China's Economic Aid

SEPTEMBER 1976

ETHIOPIA

A power plant at the town of Fitcha in the Shao Administrative Region was inaugurated on September 4, 1976. The plant is the first of a series of eight diesel power plants to be built with Chinese assistance. It will supply electricity for the local inhabitants and processing industries (NCNA Sep 5, 1976).

SIERRA LEONE

An improved seed rice station is under construction in Mkali. It took 14 months to open up 110 acres of gravity-irrigated land which may crop well in both dry and rainy seasons (NCNA Sep 14, 1976).

SRI LANKA

The construction of the Gin Ganga water conservancy project began in the presence of Prime Minister Mrs. Bandaranaike on September 21, 1976 (NCNA Sep 22, 1976).

TANZANIA

The Tanzanian Military Academy, built with Chinese assistance, was handed over in Monduli, Arusha Region, on September 1, 1976. Defence minister Sokoine said that Tanzania has not its own military academy (NCNA Sep 3, 1976).

The Tanzanian minister of communications and transport, Alfred Tandau, gave a farewell banquet on September 4 to

Pu Ke, leader of the Chinese railway working team who is leaving for home after completion of the Tanzam Railway (NCNA Sep 6, 1976).

VIETNAM

The Co Loa film printing and dubbing studio of Vietnam, constructed with Chinese aid, was inaugurated on September 21, 1976. It is located in the suburban Dong Anh District of Hanoi. Its annual capacity for processing films is 7,500 metres. The installation of equipment was begun in June 1973 and completed on September 2, 1976 (NCNA Sep 23, 1976).

WESTERN SAMOA

An agreement on economic and technical cooperation between the PR China and Western Samoa was signed on September 8, 1976 (NCNA Sep 8, 1976).

ZAIRE

At Mbandaka, capital of the Equator Province, an agricultural experimental centre is under construction with Chinese aid. Work on this project was started three years ago. The centre is one of nine in the country and specializes in popularizing the technique for growing vegetables and paddy rice (NCNA Sep 2, 1976).

Our staff member in charge of "Agreements", "Activities of the CCP Politburo Cadres", "Personal Data" and "China's Economic Aid" is away on a three months' tour to Asia. The material he compiled abroad may possibly have some gaps, as the comprehensive sources available to him at the Institute of Asian Affairs are not available to him now. Any important details missing in this issue will be included in the December 1976 issue of C.a.
