## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

### Australia (Mar 19)

Cultural exchange for 1990-91 (XNA, Mar 19, 1990)

### Ethiopia (Mar 12)

Protocol on China to send a new medical team. Under it, the new team composed of 15 doctors from China's Henan Province will work in the hospital of Debre Berhan, 140 kilometres northeast of Addis Ababa. (XNA, Mar 12, 1990)

### Nigeria (Mar 28)

Agreement on cultural and educational cooperation. According to the agreement, the two countries will also increase visits between actors, musicians, athletes, journalists, university teachers and other experts. (XNA, Mar 28, 1990)

### North Korea (Mar 22)

1990-91 plan for cooperation in public health and medical science. (KCNA, Mar 24, 1990; cit. SWB, Mar 29, 1990)

### Romania (Mar 06)

1990 barter and payments agreement. (XNA, Mar 6, 1990)

### Soviet Union (Mar 13)

Agreement on 1990 goods exchange and payment. Of Soviet exports to the PRC, 55% consists of machinery and equipment, including civilian aircraft and aircraft parts. According to the protocol, 80% of the supplies of Chinese goods to the USSR will consist of industrial goods and foodstuffs, consumer goods and raw material for producing them. Amongst these are items of clothing and knitwear, cotton and silk fibres, fur and leather garments, down-made items, footwear and sports

items and meat. Supplies of household radio electronic equipment will also occupy a significant position among Chinese exports to the Soviet Union. (XNA, Mar 13, 1990; Tass, Mar 13, 1990; cit. SWB, Mar 16, 1990)

### Ethiopia

Since Feb 1985 Guo has been vice-minister of the State Scientific and Technological Commission. He was born in 1935 in Henan Province. In 1959 he graduated from the Metallurgical Department of Ural Institute of Engineering in USSR.

### Guo Zhenqian 郭振乾

Appointed vice-governor of the People's Bank of China. (XNA, Apr 3, 1990)

Guo was born in 1932 in Henan Province. In 1954 he graduated from the People's University of China. Later he served in Financial and Trade Departments of Hubei Province. In 1986 he became governor and deputy Party secretary of Hubei. The following year he was elected member of the CCP Central Committee.

### Hou Zongbin 侯宗宾

Appointed secretary of Henan Province CP. (XNA, Mar 28, 1990)

Hou was born in 1929 in Nanhe County, Hebei Province. He became vice-governor of Gansu in 1986. The following year he was appointed governor and deputy Party secretary of Shaanxi and was also elected member of the CCP 13th Central Committee.

### Huan Yushan 桓玉珊

Appointed vice-minister of materials. (XNA, Apr 3, 1990)

From May 1987 until Mar 1988 Huan had been director of the State Bureau of Materials and Equipment.

### Huang Feng 黄枫

Resigns from his position as vice-governor of Heilongjiang Province. (XNA, Mar 8, 1990)

### Jiamuyang Luosangjiumei Tudanquejinima 嘉木样·洛桑久美·图丹却尼玛

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Gansu Province. (RMRB, Mar 10, 1990, cit. SWB, Mar 26, 1990)  
Jiamuyang is a newcomer.

### Liu Yuhuan
