CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Congo

China presented Congo a new drinking water pipeline works in Ouessou City, capital of Sagha Region. The works has a capacity of 1,550 cubic meters per day and is expected to greatly benefit 13,000 inhabitants in the city, which is considered the country's capital for cocoa, wood and palm oil. (XNA, Jul 4, 1990)

Maldives

China handed over the housing project (phase 1) consisting of a four-storey building and an outside underground water storage tank with a capacity of 400 cubic meters. The project covers an area of 1,350 square meters in a construction area of 2,300 square meters. The construction cost 4.74 million Chinese yuan (1.28 million U.S. dollars), out of which half was paid out of a Chinese interest free loan while the other half was a grant by the Chinese government. The construction of the project commenced in May 1989 and completed in July this year. (XNA, Jul 25, 1990)

Sri Lanka

China handed over a factory for the manufacture and popularization of rice-based products. Under a contract signed in 1988, the project was formally commenced on May 20, 1989, and was completed on July 14, 1990, the factory covers an area of 8,089 square meters and its production capacity is 1,360 tons of dry rice noodles per year.
