## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Indonesia (Aug 08)

Memorandum on resumption of diplomatic relations. The government of the PRC and the government of the Republic of Indonesia, pursuant to the agreement reached in Tokyo on 23rd February 1989 and the communiqué signed in Peking on 3rd July 1990 on the normalisation of relations between the two countries on the basis of the 10 principles of the Bandung Conference and the five principles of peaceful co-

existence, have decided to resume their diplomatic relations effective as of today, 8th August 1990, and have reached the following understanding concerning relevant questions relating to their bilateral relations.

The government of the PRC appreciates the position of the government of the Republic of Indonesia in consistently adhering to the one-China policy and its recognition of the government of the PRC as the sole legal government of China with Taiwan as an integral part of China. The two governments have reached the understanding that Indonesia maintains only economic and trade relations of nongovernmental nature with Taiwan.

Both governments reiterate their position of non-recognition of dual nationality for their nationals. Those people of Chinese origin residing in Indonesia who have acquired Indonesian nationality do not any more possess the Chinese nationality. Similarly, those people of Indonesian origin residing in China, who have been naturalised as Chinese nationals or have acquired Chinese nationality, also do not any more possess Indonesian nationality.

The two governments enjoin their respective nationals, who retain their respective nationality and reside in either one country as aliens, to abide by the laws of the country of residence, respect local values and customs, and live in harmony with the people of the country of residence. Both governments declare that they will, in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations of their respective countries and in accordance with international practice, protect and respect the legitimate rights and interests of the nationals of each side who reside as aliens in their respective countries.

Indonesia (Aug 08)

Trade agreement. The government of the PRC and the government of the Republic of Indonesia, hereinafter referred to as the contracting parties; desirous of expanding and strengthening trade relations between the two countries on the basis of the principles

of equality, fair trade and mutual benefit for the purpose of enhancing their respective economic development; have agreed as follows:

Article I. The contracting parties shall promote the expansion of trade relation between the two countries within the framework of this agreement and in accordance with their respective

laws and regulations.

Article II. The contracting parties, within the limit of laws and regulations in force in their respective countries shall grant each other most-favoured-nation treatment with respect to customs duties and other taxes and duties applicable to trade exchange between the two countries.

Article III. The provisions of Article II

shall not apply to:

(a) Preferences and advantages which either of the contracting parties has granted or may grant to neighbouring countries in order to facilitate their frontier trade; and

(b) Exclusive preferential treatment which results from any customs unions or free trade areas or regional economic grouping to which either of the contracting parties is or may become a

member.

Article IV. The contracting parties shall, subject to their respective import, export, foreign exchange, commodity inspection, and other laws and regulations, provide the maximum facilities possible for the purpose of harmonious expansion of bilateral trade between the two countries.

Article V. All trade payments between the two countries shall be made in freely convertible currencies, subject to foreign exchange laws and regulations effective in their respective countries.

Article VI. Each contracting party shall facilitate the participation by the other contracting party or its nationals in trade fair or exhibitions to be held in its territory, subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the competent authorities of the country where the trade fairs or exhibitions are to be held.

Exemption from customs duties and other similiar charges on articles and samples intended for fairs and exhibitions, as well as their entry, leaving, sale and disposition shall be subject to the laws and regulations of the country where the fairs or exhibitions are held. Article VII. Goods of all kinds of no commercial value used only as samples for obtaining orders and not intended for sale originating from the territory of either of the contracting parties shall be exempted from customs duties on entry into the territory of the other contracting party.

Article VIII. The representatives of the contracting parties, upon request by either of them, shall in the spirit of cooperation and mutual understanding discuss measures aimed at broader trade relations between the two countries and solution of problems arising from the implementation of this agreement. The place and date of such discussions shall be established by mutual agreement.

A joint committee could be established if deemed necessary by mutual con-

sent.

Article IX. The provisions of this agreement shall not in any way limit the right of either contracting party to apply prohibition or restriction of any kind which is directed to the protection of its essential security interest, or to the protection of public health or the prevention of diseases and pests in animals or plants.

Article X. The provisions of this agreement shall continue to be applied after it has expired, to all commercial transactions concluded but not fully performed before the termination of

this agreement.
At the request of either contracting parties, the present agreement may be revised by mutual consent.

#### CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Burkina Faso

Two administration buildings to Burkina Faso government were built with Chinese aid and opened in Aug 1990. The buildings, occupying an area of 13,000 meters, cost some 8,600,00 US dollars and were completed in 22 month by Chinese technicians and workers. They are dedicated to the seventh anniversary of the "August 4" Revolution of Burkina Faso.

Ecuador

Under a contract to promote agronomical research in Ecuador, China will help set up a 40-hectare experimental farm for scientific research. China will also help develop fruit tree cultures, process and market fruit and drill wells.

China will build a pencil factory which will cost about 6.15 million US\$ covered by a loan from China. Once com-

pleted in two years, the factory, the first of its kind in Ethiopia, will produce over 20 million pieces of pencil every year. At present, a thread factory is being built in Addis Ababa with Chinese assistance.

Jordan

A sports town constructed with Chinese aid was inaugurated in Aug 1990 in Irbid. The sports town comprises an olympic-standard stadium for 15,000 spectators, a gymnasium, a multi-purpose sports hall, three swimming pools and an olympic-size pool. Construction of the project started in 1987, and China and Jordan shared the cost estimated at 15 million US dollars. (XNA, Aug 11, 1990)

Mali

A new medical team arrived in Mali for a two-year service. The 22 doctors of the previous team have left for home after giving medical treatments and consultations to 290,700 local people in the past two years. A total of 422 medical persons have served in Mali over the past two decades. (XNA, Aug 10, 1990)

Myanmar

A cultural theater is under construction with Chinese aid.

The project, with a total acreage of 24,000 square meters including a 1,500-seat modern theater, will be completed

at the end of this year.

Also under construction is the Yangon-Tanyin bridge. The 1,822-meter rail-cum-road bridge is being constructed by a contract between the Myanmar and Chinese governments, under which the Chinese side provides the design, principal machinery and equipment as well as steel. The project started in October 1986 and is to be completed in six years. But the construction work came to a standstill in September 1988 because of the country's home situation but has been fully resumed since late May.


