, aber weit verstreut und meist schwer zu erreichen. In dieser Bibliographie - in alphabetischer Reihenfolge nach Verfassern bzw. nach Sachtiteln geordnet - wird erstmalig versucht, eine möglichst erschöpfende Zusammenstellung vorzulegen. Als Grundlage dienten die reichhaltigen Bücherbestände der Museumsbibliothek Jakarta (Perpustakaan Museum Pusat Jakarta). Fast sämtliche bis zum Jahre 1940 in deutscher Sprache erschienenen Veröffentlichungen sind dort vorhanden. Es wurden ferner Antiquariatslisten und bibliographische Angaben in Büchern ausgewertet.

Aus praktischen Gründen erwies es sich als angebracht, die Inseln Borneo (in Teil I) und Neuguinea (Teil II) als geographische Begriffe - ohne Berücksichtigung der politischen Grenzen - zu verstehen. Weiterhin wurden auch solche Bücher in die Liste aufgenommen, die sich nur teilweise mit Indonesien und Neuguinea befassen.

Das hier vorgelegte Literaturverzeichnis enthält 1194 Titel (Indonesien: 981; Neuguinea: 213), und zwar Bücher, Broschüren und Sonderabdrucke. Es sind jedoch im allgemeinen solche Veröffentlichungen nicht erfaßt worden, die sich ausschließlich mit Fachfragen der Geologie, Botanik, Zoologie, Medizin und Landwirtschaft beschäftigen.
