AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Bangladesh (Jan 08)

12th barter protocol to exchange goods worth 31 million U.S.\$ each way. Under it, Bangladesh will export crust and finished leather, raw jute and jute goods, tea, tobacco, g.i. pipe, super enameled copper wires, stainless razor blades and tea processing machinery to China. The items to be imported by Bangladesh from China under the protocol include machinery equipment and spares, light industrial products, dyes and chemicals, diesel (hs), power tiller, steel billets, steam coal, pig iron, refractory materials, scientific and surgical instrument.

Ecuador

Under a protocol of Jan 19, China will aid Ecuador with three different projects, including a 40-hectare agricultural experimental farm, an 600 square meters fruit storage and trading center and the drilling of 10 wells.

Kenya

A gymnasium constructed with Chinese assistance was handed over in Jan 1990. The construction of the 5,000-seat gymnasium started in April 1987 and was completed in October last year. The whole sports complex cost 200 million Kenyan shillings (about 9 million U.S. dollars).

Mali

China will finance and build a 10,000-square meter palace of congress for Mali in Bamako. The complex, in tra-

Appointed chairman of the People's Government of Guangxi Autonomous Region. (XNA, Jan 4, 1990)
Cheng was born in 1933 in Guangxi. He graduated 1957 from Jiaotong University. From 1964 until 1985 he served as engineer in Liuzhou Railway Administration. In 1987 he became vice-chairman of Guangxi's People's Government.

Hong Yuncheng 洪允成
Appointed president of the CITIC Industrial Bank. (XNA, Jan 11, 1990)
Since Sep 1986 Hong has been director of the General Office under the People's Bank of China.

Huang Huang 黄 璜
Appointed secretary of Ningxia Autonomous Region CP. (XNA, Jan 13, 1990)

Huang was born in 1933 in Lianshui County, Jiangsu Province. 1956-1982 he served as Party secretaries of counties and prefectures and became secretary of Anhui Province CP in 1983. In Sep 1985 he was by-elected member of the CCP 12th Central Committee (until Nov 1987). Since June 1987 Huang has been vice-governor of Jiangxi Province.

Li Lun 李 伦
Identified as deputy director of the General Logistics Department, PLA General Staff. (XNA, Jan 15, 1990)
Li was born in 1927 in Wuhu City, Anhui Province. He served in the 8th Route Army, East China Field Army and 3rd Field Army, 1951-69 he served in the Transport and Logistics Department of the General Staff and 1978-82 as deputy director of the Communications Subdepartment under the Logistics Department of the

General Staff. 1982-85 he served as director of the subdepartment and became president of the PLA Logistics Department in 1986.

Liu Meijin (f)

Identified as vice-governor of Fujian Province. (Zhongguo Xinwen She, Jan 9, 1990; cit. SWB, Jan 12, 1990)

Liu was born in Licheng, Shandong Province, and later worked as an engineer. 1983-89 she served as deputy director of the Organization Department under Fujian CP.

Wen Guoqing 文 国 庆

Identified as commander of Hunan Military District. (Changsha Radio, Jan 17, 1990; cit. SWB, Jan 25, 1990)

Wen has been deputy commander of Guangdong Military District before.

Zhou Nan 周 南

Appointed director of the Hongkong Branch of the Xinhua News Agency. (XNA, Jan 15, 1990)

Zhou was born in 1927 in Changchun City, Jilin Province. In the early 1950s he worked as a diplomat in the foreign ministry, in the Chinese embassies in Pakistan and Tanzania and at the Chinese mission to the UN. He was appointed assistant minister of foreign affairs in 1982 and vice-minister of foreign affairs in 1984.
