Maldives (Feb 20)

Two aid agreements:

A China will provide the Maldives with an interest-free loan of five million yuan (about 1.06 million U.S. dollars) and a grant of five million yuan for implementing projects over a period of five years from April 1, 1990 to March 31, 1995, to be agreed upon through consultations between the two governments.

B China will help the Maldives build a residential building with a floor space of about 2,300 square meters in Male.

A The Chinese government will provide the Sri Lankan government with a grant to the tune of RMB three million yuan (about 0.64 million U.S. dollars) for construction of a small-sized memorial hall in the Abhayagiri stupa in the ancient city of Anuradhapura of North Central Province.

B The Chinese government agrees to provide building materials valued at RMB three million yuan (about 0.64 million U.S. dollars) for restoration of the Abhayagiri stupa. The cost shall be met under the balance of the loan stipulated in the agreement on economic and technical cooperation between the two governments signed on March 13th, 1986.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Cameroon

China and Cameroon signed a contract for a vegetable growing project on an area of 21 ha in the village of Batchenga, some 70 km from Yaounde.

Congo

A The water-supply project Ouessou was inaugurated on Feb 1, 1990. The system, which includes a station capable of treating 1,550 cubic meters of water a day, can fulfil the needs of the city. Ouessou, capital of the region of Sangha adjoining Cameroon, is the centre of a main producing area for cocoa, wood and palm oil and has 13,000 inhabitants.

B The reconstructed hydroelectric station at Bouenza was handed over on Feb 13, 1990. The Bouenza station is about 200 kilometers south of the capital and was constructed with Chinese aid in 1979. Its overhaul began on May 31, 1988, and was completed last August 15. The station supplies electricity to the Congolese economic capital of Pointe-noire and was recently linked with the electric network of Brazzaville to play an important role in the country's economy.

Tunisia

The eighth medical team sent by China since 1973 left the country after a two-year service in northeast Jendouba Prefecture and central Sidi Bou Zid Prefecture. The team has given 321,328 consultations, operated on 13,226 patients, treated 75,571 emergency cases and hospitalized 29,240 patients, said a team statistics. Among them, 1,604 patients suffering from "grave" cases have recovered, it said. Meanwhile, the ninth team has arrived in Tunisia to continue medical service in the same prefectures.
